The Toms River Municipal Utilities Authority (TRMUA) received your Open Public Records Act (OPRA) request on April 30, 2019. The official Records Custodian, Robert J. DiBiase, received your OPRA request on April 30, 2019. As such, the seven (7) business day deadline to respond to your request was May 9, 2019. This response is being provided to you on the first business day.

Your OPRA request sought access to the following items listed in bold (answers are in italics):

If your request for access to a government record has been denied or unfilled within the seven (7) business days required by law, you have a right to challenge the decision by the Toms River Municipal Utilities Authority to deny access. At your option, you may either institute a proceeding in the Superior Court of New Jersey or file a complaint with the Government Records Council (GRC) by completing the Denial of Access Complaint Form. You may contact the GRC by toll-free telephone at 866-850-0511, by mail at P.O. Box 819, Trenton, NJ, 08625, by e-mail at grc@dca.state.nj.us, or at their web site at www.state.nj.us/grc. The GRC can also answer other questions about the law. All questions regarding complaints filed in Superior Court should be directed to the Court Clerk in your County.
