The Department of the Treasury, Office of Management & Budget (OMB) has completed its review of your Open Public Records Act (OPRA) request C250805. You requested "I. [NJCFVS Vendor Payment History Reports - Outside Counsel]Description: The complete, itemized "Vendor Payment History Report," "Check Register," or equivalent system-generated ledger from the New Jersey Comprehensive Financial System (NJCFVS) detailing all individual payments, checks, and electronic fund transfers issued by the State of New Jersey to the following specific vendors/law firms: Law Offices of Kimmo Abbasi (or registered vendor Kimmo Abbasi) Meyerson, Fox & Conte, P.A. (or any registered vendor variation including "Meyerson Fox") Hill Wallack LLP (or registered vendor Hill Wallack) Mandatory Data Fields: To ensure the records are functional, the system-generated report must include the following visible fields for each transaction: The Payment Date The Payment Amount The specific State Agency, Division, or Department issuing the payment (e.g., DHS, DoAS, or OPG) The Check or EFT Transaction Number Date Range: January 1, 2018 to Present. II. PREEMPTIVE LEGAL DIRECTIVES & COMPLIANCE REQUIREMENTS 1. Objective Financial Data (Preclusion of Privilege Exemptions) The records requested herein are purely mathematical financial transaction ledgers generated by the State's central accounting system. They do not constitute advisory opinions, deliberative material, or confidential legal advice. Therefore, they are explicitly public records under OPRA and cannot be shielded under attorney-client privilege, the deliberative process exemption, or client confidentiality statutes. 2. Mandatory Search Audit Trail For the requested digital database search, the custodian must provide the exact vendor names or vendor ID numbers queried within the NJCFVS, along with the precise date and timestamp the search was executed. Failure to provide this metadata will be logged as a failure to conduct a "reasonably calculated search.""

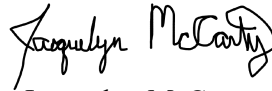
