On the above date and time, I arrived at 138 West 6th Avenue for a report of people screaming outside a residence. When I arrived I observed 2 people screaming at each other, later identified as Philip King and Gina Famiano. King stated that his friend, Christopher Kane, called him and asked him to come over to his residence. King stated that he was told by Kane that his roommate, Gina Famiano, was intoxicated and out of control. King stated that when he arrived that Kane and Famiano were in an argument for approximately 1 hour before the police arrived. King stated that he is missing his wallet and cell phone and he last had them inside the residence.

I then went and spoke with Famiano, who was located next to 138 West 6th Avenue. Famiano did not have any clothing on and was holding several bags in her hand. I advised Famiano several times to put clothes on. Famiano had several articles of clothing in the bags she was holding but was still not getting dressed. After multiple times advising Famiano to get clothes on, she finally put clothing on. I then asked Famiano what happened and she began to ramble on and not make much sense. Famiano stated that she started living at the residence with Kane within the last 2 weeks. Famiano stated that she was in an argument and she can not find her cell phone and she has cigarettes missing. Famiano stated that she wanted King to leave the property and she would wait for Kane to return back home with a key to let her inside.

I advised King that Famiano did not want her on the property and that he would have to leave since Kane had left prior to police arrival. King stated that his wallet is inside the residence with money in it and he wanted his wallet. I then went and spoke with Famiano, and asked her if it was O.K. if I entered her residence thru an open window. Famiano gave me permission. I then entered the residence and opened the door for Famiano. Officer Zalesaki and I checked the residence for King's wallet and cell phone with negative results. I advised King that after Kane returns back to his residence and he still can not find his items, to call the police department. I also advised Famiano that she could sign a complaint for theft of her cell phone and cigarettes if she is not able to find them.

On July 17, 2017 at approximately 1723 hrs. myself and my partner, SLEO I Scibilia #1738, responded to 138 West 6th Avenue for a report of a disorderly person. Upon arrival, we spoke with Gina Famiano who stated that she has been staying at this location with Christopher Kane for approximately two months and that the two of them had a disagreement because she wanted to get into the residence and he wouldn't let her. Famiano stated that Kane left prior to our arrival after she told him that she was going to call the police.

During our conversation with Famiano, she stated that she felt as though she may have been sexually assaulted by Kane over the course of the prior night. After Famiano made that statement, I contacted dispatch and requested that a detective respond to our location, and also contacted Sgt. McGraw #242 and requested that he also respond to our location. We were also able to make contact with Christopher Kane via the telephone and request that he come back to our location so we could speak with him about the incident he just had with Famiano. A short time later, Famiano was transported by Ofc. Tolan Jr. #262 to Cape Regional Medical Center to have a sexual assault kit completed. Christopher Kane also arrived back home and spoke to Det. Elliott #256. At this time the investigation was turned over to Det. Elliott.

On Monday, July 17th 2017 at approximately 1730hrs. I, Sgt. McGraw was contacted by Ofc. Massie #241, who requested me to respond to 138 West 6th Avenue for a possible sexual assault. Upon arrival, I spoke to Ofc. Massie who advised me of the situation. He stated that the victim, Gina Famiano alleged being sexually assaulted by accused, Christopher Kane, who also resides at this location. Ofc. Massie also advised me that Mr. Kane was enroute back to this location shortly.

I walked to the rear of the property and came in contact with Famiano, who was sitting on the back steps of unit B. She began to tell me that last night while inside the apartment, she was hanging out with a friend named "Phil King" and Christopher Kane. During the course of the night, Kane gave her a Gatorade bottle that contained blue liquid and that was already open. She remembered complaining to Kane that the bottle was already open. He told her that he took a sip of the blue Gatorade. While she sat on the couch drinking the Gatorade, she began to feel light headed and her head became "foggy". She remembered getting up off the couch and walking to the bathroom and then the next time she remembered laying on the couch. She made mention that she was fully clothed as this point. Then she stated that she woke up in the bedroom, naked. She mentioned that she felt that Kane had put something in the Gatorade bottle to make her pass out. She also stated that she felt uncomfortable in her private area as too having sexual intercourse. She stated, that she has never had any sexual relations with Kane in the past.

During the course of talking with Famiano, her story kept jumping around as if her recollection of the prior night was coming back to her as she spoke with me. She also mentioned that she contacted her friend "Phil King" this morning and asked him what happened last night. He told her that she went into the bathroom and remained inside the bathroom for approximately 25 minutes. He told Kane that she was inside the bathroom for a long time and that Kane went into the bathroom with her. He was inside the bathroom for a period of time and when he went to check on them, Kane opened the door and assisted her to the couch. He told her that he left the residence at approximately 0230hrs. Famiano also stated that the cops were called earlier this morning and that she was "running around the neighborhood" naked. She said the cops were there and told her to put clothes on. She said that Kane put her belongings on the porch and that she wasn't allowed to reenter the apartment without him being there. So she said she walked around town the entire day. She said she contacted Kane throughout the day to get back in the apartment. He told her, she couldn't return until he was finished work. Famiano made mention that she couldn't locate the black pair of panties she was wearing from the night before, even though she was wearing the same outfit she had on from the night before.

Detectives Elliott and Melo arrived on scene and I advised them of the situation. I advised Famiano to tell Det. Elliott her account of the situation. A short time later, Kane arrived on scene. I spoke with Kane out front of the property. He stated that he arrived home from working all day to Famiano and "Phil King" inside the apartment.

