The Town of Westfield received your OPRA request on August 12, 2019. The custodian of records received your request on the same day. As such, the seven (7) business day deadline to respond to your request is August 21, 2019. This response to your request is being provided to you on the same business day as the custodian's receipt of said request.

Your request sought access to the following:

“A list of properties that are behind two or more years on their property tax payments.”

Henry Wang, Tax Collector for the Town of Westfield has advised this office that there are no properties that are delinquent for more than two years since the town is required to sell delinquencies that are more than a year old at the annual tax sale. With that being said, a current list of opens liens is being provided to you.

The following documents are being provided to you in their entirety and are responsive to your request:

1. Lien Account Status as of August 12, 2019 (7 pages)

This response is being transmitted to you via email, as per your request.

If your request for access to a government record has been denied or unfilled within seven (7) business days required by law, you have a right to challenge the decision by the Town of Westfield to deny access. At your option, you may either institute a proceeding in the Superior Court of New Jersey or file a complaint with the Government Records Council (GRC) by completing the Denial of Access Complaint Form. You may contact the GRC by toll-free telephone at 866-850-0511, by mail at P.O. Box 819, Trenton, NJ 08625, by e-mail at grc@dca.state.nj.us, or at their web site at www.state.nj.us/grc. The GRC can also answer other questions about the law. All questions regarding complaints filed in Superior Court should be directed to the Court Clerk in your County.
