The Town of Westfield received your OPRA request on December 5, 2019. The custodian of records received your request on the same day. As such, the seven (7) business day deadline to respond to your request is December 16, 2019. This response to your request is being provided to you on same business day as the custodian's receipt of said request.

Your request sought access to the following:

- I am requesting a List of all residential properties in your city that have had the water shut off any time between 6/1/2019 and 12/1/2019. I only need the property addresses. I do not want any customer information or reason for shut off. I authorize you to redact confidential information in accordance with Section 182.052 of the Utilities Code.

Please be advised that the Town of Westfield does not operate a water utility and does not possess or maintain water records. It is suggested that you contact New Jersey Water Company for the records you are seeking.

This response is being transmitted to you via email as per your request.

If your request for access to a government record has been denied or unfilled within seven (7) business days required by law, you have a right to challenge the decision by the Town of Westfield to deny access. At your option, you may either institute a proceeding in the Superior Court of New Jersey or file a complaint with the Government Records Council (GRC) by completing the Denial of Access Complaint Form. You may contact the GRC by toll-free telephone at 866-850-0511, by mail at P.O. Box 819, Trenton, NJ 08625, by e-mail at grc@dca.state.nj.us, or at their web site at www.state.nj.us/grc. The GRC can also answer other questions about the law. All questions regarding complaints filed in Superior Court should be directed to the Court Clerk in your County.
