Dear S.B. D'Andrea:

Evesham Township received your Open Public Records Act (OPRA) request, on **June 11, 2018**. The Police Department Records Custodian received your OPRA request on **June 14, 2018**. The seven (7) business day deadline to respond to your request is **June 22, 2018**. This response to your request is being sent to you on the **4th** business day after the Police Department custodian's receipt of the request.

You requested "*All records of BOLO's (Be On the Look Out) put out from April 15, 2018-June 5, 2018*" under common law and OPRA. Please be advised that the Evesham Township Police Department has 1 document that it created and has 10 documents which it has received in the course of its law enforcement duties. Your request for these documents is being denied. The documents are exempt from disclosure under the on-going and active criminal investigation records exemption pursuant to N.J.S.A. 47:1A-1.1 and N.J.S.A. 47:1A-3a, and/or under Executive Order 21 as some of the documents contain information from Federal or State government related to potential acts of terrorism. Furthermore, the documents contain specific instruction from the transmitting agency that Evesham Township is not permitted to release the information to the public.

If your request for access to a government record has been denied or unfilled within the seven (7) business days required by law, you have a right to challenge the decision by the Evesham Township Police Department to deny access. At your option, you may either institute a proceeding in the Superior Court of New Jersey or file a complaint with the Government Records Council (GRC) by completing the Denial of Access Complaint Form. You may contact the GRC by toll-free telephone at 866-850-0511, by mail at P.O. Box 819, Trenton, NJ, 08625, by e-mail at grc@dca.state.nj.us, or at their web site at www.state.nj.us/grc. The GRC can also answer other questions about the law. All questions regarding complaints filed in Superior Court should be directed to the Court Clerk in your County.
