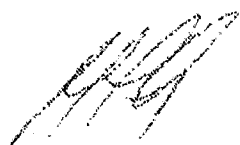

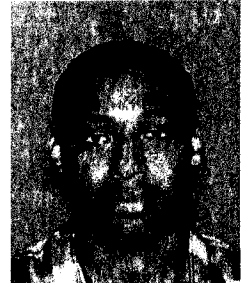

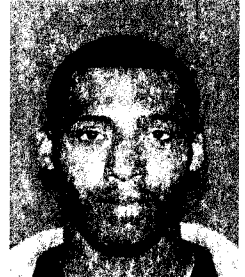

Resisting Arrest/ Obstruction/ Contempt

On December 10, 2009 at approximately 2337 hours, I was on patrol in an unmarked vehicle along with Dsg Vern Marino and Investigator Gary Kille in the quality of life area. We were in plain clothes but had on items clearly marking us as Police. We observed Jonathan Gardner walking with an unknown male from the unit block of West Buck Street through yards to the unit block of West Washington Street. We were aware of an outstanding juvenile warrant for Jonathan's arrest out of Superior Court in Gloucester County. As we drove around the block and onto the unit block of West Washington Street we came to a stop next to the parking lot and observed Jonathan Gardner begin to run back towards Buck Street. Inv Kille and I both exited the vehicle and gave chase running in the same direction. We announced that Jonathan was under arrest while also yelling at him to stop. Dsg. Marino drove around the block as we ran in an

attempt to stop Jonathan before he ran back to 101 West Broad Street. Jonathan lives at the aforementioned address and it appeared as though he was running in that direction. As we began setting a perimeter between Buck Street, Spruce Street and West Broad Street Dsg Marino spotted Jonathan running across West Broad Street through properties towards Thomson and Swedesboro Avenues. Marino exited the vehicle and gave chase yelling to Jonathan to stop and that he was under arrest. By this time several other officers arrived in the area to assist. Marino gave chase until he caught up with Jonathan near Thomson and Swedesboro where Jonathan was apprehended. Jonathan was handcuffed and transported back to headquarters.

At headquarters Jonathan was processed for Resisting Arrest and Obstructing the Administration of Justice. Municipal Court Judge William Golden set Jonathan's bail at \$2000.00 full cash. Jonathan was briefly turned over to Dsg Marino and Inv Kille for a follow-up to case #200907540. After processing I transported Jonathan to the Gloucester County Jail and turned him over at 0224 hours. After turning Jonathan over to the jail I notified Juvenile Intake that Jonathan was currently in custody on adult charges and that the his juvenile warrant was turned over to corrections officers as a detainer. It should be noted that a small black handled lock blade knife was taken from Jonathan's possession and placed into property. Also refer to Jonathan's arrest report. Ave. About 15 to 20 minutes later the car pulled away and Brittany, being suspicious of the vehicle, got into her vehicle and followed. On Lodge Ave near Wawa she got into a position where she was able to observe the driver. It was at that time that she observed an acquaintance, Jonathan Gardner, in the drivers seat in the process of taking off a gray sweatshirt. Jonathan and Brittany did not exchange greetings as they would normally have done in the past. Jonathan would also not keep eye contact with Brittany. Brittany continued back to Overbrook Ave and related her observations to Tamara. They believed, based on what they had just experienced and their knowledge of what they believe to be Jonathan's criminal history they felt they should report the incident because they believe Jonathan either wanted to burglarize the residence or commit a home invasion. I took the information and advised Tamara that we would provide extra patrols to the neighborhood and pass information on to the Detective Unit for intelligence purposes. On Friday, April 29, 2016 at 1300 hours, Gloucester County Communications dispatched officers to the Manor, located on Baird Ave for two suspicious motor vehicles. Upon arrival, I entered the back parking lot of Baird Ave and activated my Axon Taser Body Worn Camera (BWC) and approached two vehicles [REDACTED] black 2013 Ford Fusion and (NJ [REDACTED] black 2004 Hyundai XG3. The Ford Fusion was occupied by one occupant, later identified as Adam J Watts, and the Hyundai XG3 was occupied by four occupants, later identified as Jonathan A Gardner, [REDACTED] Eric Thornton, and Tykirah A King. I then explained to the occupants that there was a call of two suspicious motor vehicles. I

asked for identification of each of the occupants and Adam, Tykirah, [REDACTED] was able to provide identification. Eric and Jonathan did not posses identification. I then asked Jonathan Gardner for his information and did not require Eric Thornton for having dealt with him the day prior on his arrest for a summons that was issued to him. I forwarded all the information to Communications to be checked for warrants and advised the four occupants of the Hyundai that there is an odor of burnt marijuana in the vehicle. I had the four occupants step out of the vehicle and advised that I will be conducting a motor vehicle search. I then executed a grid search in the vehicle starting with the front passenger section and worked my way clock wise yielding negative results. Communications came back with Adam Watts having a warrant out of Deptford Twp (SP5588466) for \$250. The other occupants yielded negative results and were free to go. I then had Adam step out of the vehicle, handcuffed him with his hands behind his back (double locked), and placed him in the rear of marked unit #6 to be transported to headquarters.

