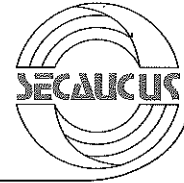

Dear Mr. Beckwith:

The Official Records Custodian for the Town of Secaucus, Michael Marra, received your Open Public Records Act (OPRA) request on November 18, 2019.

The Town of Secaucus does not maintain a list of all residential vacant properties and therefore has no records pertaining to your request. We do however maintain a foreclosure list. If you wish to have that list, please let us know.

If your request for access to a government record has been denied or unfilled within the seven (7) business days required by law, you have a right to challenge the decision by the Town of Secaucus to deny access. At your option, you may either institute a proceeding in the Superior Court of New Jersey or file a complaint with the Government Records Council (GRC) by completing the Denial of Access Complaint Form. You may contact the GRC by toll-free telephone at (866) 850-0511, by mail at P.O. Box 819, Trenton, NJ 08625, by e-mail at [grc@dca.state.nj.us](mailto:grc@dca.state.nj.us) or at their website at [www.state.nj.us/grc](http://www.state.nj.us/grc). The GRC can also answer other questions about the law. All questions regarding complaints filed in Superior Court should be directed to the Court Clerk in your County.
