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Re: Open Public Records Act

Dear Taeho Kim:

The Borough of Gibbsboro Records Custodian receive Open Public Records Act (OPRA) on May 27, 2020. Accordingly, the initial seven (7) business day deadline to respond to your request under OPRA is June 5, 2020. This response is being provided on the fourth day after your request.

Your records request was as follows:

Employees who worked in the police department at any point of time from 2012-2019: name, hire date, current status (active or separated), date of separation.

The following records are being provided in response to your request:

1. Police Department Personnel, 2012-2019

If your request for access to a government record has been denied or unfilled within the seven (7) business days required by law, you have a right to challenge the decision by the Borough of Gibbsboro to deny access. At your option, you may either institute a proceeding in the Superior Court of New Jersey or file a complaint with the Government Records Council (GRC) by completing the Denial of Access Complaint Form. You may contact the GRC by toll-free telephone at 866-850-0511, by mail at P.O. Box 819, Trenton, NJ, 08625, by e-mail at grc@dca.state.nj.us, or at their web site at www.state.nj.us/grc. The GRC can also answer other questions about the law. All questions regarding complaints filed in Superior Court should be directed to the Court Clerk in your County.
