Dear Mayor & Council,

It was good seeing everybody last night and I appreciated our spirited conversation regarding the proposed PLA ordinance. The reason I am emailing you is because I wanted to provide the studies surrounding the bad results of implementing PLAs.

Economically speaking, PLAs drive up costs on the taxpayer funded projects due to artificially constricting the supply of labor. The studies I am attaching show that in NJ, enforcement of PLAs drove up the costs on public schools by 33% and due to inefficiency delayed their timelines by 6-8 weeks (https://www.nj.gov/labor/forms_pdfs/legal/2010/PLAReportOct2010.pdf.)

Attached are 2 examples on bids for school improvements in Toms River. Toms River posts the results of PLA bids versus non-PLA bids and the results are always the same, PLA's drive up project labor costs far

beyond what the free market produces in a non-PLA bid.

Far more important is the question of principle, which is that we are taking away the freedom of choice from workers to join or not join a union while working on taxpayer-funded projects in Parsippany.

This ordinance would discriminate against the many local businesses that would otherwise bid on municipal work in town. In particular, the Associated Builders and Contractors suggests the following businesses in Morris County would be barred from bidding on work in our town should a PLA be mandatory:

Honorable Mayor Barberio:
Esteemed Council Members:

It has come to my attention the district is considering adopting a ordinance which compels PLA's, a.k.a Public Labor Agreements? I write each of you today in opposition of the adoption for a variety of reasons. Davis Bacon ACT ensures prevailing wages are paid on all publicly funded projects so protections under P.L.A's offer more protection for the labor unions than the stakeholders. On average this leads to more overbudget costs and longer turn around times.

Specialist like our firm are regularly hired by Union contractors across the state to provide the expertise not found through labor unions training or apprenticeship programs. Here in New Jersey any contractor who provides good and services to public entities, as we do, are required to participate in the ERISA programs and sponsor our own apprentices. Coupled with that we still provide specialized training for the best-in-class products we represent at the request of our valued customers like you. As stakeholders why would anyone wish to limit, in any way, access to more products, services and value by adopting restrictive P.L.A's?

As a member in good standing with the Associated Building and Contractors, ABC. I urge each of you to seriously consider opposing this ordinance particularly when there's no existing crisis which warrants its adoption. New Jersey is already known for its onerous regulations upon small business owners and the adoption of Public Labor Agreements simply adds to this negative image and those who support it.

While I am away, I will still have access to certify the budget for submission to the DLGS after the introduction. That certification of course will be contingent upon the final state document incorporating and necessary changes to ensure it is balanced, and within both CAPS.

Juan I have attached my working documents of the budget incorporating your budget and some of the modifications that Len had made. As it stands now, Parsippany is over the Levy Cap and will need approximately \$400,000 cut from appropriations to make the budget legal and certified. I also estimated the merit adjustments already at approximately \$100,000 so the \$400,000 is in addition to that. While I am away, I will still have access to certify the budget for submission to the DLGS after the introduction. That certification of course will be contingent upon the final state document incorporating and necessary changes to ensure it is balanced, and within both CAPS.

Juan I have attached my working documents of the budget incorporating your budget and some of the modifications that Len had made. As it stands now, Parsippany is over the Levy Cap and will need approximately \$400,000 cut from appropriations to make the budget legal and certified. I also estimated the merit adjustments already at approximately \$100,000 so the \$400,000 is in addition to that. Also I currently have the use of sewer fund balance at \$1,250,000 as I was not sure if you wanted to go to the full \$1,500,000 use of fund balance or something between the initial \$1,000,000 and \$1,500,000.