Once at headquarters, I secured Adam to the wooden bench located in the patrol area of the station for processing and contacted Deptford Twp to receive a new court date. Adam was then processed, photographed, and released with a new court date.

Thursday, May 19th, 2016 at approximately 11:19 hours, while stationary at the corner of Swedesboro Avenue and Huff Avenue, I observed the following. I observed a black vehicle fail to stop at the stop sign within the intersection of Swedesboro Avenue and Huff Avenue.

I then activated my emergency lights and conducted a motor vehicle stop on NJ registration S50GGL on Baird Avenue. At this time this officer activated my BWC. Upon speaking with the driver who I identified as Jonathan Gardner, I ask to see his driver's license, registration, and proof of insurance. After obtaining the credentials that I had ask for I advised Jonathan the reason for the stop was that he had failed to stop at the stop sign posted on Swedesboro

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Avenue.

Back in my patrol unit, I ask communication to check Jonathan for a valid driver's license and check for any active warrants. Communication advised this officer Jonathan has a suspended driver's license and showing one active warrant for his arrest. I advised Jonathan of the active warrant at which time he was placed in my custody. Jonathan was secured in the rear seat of my patrol unit and transported to headquarters.

Upon arrival at headquarters Jonathan was escorted into the cell area where I conducted a search of his person. With negative results of any weapons or drugs Jonathan was placed on the wooden bench and secured to same. Jonathan was processed on warrant WV679 for \$525 out of Westville Municipal Court. Jonathan posted \$100 towards his fine and given a new court date of June 8th, 2016 at 1PM. Jonathan was also issued motor vehicle summonses #28967 for driving while suspended, #28966 for failure to stop at the stop sign. Jonathan was advised of his court date and released at 11:55 hours. No further action was taken at this time, more information to follow if and when received.

CD 201608764	Sunday, June 19th, 2016 at approximately 22:47 hours, Paulsboro units were dispatched to 1315 Pine Street for a male subject shot several times in the chest. Upon my arrival I activated my BWC. As I began approaching the residence, I observed a black male subject who was later identified as Michael Graham standing on the porch talking on the cell phone. As Ptlm. Kyle Spears from East Greenwich Twp Police and I entered the residence and began making our way back to the yelling and screaming, I observed the following.		

I observed a black male lying on his back on the ground at the base of the steps between the living room and kitchen area; his head facing the front door and his feet towards the kitchen area.

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I further observed the male subject who was later identified as Jonathan Gardner bleeding from what appeared to be two bullet holes just below his chest. Robert Thornton and Eric Thornton were leaning over Jonathan screaming, "Help him, help him he's dying." Both Eric and Robert were removed from the area and escorted out to the porch. Ptlm. Spears remained inside while I attempted to speak with Robert on what happened. As Robert was walking around I asked where did the shooting take place; Robert responded by stating, ""Right here," as he began walking back into the residence. Ptlm. Gentile was advised to secure the inside as I continued attempting to get information from Robert. With no cooperation, I began securing the outside of the residence.

EMS arrived on location approximately 22:52 hours and was escorted into the residence by Ptlm. Gentile. A few minutes later I entered the residence and observed EMS performing CPR. At this time I contacted Lieutenant Kille and advised him of the shooting. Lieutenant advised me to contact the detectives and that he would be responding to the scene. Detective Sgt. Gilcrest was contacted and advised of the shooting. Detective Sgt. Gilcrest advised that he would be responding to the scene. As ALS arrived on location they were escorted into the residence where CPR was still being conducted.

As ALS was administering further medical treatment, once again I made several attempts to speak with Robert asking about where the shooting took place. Robert stated it happened outside. Robert appeared he didn't want to speak with police at this time because he was very concerned about getting his children who were up stairs to safety. Robert went to the steps and waited for his children to come down. Robert and his children were then escorted out of the residence through the back door. It should be documented that Robert left the scene with his children to an unknown location.

I began scanning the area looking for any signs of evidence; however, I could only observe several blood droppings at the bottom of the steps leading into the residence and no evidence of any shell casings. As EMS began removing Jonathan out of the residence and into the ambulance, several family members began ignoring the perimeter and wanted to see Jonathan. The members were escorted back behind the police line. While Jonathan was being transported to the hospital the mother of the victim Alesia Burns arrived on location, at which time she was advised to make her way up to the hospital. Alesia began telling this officer that the shooter was Darnell Samuels. Alesia would not elaborate on how she knew that Darnell was the shooter. At approximately 23:20 hours Detective Sgt. Gilcrest arrived on location. I advised Detective Sgt. Gilcrest on all of the information that was obtained at which time the scene was turned over to him. No further action was taken at this time, more information to follow if and when received.

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
