Important Notes/ Clarifications:

- *COVID-19 Vaccines Covered under the Affordable Care Act (ACA) are covered at a \$0 Copay
- *Out of Pocket Maximum amounts of individual \$1 600 and family \$3200
- *Voluntary Smart90 allows members to fill up to a 90 day supply at any in network retail pharmacy
- *Specialty Copays are \$10 for all tiers at retail and \$20 for all tiers at mail

Accredo Specialty Pharmacy

If you are taking a specialty medication you must fill your specialty medications through Express Scripts Accredo Pharmacy. Accredo only fills specialty medications and will fill and ship these medications directly to your home. If interested please call Accredo at **(800) 803-2523**.

KPCM through USRX Care for Specialty

If you are taking a specialty injectable medication you will be required to obtain a prior authorization for these medications through USRX care as part of the KPCM program through Keenan. The reviews for these medications are not done by ESI. You can contact USRX Care by calling **(844) 744-4410**.

Save On

Certain specialty medications will be covered at a \$0 copay through the Save On SP specialty program. This will require that members contact them to enroll. Members taking meds that are covered through Save On will receive a letter as well as a reject at the pharmacy if they need to enroll. Save On can be reached at **(800) 683-1074**.

Formulary

When you have a prescription filled you will pay a copay based on if the medication is generic, formulary or non-formulary per the above copay chart. if you use one of the formulary exclusions it will not be covered unless your doctor provides documentation showing you have tried and failed the formulary alternative(s). For a copy of the formulary, please call Express Scripts at **(866) 701-2018** or visit express-scripts.com to perform a drug coverage check.

Drug Quantity Management

Certain drugs are subject to quantity level limits. These limits are aligned with the FDA approved dosage for that medication. An example of this is the drug Viagra which is limited to 6 pills per month, in accordance with FDA guidelines. If additional quantity of a drug is needed the doctor will need to call Express Scripts for a clinical review to get a prior authorization.

Step Therapy

Drugs in certain ongoing drug therapy categories could be subject to Step Therapy. Step Therapy is a program in which certain drug classes are organized in a set of “steps” with generic drugs being the first step and brand name drugs being the second step. In order to meet Step Therapy requirements you need to use the 1st line Rx before the brand will be covered.

Prior Authorization

Prior authorization is needed for certain medications. If you have questions on a particular drug, please contact Customer Service or visit www.express-scripts.com to perform a coverage check. Please have your doctor call Express Scripts at **(800)753-2851** to go through a clinical review on your medication if it is subject to prior authorization.

Express Scripts’ Home Delivery Pharmacy

Home Delivery from the Express Scripts Pharmacy is available to fill your maintenance medications— those prescription drugs you take regularly to treat ongoing conditions. You can get set up by calling customer service or accessing the mobile app / website.
