2. In order to request access to government records under OPRA, you must complete all the required portions of and date this request form and deliver it in person during regular business hours or by mail, fax or electronically to the appropriate custodian of the record requested. Your request is not considered filed until the appropriate custodian of the record requested has received a completed request form. If you submit the request form to any other officer or employee of the Township of Downe, that officer or employee may not have the authority to accept your request form on behalf of the Township of Downe and your request will be directed to the appropriate division custodian. The seven business day response time will not commence until the proper custodian reviews the request to determine if it is complete.
3. If you submit a request for access to government records to someone other than the appropriate custodian, do not complete the Township of Downe request form, or attempt to make a request for access by telephone or fax; the Open Public Records Act and its deadlines, restrictions and remedies will not apply to your request.
4. The fees for duplication of a government record in printed form are listed on the front of this form. We will notify you of any special charges, special service charges or other additional charges authorized by State law or regulation before processing your request. Payment shall be made by check or money order payable to the Clerk/Custodian of Record of the Township of Downe.
5. If it is necessary for the records custodian to contact you concerning your request, providing identifying information, such as your name, address and telephone number or an e-mail address is required. Where contact is not necessary, anonymous requests are permitted; except that anonymous requests for personal information are not honored.
6. ***You may be charged a 50% or other deposit when a request for copies exceeds \$25.*** The Township of Downe custodian will contact you and advise you of any deposit requirements. Anonymous requests, when permitted, require a deposit of 100% of estimated fees. You agree to pay the balance due upon delivery of the records.
7. Under OPRA, a custodian must deny access to a person who has been convicted of an indictable offense in New Jersey, any other state, or the United States, and who is seeking government records containing personal information pertaining to the person's victim or the victim's family.
8. By law, the Township of Downe must notify you that it grants or denies a request for access to government records within seven business days after the custodian of the record requested receives the request, provided that the record is currently available and not in storage. If the record requested is not currently available or is in storage, the custodian will advise you within seven business days when the record can be made available and the estimated cost. You may agree with the custodian to extend the time for making records available, or granting or denying your request.
9. You may be denied access to a government record if your request would substantially disrupt agency operations and the custodian is unable to reach a reasonable solution with you.
10. If the Township of Downe is unable to comply with your request for access to a government record, the custodian will indicate the reasons for denial on the request form and send you a signed and dated copy.
11. Except as otherwise provided by law or by agreement with the requester, if the custodian of the record requested fails to respond to you within seven business days of receiving a request form, the failure to respond will be considered a denial of your request.
12. If your request for access to a government record has been denied or unfilled within the time permitted by law, you have a right to challenge the decision by the Township of Downe to deny access. At your option, you may either institute a proceeding in the Superior Court of New Jersey or file a complaint in writing with the Government Records Council (GRC). You may contact the GRC by toll-free telephone at 866-850-0511, by mail at PO Box 819, Trenton, NJ, 08625, by e-mail at [grc@dca.state.nj.us](mailto:grc@dca.state.nj.us), or at their web site at [www.state.nj.us/grc](http://www.state.nj.us/grc). The Council can also answer other questions about the law.

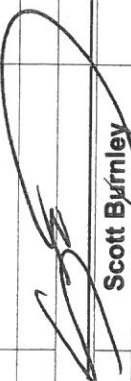

*It is now 6:55 pm on Saturday, September 2, 2017, and these neighbors at [REDACTED] Fortescue, have just arrived. Perhaps someone in the area may be interested in checking for themselves if they are occupying the home now and again tomorrow morning and on Labor Day.*

Dear Mayor, Commiteemen, Nadine, and Mr. Carr ~

Thank you, Mayor, for your quick response to our email. We have questions on two issues:

1. The survey marker below was inserted in the ground with an orange ribbon. We arranged the ribbon in a 90 degree angle to show the Twp boundary and our side boundary. The fence is on the boundary line and is no longer encroaching on our property, but the first two posts and a full section and part of another are in the Twp. setback according to your description to us of the setback in June. You told us our neighbors were aware of the setbacks. You state you inspected the property on Sunday and found full compliance and no violations. Please explain in writing why this fence can now stand in the Twp setback.



2. You state: "Your neighbor does have a temporary CO which gives him or any contractor the legal right to access the building and structures for the purpose of renovations, repairs, and remodeling to bring the property to code to the satisfaction of the state code officials."

We are aware our neighbors were given an undated Temporary (therefore, *Perpetual*) Certificate of Occupancy that forbids Occupancy and only allows for renovations. This document, [REDACTED] was signed and authored by the Mayor, not our Zoning Officer. Why? The language is confusing, conflicting, and ripe for misinterpretation.. What IS the purpose of issuing an undated Temporary Certificate of Occupancy that forbids Occupancy and only allows for renovations? Wouldn't "Building Permits" suffice and avoid duplicity? Please advise in writing .





We think our neighbors, when asked, would freely and truthfully ADMIT to occupying their home for the many two and three day stretches at a time that we have observed because they believe they are doing nothing wrong. And these two or three day stays certainly included using a failed septic as water is supplied to the house. They are by no means "sneaking" to do this, and we are sure they are very comfortable knowing they have a document signed by the Mayor granting them a confusing "Temporary Certificate of Occupancy".

