Narrative

On Tuesday September 24 2019, at approximately 1433, I was dispatched to 1524 Newport drive, for a report of a stolen dog. Dispatch advised that the call came in from a neighbor who witnessed the dog being taken.

When I arrived on scene I spoke to the complainant, Kaitlyn Lane, who stated that she is a neighbor at 1518 Malibu Drive. Kaitlyn stated she observed an older model 4 door Cadillac Sedan cream or ivy colored, in front of her house stopped at the stop sign at the intersection of Malibu drive and Newport Avenue. Kaitlyn said she noticed the vehicle was stopped at the stop sign longer then usual, and eventually saw the driver get out of the vehicle. Kaitlyn said she then observed the driver walk over to passenger side of his vehicle and saw him playing with her neighbors puppy, who was in the front lawn on the side of the house. Kaitlyn said she then saw the male pick up the puppy, and place him in his car, and then he made a left turn and drove down Newport Drive.

Kaitlyn said she wasn't sure if the male knew her neighbors and the puppy, so she decided to walk her dog around the neighborhood and while doing that she checked the area for the vehicle. Kaitlyn said she walked around for approximately 10 minutes and when she did not see the Cadillac she felt something wasn't right and called her neighbor, Evelyn Xochiali. Kaitlyn said that Evelyn advised that she was not home and told her that no one should have her dog. Kaitlyn said she then called the police to report the incident.

I spoke to the owner of the dog, Evelyn, via telephone since she was not yet on scene. Evelyn described her dog as a 9 month old Boston Terrier puppy, black and white in color. She said the dogs name is Fendy and he has all its vaccinations, and was not wearing a collar. She also said Fendy is not chipped, and has not yet been registered. Evelyn said she purchased Fendy from a breeder in Pennsylvania for \$550. Evelyn stated her daughter let the dog out in the backyard when she got home from school, and he got out of the backyard through a hole in the fence.

Kaitlyn advised that she has a surveillance in the front of her house and that we checked, however no evidence of the theft was caught on camera because it does not reach the area where the incident occurred. I also checked nearby houses for surveillance cameras and had negative results. Kaitlyn stated the vehicle appeared to be occupied once, and described the suspect as a black male, late 20's to early 30's, wearing a grey hooded sweat shirt, no further description. Kaitlyn said she was not able to get a plate to the suspects vehicle.

I advised Evelyn if she gets any more information on the suspect vehicle to call the police. I also explained that she can try to check with animal control and animal shelters daily for Fendy, and if he is found to call the police so we can document that he was located.
