The Borough of Allenhurst received your Open Public Records Act (OPRA) request on October 29, 2020. The official Records Custodian, Donna M. Campagna, received your OPRA Request on October 29, 2020. As such, the seven (7) business day deadline to respond to your request is November 6, 2020. This response is being sent to you on the first business day after the custodian's receipt of said request.

Your OPRA request sought the following:

- #1 List of all open code Violation properties from January 1st 2020 to Current Day
- #2 List of all tax delinquent properties from January 1st 2020 to Current Day
- #3 List of all utility delinquent properties from January 1st 2020 to Current Day

We have no documents response to item #1. Attached you will find the responsive documents to Items #2 and #3.

If your request for access to a government record has been denied or unfilled within the seven (7) business days required by law, you have a right to challenge the decision by the Borough of Allenhurst to deny access. At your option, you may either institute a proceeding in the Superior Court of New Jersey or file a complaint with the Government Records Council (GRC) by completing the Denial of Access Complaint Form. You may contact the GRC by toll-free telephone at 866-850-0511, by mail at P.O. Box 819, Trenton, NJ, 08625, by e-mail at grc@dca.state.nj.us, or at their web site at www.state.nj.us/grc. The GRC can also answer other questions about the law. All questions regarding complaints filed in Superior Court should be directed to the Court Clerk in your County.
