Dear Mr. Sexton:

The Official Records Custodian for the Town of Secaucus, Michael Marra, is in receipt of your OPRA request that was sent on October 17, 2019.

On November 6, my office emailed you the most current documentation that was provided to me by our Tax Collector's Office. I have spoken to the Construction Office regarding the remainder of your OPRA request. The request as written is too voluminous to be handled. If you could, please try to narrow your request down to specific properties,

If your request for access to a government record has been denied or unfilled within the seven (7) business days required by law, you have a right to challenge the decision by the Town of Secaucus to deny access. At your option, you may either institute a proceeding in the Superior Court of New Jersey or file a complaint with the Government Records Council (GRC) by completing the Denial of Access Complaint Form. You may contact the GRC by toll-free telephone at (866) 850-0511, by mail at P.O. Box 819, Trenton, NJ, 08625, by e-mail at grc@dca.state.nj.us or at their website at www.state.nj.us/grc. The GRC can also answer other questions about the law. All questions regarding complaints filed in Superior Court should be directed to the Court Clerk in your County.
