PUBLIC ADDRESS ANNOUNCEMENT

WEATHER

- Threat
- Warning

SEVERE WEATHER

The below named person will be responsible for monitoring weather on the day of the event:

1. Name of Designated Person(s): Edward Bravo will monitor weather conditions starting three hours prior to the event.

2. Shall it be determined that severe weather is imminent, appropriate action will be taken (SEE BELOW).
3. We have downloaded a lightning/weather app for smartphones (Lightning Alarm, My Lightning Tracker, or Storm Alert Lightning & Radar).

BEFORE THE EVENT: If severe weather is anticipated for the time frame that the event is scheduled, plans will be made to delay, postpone, or cancel the event.

DURING THE EVENT: If severe weather occurs during the event:

THUNDERSTORM WATCH

1) In the event that a Severe Thunderstorm Watch has been issued for the Atlantic City area and the situation has been communicated to the Event Directors the following actions should take place:

Communication from Event Directors will determine if a threat is imminent and the appropriate announcement should be made over the public address system.

For example:

SAMPLE THUNDERSTORM WATCH ANNOUNCEMENT

YOUR ATTENTION PLEASE, A SEVERE WEATHRE WATCH IS IN EFFECT FOR THE ATLANTIC CITY AREA UNTIL X:00 PM/AM."

- **SHOULD INCLUDE ANY PERTINENT DETAILS IN ANNOUNCEMENT:**
 - **CLOUD TO GROUND LIGHTNING**
 - **HEAVY DOWNPOURS AND HAIL ARE POSSIBLE**

TAKE ACTION AND EXIT THE VENUE IN AN ORDERLY FASHION AND MOVE TO SAFETY. IN THE EVENT OF SEVER WEATHER THE FOLLOWING LOCATIONS ARE DESIGNATED AS THE BEST AVAILABLE PROTECTIVE AREAS FOR INSIDE AREAS:

- 1. PLEASE INSERT AREA (CLOSET BOARDWALK HOTEL & CASINO TO EVENT)**
- 2. PLEASE INSERT AREA (PERSONAL VEHICLES)**

POLICE EMERGENCY

If a major sustained crowd disturbance needs to be reported to Atlantic City Police Department the event directors have designated **(NAME)** Alex Garcia **(NUMBER)** 212 804-8998 to report that disturbance to the Atlantic City Police Department. In the unlikely event that an evacuation is necessary, event organizers will need to provide an appropriate message to the public to the event attendees and the spectators of the event:

SAMPLE POLICE EMERGENCY ANNOUNCEMENT

"YOUR ATTENTION PLEASE. AN EMERGENCY HAS BEEN REPORTED AT (SPECIFIC LOCATION). THE AUTHORITIES HAVE BEEN NOTIFIED AND ARE RESPONDING. IF YOU ARE IN THAT IMMEDIATE AREA, PLEASE PREPARE TO EVACUATE CALMLY AND MOVE TO SAFETY. SAFETY PROCEDURES ARE UNDER WAY TO DETERMINE IF ANY ADDITIONAL EVACUATION REQUIREMENTS ARE NECESSARY."

In the unlikely event that an evacuation is necessary, event organizers will need to provide an appropriate message to the public to the event attendees and the spectators of the event:

SAMPLE FIRE EMERGENCY ANNOUNCEMENT

“YOUR ATTENTION PLEASE. A FIRE EMERGENCY HAS BEEN REPORTED AT (SPECIFIC LOCATION). THE AUTHORITIES HAVE BEEN NOTIFIED AND ARE RESPONDING. IF YOU ARE IN THAT IMMEDIATE AREA, PLEASE PREPARE TO EVACUATE CALMLY AND MOVE TO SAFETY. SAFETY PROCEDURES ARE UNDER WAY TO DETERMINE IF ANY ADDITIONAL EVACUATION REQUIREMENTS ARE NECESSARY.”

POWER OUTAGE

Also note that in the event of a power outage a megaphone will be used to give instructions and the event directors have designated (NAME) Hugo Flores (NUMBER) 914 874-6067 to contact Atlantic City Police and/or Fire Departments to determine if an evacuation is necessary.

2). We will review the nature of the emergency and all possible courses of action and determine the potential next steps.

3). Options include, but are not limited to the following:

-Continue to monitor the situation without any overt action at the present time.

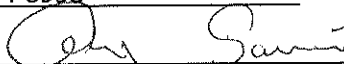
-Make the determination to contact emergency personnel.

THUNDERSTORM WARNING

2) In the event that a SEVERE THUNDERSTORM WARNING has been issued for the Atlantic City area, as event organizers it is our responsibility to take the following actions:

- Lightning strike within 20 miles of venue Event organizer need to constantly monitor weather, lightning strike within 10 miles of venue Event organizer needs to initiate evacuation of the outdoor event and instruct all workers, volunteers, and patrons etc. to exit the outdoor venue and seek immediate shelter in a sturdy structure or an area off refuse.
- Communications from event organizers will determine if a threat is imminent and that the approved appropriate announcement should be made by event directors.

SAMPLE THUNDERSTORM WARNING ANNOUNCEMENT

“YOUR ATTENTION PLEASE, A SEVERE THUNDERSTORM WARNING IS NOW IN EFFECT FOR THE ATLANTIC CITY AREA UNTIL X:00 AM/PM. (INLCUDE PERTINENT DETAILS INCLUDING CLOUD TO GROUND LIGHTNING, BRIEF HEAVY DOWNPOURS, AND HAIL ARE POSSIBLE).