In our prior email, we asked if you thought we were the troublemakers in this instance. You did not answer that. Your stating to us "Unfortunately, the Township does not have the resources for full-time surveillance of your neighbors property to enforce the CO limitations." insinuates that *THAT* is what we were asking of the Township! Remember, we are long-time residents and know the devastation and loss of revenue caused by Hurricane Sandy. We have never asked anything of the Township before we were forced to seek help, and somehow the burden of proof seems to be on US.. We find ourselves in a Lose-Lose situation and your comment, along with how the July minutes publicly portray us, is just one example.

We again request that the minutes of the July meeting be amended to reflect our accurate statement and the situation we faced. The way it is worded now leaves out the very reason we sought your help. It was afterwards that we were made aware that the neighbors did not have a CO and Cease and Desist Orders were issued. We did not present to the Twp office for anything other than assistance for what to do when neighbors were in the process of stealing our property by erecting a fence through it. We contracted with a surveyor and provided a new survey as the only markers missing on our property were those on the boundary with these neighbors. The old fence was encroaching 3-1/2 feet on our property and it was removed. A new fence has been erected on the property line and seems just fine with the exception of a panel and part of another that are in the Township setback.

We did not expect that our first visit ever to request help from our Township authorities would result in all these problems being dumped in our laps. NONE were caused by us!

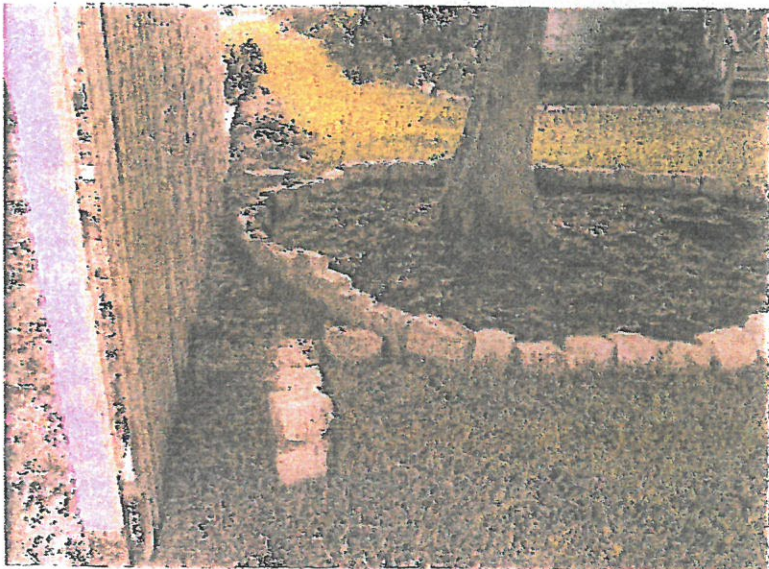
*(Most of this is repetitious for three of you except for the last four or five paragraphs but we want all the Committee members to be advised so they may decide if changes we request to the transcribed July meeting be made.)*

Gentlemen:

We came to you for HELP in June, 2017, when our new neighbors refused to believe us when we told them that the area between our two houses was not their driveway. We are Senior Citizens and not full-time residents. We travel between Fortescue and another home as our neighbors do as well. We were not at home when they erected 2 sections of 6' privacy fencing and three posts set in concrete directly on our property. Our survey proved they were encroaching 3-1/5 feet with the fence they put through our flower garden which they disrupted by moving our Belgium blocks and rearranging it.

They were not here the weekend when we first were presented with their handiwork pictured below. We tried to handle it nicely by printing out the three pages we found on the Downe Township's site to lead them to you regarding Zoning and Permits and taped it to the fence. The first entry under the Permit Section is FENCE. It still is. No permit was posted. It is not difficult to see it was not up to code. We thought the problem could easily be remedied with your help. We immediately emailed photos and explained the situation to Mayor Campbell, Scott and Nadine including our taping the information to the fence.





*Please note in the picture above that they used yard debris, cut tree limbs, and thorny briar vines to mark the area of where this fence between our houses presumably was to continue between our houses -- all on our property. The same scene was repeated in the back where we also share a common boundary. The grass and topsoil was removed from our property on what they arbitrarily decided was theirs. This is why we needed your help and advice.*

We came to speak to Scott Burnley about what to do. It was then, and only THEN, that we learned these neighbors had no CO because of a failed septic. Also in their Township's file with the Zoning Board, there were letters from their realtor attesting they had signed Certifications they understood meant they could not occupy the home. We were stunned that they would pick a battle with us with all they knew they were doing wrong. Scott issued two Cease and Desist Orders and we thought our troubles would be over.





The following weekend as we were hanging our Fourth of July decorations, two State Trooper cars arrived at our house because of a call they got that we had trespassed on our neighbor's property! We invited the officers into our house to show them the emails we had sent days earlier to Mayor Campbell, Scott, and Nadine where we freely admitted we had taped the papers to the fence. We had plenty of room to stand ON OUR OWN PROPERTY to accomplish this. We showed them our survey. We were not trespassing on their property at all. It was just the opposite.

