On June 17, 2019 when I called 911 because Brittany Smalls was violently attacking me when I was going out to my car, were charges not brought against Brittany Smalls on my behalf.

I told 911 operator that I had called 911 several times and that every time I went to my car or came home and tried to go in my house, Brittany Smalls was charging me or parking behind my car and screaming that she was going to cut my white bitch throat. She had a knife on her. She threatened to kill me over and over in front of police as she was handcuffed and being taken to police car she was lunging towards me stating this ain't over bitch - I going to kill you bitch - m over and over before she was handcuffed she went on and on a violent rampage against me. Going on and on about how she hates me calling me violent names and repeatedly stating that she is going to kill me.

Was Vetrano the officer that decided whether charges would be pressed on my behalf?  
Why is this being done to me. Why do I have to spend my everyday trying to write letters and go to police station to get information to keep myself safe. Why am I being charged and found guilty of crimes that is not being explained to me?

I had to tell 911 operator that the police were letting Brittany Smalls go in house and when she came back out the Neptune police officers were letting Brittany Smalls state she was not answering any questions. Then the police came and lied to me stating Brittany Smalls made statements against me which Brittany Smalls just told the Neptune police upon their arrival that she was going in house and when she came out she told police she was not answering questions and they allowed her.

Then the police officers told me I had to figure out how to get along with Brittany Smalls and then laugh and leave. I had to tell 911 operator all of this.

I had to work up courage to call 911 when Brittany Smalls was charging after me when I was going to my car because of the violent way I was being treated by Neptune police and they were helping Brittany Smalls especially Vetrano who stalked the situation and stated he stalked situation. Vetrano lied and stated that he saw me on property before house was built and violently dared me to say otherwise.

Why were charges not pressed against Brittany Smalls that day for threatening to kill me with a knife on her. Why are the Neptune police and Monmouth County prosecutors office defending the Smalls and lying for them and charging me with crimes and not telling me and charging me with crimes on June 17, 2019 so no charges would be made against Smalls.

The Neptune police allowed the father - Smalls to become violent with me the night of June 17 and because I did not call 911 but called 732-988-8000 I am being violently attacked and you are hiding the violence I endured.

Your office with Neptune police set me up for violence.

Your office with neptune pressed charges against me and confused me and did not tell me.

Maura told me if I was found criminal in THIS incident. You are liars and violent manipulators.

Your office conspired with vetrano to illegally commit me and compile a file on me to make me out to be crazy and dismiss every word I say.

Your office conspired and directed the internal affairs and neptune police to discredit my every word violently.

Your office compiled a file against me making up lies that I was crazy and suicidal and that I had guns so I would be shot by police when I called 911.

Years ago I had been violently victimized by my siblings and berardi and his sister and illegally put in mental institution and was sexually assaulted while in mental institution forced drugs that victimized me and took my ability to be me away and the effects were permanent.

Severe crippling abuse. Constant violence from berardis and family members. I was forced to have a surgery that I did not need and remove organs after this by another doctor. I got an infection. I got really sick.

Every time I went to emergency room because I was so sick, I was nastily turned away. I was told that I was being complainy and needy to work harder. My car were vandalized and I had to walk and ride my bike every where. For food for myself and animals.

I walked around like this for years. I kept going back to hospital and was told they do not treat people like me and turned away.

One day I walked in my house and my brother harry was standing there waiting for me. He charged me and had me on floor beating me and choking me. I could not breathe.

The police came. They arrested me. I went to court not understanding what I was being charges with.

I requested a public defender. I was granted a public defender who never spoke to me. I showed up at court spoke to prosecutor and told him I had a public defender the prosecutor said that the public defender said I was to go to anger mangement. I said no . I said I did nothing wrong that I was attacked. When the judge called me she said that the prosecutor said I was to pay money for public defender and I did . a ,lot of money i did not have. I did not realize any charges were brought against me.

I ended up in an induced coma for about a month. All of my organs have really bad scars from walking around with infection and pneumonia for years. I have damage to my organs and severe lung damage. I have severe neuropathies and neuro muscular and nerve damage from poor treatment in icu.

I never saw or spoke to public defender.

You all set me up. You did not tell me why you would not press charges on my behalf. You set me up for hospital to turn me away when sick and victimize me and use me for surgeries I do not need. I was forced into surgeries. Given illegal mental drugs to comply with treatment and forced surgery. I was sexually violated over and over by doctors and hospital staff.

Your office set me up and not tell me what is going on and why I am treated the way I am. Your office did not tell me false charges against me were being used to harm me and confuse me.

Your office did this for revenge to harm me because you are violent criminals. I want my records of what charges are against me. I want to appeal.

Maura in neptune police records manipulates and lies to me.

You are all working together to confuse and harm me. I want to press charges and file report against all involved.

Police told smalls that I have charges and did not tell me to harm me. I am dealing with violence every day and no one is helping me.

Also, public records reveal Cutolo is currently a defendant to an action in NJ federal court ( 3:19-cv-11991). Access to the records above are being sought so as to possibly assist plaintiff (Modica) under the doctrine of amicus curiae.

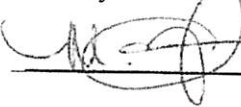
