Dear Ms. Evans:

I am in receipt of your recent OPRA request, whereby you requested the following:

Please tell me WHO submitted an OPRA request this year to obtain a Central Communications incident report regarding an incident that occurred at 6 a.m. on May 16, 2006, in response to to a 911 call placed by a woman called Janet Moretti.

Please also tell me WHEN this OPRA request was submitted.

Please be advised that on September 24, 2018, David Levinsky submitted an OPRA request for, *inter alia*, "[a]ny Aegis Public Safety System Incident Reports from a 911 call originating at 14 Butler Court in Medford on 5/16/2006." While a search of our records reveals that no other OPRA requests have been submitted seeking the specific incident report identified in your request, this Office has provided a voluminous number of Computer Aided Dispatch (CAD) reports in response to various OPRA requests submitted during the past year. It would require the review of every CAD report produced by the County of Burlington in response to an OPRA request during the past year to determine whether or not the specific CAD report you identify was provided in response to any other OPRA request.

Given its scope, such a review would be extraordinarily time consuming. Nonetheless, should you wish for me to proceed with such a review, kindly so advise in writing.

We now consider our response complete. Thank you for the opportunity to be of assistance.
