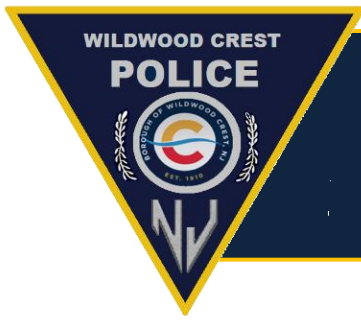

The Wildwood Crest Police Department received your Open Public Records Act (OPRA) request on Tuesday, December 23, 2025. The official Records Custodian, Chief Robert Lloyd, received your OPRA request on the same date and assigned his designee, the Administrative Sergeant with the task. This response to your request is being provided to you on 12/31/2025 the 4th borough business day after the custodian's receipt of said request.

OPRA allows public agencies to impose special service charges whenever the nature, format, manner of collation, or volume of a government record embodied in the form of printed matter to be inspected, examined, or copied pursuant to this section is such that the record cannot be reproduced by ordinary document copying equipment in ordinary business size or when fulfilling a request requires an extraordinary expenditure of time and effort. See N.J.S.A. 47:1A-5.c. Special service charges must be based upon the actual direct cost of providing the copy or copies.

OPRA mandates that the requester (you) shall have the opportunity to review and object to the charge before it is incurred. See N.J.S.A. 47:1A-5.c. As such, a detailed estimate is provided below:

Video Recordings - Initial review: 23 videos totaling 3.5 Hours

-related to Case #: 2023-20012

Redaction & Final Review of Video Recordings: 10.5 Hours

-redaction due to the presence of juveniles, PII, and other statutory privacy concerns

-computer screens, hospital, public restricted areas within the police department

Total anticipated hours to complete video redactions: 14 hours

Hourly service fee: \$53.05 per hour. Estimated video redaction fee: \$742.70

Redaction fee for Reports: 3 sheets, 5 cents a sheet, Total: .15 cents.

Estimated total for OPRA Request: \$742.85

Administrative Sergeant Christopher Webb is the lowest paid employee capable of satisfying this request. His hourly rate is \$53.05.

Reports are required to be printed for redactions by the records department, then scanned for documentation, faxing or emailed. Each sheet of paper has a cost of 5 cents.



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Report redactions; N.J.S.A. 47:1A-1.1, (20) Personal identifying information.

Kindly respond in writing or email with your acceptance or rejection of this estimated charge. We will not begin to process this request until we receive your written acceptance and processing of fee.

The Estimated fee is based on your request for any available body-worn camera footage and reports related to the incident.

As it stands, please allow for the additional time for processing this request and receipt of your service fee.

If you reject the estimated charge and you wish to challenge the special service charge, you have a right to challenge the decision. At your option, you may either institute a proceeding in the Superior Court of New Jersey or file a complaint with the Government Records Council (GRC) by completing the Denial of Access Complaint Form. You may contact the GRC by toll-free telephone at 866-850-0511, by mail at P.O. Box 819, Trenton, NJ, 08625, by e-mail at grc@dca.state.nj.us, or at their web site at www.state.nj.us/grc. The GRC can also answer other questions about the law. All questions regarding complaints filed in Superior Court should be directed to the Court Clerk in your County.