They removed the fence in the photos above off our property but on July 4, 2017 at 7 am the neighbors began digging with a post-hole digger down the boundary line despite the Cease and Desist Orders that were issued stating they could not do work on the fence or their property until it was approved. We called the police and they reviewed the Cease and Desist Orders with the neighbors and told us it was a township matter.

We were assured at the June meeting by Mayor Campbell that the neighbors knew the boundaries now, including the Township set back lines. We returned our Belguim blocks to where they had originally been. You can see the damage they did to our property in the picture below. (We know this is a civil matter and are just pointing it out to you.) An apology was never offered to us for the trouble they created or the property damage they caused us. The new fence below is now on the property line but in the Township setbacks. We advised Mayor Campbell, Scott and Nadine and provided them with the photo below so you could see our recent survey marker. This was after the Mayor assured us they "were trying to do the right thing and they knew the setbacks". Have we not been "trying to do the right thing" also? Do you think we are the troublemakers in this situation and deserve to be treated as such? Please advise what course of action will be taken about this and when? If the answer is none, please advise as well.



We attended the June and July meetings and we recently read the transcript of the July meeting. It stated, [REDACTED] from Fortescue stated she had been here for 17 years and she has new neighbors that do not have a CO and were issued a



Cease and Desist Order that they are not honoring. Mayor Campbell stated the residents are trying to do the right thing. Discussion continued on the property line and the installation of a fence." This publicly presents us as the aggressors and troublemakers looking for something to complain about when, in fact, we were the victims of their failed attempt to steal 350 square feet of our property to make a driveway for themselves!

What was publicly posted on your site is the exact same version of what we have heard these neighbors loudly telling other neighbors and passersby about us - that we were preventing them from fixing up the house they bought and making the neighborhood nicer! They ask them about us: "What kind of people do that?" We remain silent and do not take their bait to escalate this situation. They never say anything about what they did to us that precipitated our being in need of your help - and neither do the July minutes!

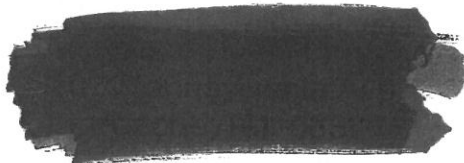
**WE DID NOT EXPECT TO HAVE MORE PROBLEMS WHEN WE CAME TO YOU FOR HELP!** Mayor Campbell advised us we need to call the Department of Health regarding their septic system and that the neighbors have a temporary CO now but they are not allowed to occupy the home so we should keep notes and advise if they occupy the house overnight. Yes, we have noted each occurrence we personally witnessed although we are only here on a part-time basis. But what will that accomplish? We do not like policing our neighbors, especially when we can't rely on the Committee to support us and enforce the Ordinances. Somebody please take a look and see for yourselves how often they occupy the house!

We value our reputation. The very least you can do for us is to correct the published July notes to include what Beth really said at the meeting - we have lived here for 17 years "and never had any problems. Our new neighbors erected a fence that was proven to encroach 3-1/2 feet upon our property after we had a new survey done. A temporary CO and two Cease and Desist Orders were issued but they are not being honored by the residents." The information you withheld is crucial and truthful.

What would any of you do if this happened to you? Most people immediately say they would have destroyed the fence themselves!

Please acknowledge this email and advise what will be done.

An Executive Session was held by the Downe Township Committee during its Regular Meeting held on Monday, January 9, 2017 at the Municipal Complex. Mayor Robert G. Campbell presided. Committee members present were Larry Jordan, Sr., (Deputy Mayor), Stephen Byrne, Edward Bart and Michael Rothman. Municipal Solicitor, John Carr, was also present.

**ANTICIPATED LITIGATION PURSUANT TO N.J.S.A. 10:4-12B(7), RE:  
OPTIONS REGARDING BLUE ACRES BUYOUTS**

The Township Committee discussed the matter of Blue Acres buyouts by the State. Mayor Campbell stated he has been contacted by a number of news agencies. He explained to them this Blue Acres buyout process has been going on for about a year. Mr. Cook stated he contacted the Blue Acres Office and found there is a second round of the buyout process being talked about at the State. The second round involves the remainder of Money Island. So they have consistently lied to us. There is one person who is under contract with Blue Acres. We sent out letters to the residents listed with Blue Acres to have received an offer. We asked the residents to share the offer letter with the township and they refused to share the information. The DEP will not share the information. We really can't be mad at the residents because they have been intimidated by the DEP and are afraid of what could happen to them next. They keep hearing that the committee is going to do something but they are not seeing anything from us. Maybe we need to contact our legislators. We need to attack the tax exempt status wall. The DEP fears legal action. How do we stop the homeowners from selling out? We could possibly stop the second round of buyouts. We need to ask for an injunction. We need to use the court system. Mayor Campbell spoke about the possibility of having the Lt. Governor visit Downe Township while she is in town for another event. Discussions continued with the committee on what state agencies we need to contact to discuss our situation. We will be prepared to go public with what we have decided to do as far as a lawsuit at the next meeting.

A motion made by Cook and seconded by Campbell to close executive session. All in favor.
