The Morris County Prosecutor's Office received your Open Public Records Act (OPRA) request dated June 7, 2025, on June 9, 2025, and it was received by the records custodian on the same date. Specifically, I am requesting the following records:

1. A copy of the complaint, summons and/or warrant, including the affidavit of probable cause or certification attached thereto and all attachments.

2. Any incident reports, police reports, or law enforcement first reports related to this matter.

3. The officer's narrative or any supplemental reports prepared by Det. S. Verbist or any assisting officers.

4. Any CAD report, CAD abstract, or detailed CAD log for the relevant incident on or around February 9, 2025.

5. Any available arrest reports, booking sheets, or custody records related to the June 6, 2025 arrest.

6. If available, a mugshot or booking photo of the defendant.

7. Any documents reflecting warrant issuance or recall, including court communications, attachments, or notes.

If any part of this request is denied, please provide a detailed legal justification pursuant to N.J.S.A. 47:1A-5(g), including the specific exemption or privilege relied upon.

The following records are being provided and are responsive to your request:

1. Complaint-Warrant & Affidavit 1435-W-2025-000071 (6 pages).

Note: *Personal identifying information redacted pursuant to N.J.S.A. 47:1A-1 and N.J.S.A. 47:1A-5(a). Information related to individuals' reasonable expectation of privacy redacted pursuant to Burnett v. Cty. of Bergen, 198 N.J. 408, 423 (2009); see N.J.S.A 47:1A-1.*

Regarding your request for an arrest report and CAD report/abstract/log, we are unable to locate any records responsive to your request.

Your request for a booking photograph is denied. Executive Orders from four successive New Jersey State Governors declare that booking photographs "shall not be deemed to be public records subject to inspection and examination and available for copying." Executive Orders Nos. 9 (Gov. Hughes, 1963); 123 (Gov. Kean, 1983); 69 (Gov. Whitman, 1997); and 21 (McGreevey, 2002). OPRA "shall not abrogate any exemption of a public record or government record from public access ... promulgated under the authority of any ... Executive Order of the Governor; Executive Order of the Governor," therefore, booking photographs may not be produced in response to an OPRA request. N.J.S.A. 47:1A-9(a); See Nunez v. City of Hackensack (Bergen), GRC Complaint No. 2011-233 (May 2017) 2015-300 (January 2013); See also Melton v. City of Camden, GRC Complaint No. 2011-233 (January 2013).

Other than the above supplied record, access to the remainder of the contents of the investigation file related to this matter is denied, as they are considered criminal investigatory records. Such records are exempt from disclosure under OPRA pursuant to N.J.S.A. 47:1A-1.1 to -13, and Janeczko v. Department of Law and Public Safety, Division of Criminal Justice, GRC Complaint Numbers 2002-79 and 2002-80 (affirmed on appeal May 2004). Criminal investigatory records are defined as records that are held by a law enforcement agency, which pertain to any criminal investigation and of which are not required by law to be made, maintained or kept on file. Ibid. A criminal investigatory record remains exempt from disclosure even after the criminal investigation has been closed. West Solloway v. Bergen County Prosecutor's Office Custodian of Records, GRC Complaint No. 2011-39; Woojin Hwang v. Bergen County Prosecutor's Office Custodian of Records, GRC Complaint No. 2011-348; Janeczko v. New Jersey Department of Law and Public Safety, Division of Criminal Justice, Custodian of Record, GRC Complaint Nos. 2002-79 and 2002-80; Andrew Johnson/Press of Atlantic City v. New Jersey Division of State Police, Custodian of Record, GRC Complaint No. 2004-46. Cf. R. 1:38-3(f)(3) as to investigative police reports under the control of a court, unless they have been admitted into evidence.

Moreover, the New Jersey Supreme Court and the New Jersey Government Records Council have both held that records which are not "required by law to be made, maintained or kept on file," are exempt from disclosure under OPRA when they pertain to any criminal investigation or related civil enforcement proceeding. See N. Jersey Media Grp., Inc. v. Twp. of Lyndhurst, 229 N.J. 541, 556 (2017) (citing N.J.S.A. 47:1A-1.1); see also, Kovacs v. Irvington Police Department, GRC Complaint No. 2014-196 (January 2015) (holding and observing that the Government Records Council "has long held that police incident reports" are exempt from disclosure under OPRA as "criminal investigatory records" when they pertain to any criminal investigation or related civil enforcement proceeding, citing Nance v. Scotch Plains Police Dep't, GRC Complaint No. 2003-125 (January 2005); Rivera v. Passaic Cnty. Sheriff's Office, GRC Complaint No. 2010-152 (May 2011); and Connelly v. Twp. of Montville, GRC Complaint No. 2013-59 (September 2013)); Rivera v. Town of West New York, GRC Complaint No. 2010- 208 (February 2013), citing Bart v. City of Passaic, GRC Complaint No. 2007-162 (April 2008); and Executive Order No. 26 (Gov. McGreevy 2002); Hockensmith v. Atlantic Cnty. Prosecutor's Office, GRC Complaint No. 2014-288 (Mar. 2015) (observing that under OPRA "criminal investigatory records include records involving all manner of crimes, resolved or unresolved, and includes *information that is part and parcel of an investigation, confirmed and unconfirmed.*") (emphasis added and internal citations omitted).

You have also requested the records under the common law. Access under the common law requires that "the person seeking access must 'establish an interest in the subject matter of the material'." Mason v. City of Hoboken, 196 N.J. 51, 67 (2008) (quoting Keddie v. Rutgers, 148 N.J. 36, 50 (1997)). As your request fails to declare a particularized interest in the non-supplied requested records, upon which a balancing of interests may be assessed, access to these records is also denied under common law. See O'Boyle v. Borough of Longport, 218 N.J. 168, 200 (2014).

The Office of the Morris County Prosecutor reserves the right to raise any other grounds for denial not raised in this response. Failure of the Office of the Morris County Prosecutor to assert an exception or privilege does not act as a waiver of any grounds for denial. Furthermore, a reviewing

Court or the Government Record's Council ("GRC") may deem a denial of access to be authorized on grounds other than those advanced by a custodian. Paff v. Twp. of Plainsboro, A-2122-05T2, 2007 WL 957289, at *2 (N.J. Super. Ct. App. Div. Apr. 2, 2007) affirming, Paff v. Township of Plainsboro, GRC Complaint No. 2005-29 (March 2006).

You have a right to challenge the decision by the Office of the Morris County Prosecutor to deny access. At your option, you may either institute a proceeding in the Superior Court of New Jersey or file a complaint with the GRC by completing Denial of Access Complaint Form. You may contact the GRC by toll-free telephone at 866-850-0511, by mail at PO Box 819, Trenton, NJ, 08625, by e-mail at grc@dca.state.nj.us, or on the GRC's website at www.state.nj.us/grc. The Council can also answer other questions about the law.

Note that any challenge to a denial of a request for records under the common law cannot be made to the GRC, as the GRC only has jurisdiction to adjudicate challenges to denials of OPRA requests. A challenge to the denial of access under the common law can be made by filing an action in Superior Court. All questions regarding complaints filed in Superior Court should be directed to the New Jersey Superior Court Clerk.

This OPRA request is now considered answered and closed.