On July 17th, 2017 at approximately 1730 hours, myself and Det. Melo #255 responded to 138 W 6th Avenue, Unit B, regarding an alleged sexual assault that took place during the early morning hours on this date. Upon our arrival, I walked to the rear of the property where the victim, Gina M. Famiano, was sitting on the steps outside of Unit B. At this time, Famiano was speaking with Sgt. McGraw #242 giving her account of what took place earlier in the day. (See Sgt. McGraw's #242 Supplemental Report).

After several minutes, I began to ask Famiano questions regarding whether she had taken a shower at any point during the day or if she was still wearing the same clothes/underwear from when the incident occurred. Famiano stated that she had not showered and was wearing the same outfit but had changed her underwear. I advised Famiano that it would necessary for us to transport her to Cape Regional Medical Center to have a Forensic Nurse perform an examination and obtain evidence for this investigation. Famiano was initially hesitant to go to the hospital after I told her that it would take a couple hours for the Forensic Nurse to perform the evaluation. Famiano stated that she wanted to go but she previously made plans with her daughter, who she only get to see when she is sober, to go to the boardwalk. I advised Famiano that allegations she made against Kane were very serious and the only way to find out if something happened is if she got the evaluation done at the hospital. I asked Famiano if she was nervous for us to find out what might come up in her system during the evaluation, which she shook her head in an up and down manner commonly used for a "Yes" response. I asked Famiano what we might find in her system, which she stated "Opiates, maybe some marijuana and I'm on methadone". Famiano later agreed to go to Cape Regional Medical Center, which she was transported by Ofc. Kevin Tolan Jr. #262.

At this time, Christopher Kane arrived on scene. I advised Kane about the incident and what Famiano was alleging against him. After briefing Kane, I requested for consent to search his residence, which he agreed to. I filled out the necessary paperwork and upon its completion, Kane allowed us to enter his residence. While Det. Melo and I were searching Kane's residence, Kane stated that he was with his ex-girlfriend, Melanie Slabik, at her house to obtain an air conditioner due to him recently moving into a new apartment. Kane stated that he was at Slabik's house for approximately an hour and returned to his house around 2330 hours. Upon his arrival, he noticed a black male sitting on the couch in the living room. Kane stated that this was the first time he saw the black male and asked where Famiano was, which he pointed in the direction of the bathroom. Kane walked towards the bathroom, where he found the door slightly ajar. Upon knocking several times, asking Famiano if she was okay and having no response, Kane opened the door and found Famiano passed out on the bathroom floor, naked.

Kane then picked Famiano up and sat her down on the couch. The black male had left the residence while Kane was attempting to make contact with Famiano in the bathroom. After placing Famiano on the couch, Kane placed ice under her arm pits and on her neck. Kane stated that he took a picture of Famiano with his cellphone, while she was still passed out, and sent it to their mutual friend, Philip King, stating something to the effect of "This is what I'm dealing with". At this time, King engaged Kane in conversation via text message and advised him that he was going to come by his residence because he felt like he didn't have a handle on the situation.

While waiting for King to arrive at the residence, Kane stated that Famiano began to regain consciousness and was agitated that she was naked on his couch. Famiano began to engage Kane in a verbal altercation accusing him of taking her clothes off and drugging her. At approximately 0330 hours, King arrived at Kane's residence. Kane stated that Famiano was out of control and when she was told to put clothes on, she completely ignored them and walked outside. King suggested to Kane to call the police to have Famiano checked out but Kane did not want to draw any negative attention to the area because he just moved into his apartment. Kane stated that this continued for approximately 2 hours before King noticed his wallet, which contained an estimated \$2200 in cash, and cellphone missing from a table directly inside the residence. King confronted Famiano about taking his belongings, which she then left the residence again while still not being clothed. King then followed Famiano outside, where she later punched King in the face after they had engaged in a verbal argument about his missing belongings. Kane stated that he left the residence while King was on the phone with police dispatch because he did not want to be involved and did not need the headache. (See Case #: 17-25642 for further details).

During the course of the consent to search, I took possession of several items for evidentiary purposes, which Kane was provided a receipt of the items seized. King also arrived on scene during this time and advised to meet me at the police department to provide a statement. I advised Kane that I appreciated him talking to me on scene and requested him to contact me later to provide a formal statement. Kane stated that he had nothing to hide and welcomed me to come back to his residence again if I needed anything further.

I then returned back to the police department with Det. Melo #255. I met with King in the lobby and escorted him back to the Interview Room. During the interview with King, he explained that Famiano is a friend of his who he has known for several years. Famiano had recently fell on hard times and needed a place to stay, which King was unable to house her and asked Kane if he could help her out. Kane eventually agreed to temporarily house Famiano until she could find another suitable place to stay.

King stated that during a recent conversation he had with Famiano on the previous day, she advised him that she had a "date" set up for that evening. Famiano previously informed King about an ad she had on Backpage.com. King stated that he wasn't completely blind to what Famiano was doing and knew she was prostituting to support her drug habit. King advised me that Famiano contacted him the previous night. During their conversation, Famiano advised King that she was on a date and "getting ready too fuck the shit out of this guy".

King also explained what had happened while he was at Kane's residence. During the time he was there, Famiano was completely uncontrollable and after about two hours his wallet and cell phone went missing, which became a big concern for him because he had recently received approximately \$2200 from a check that his grandmother had left him after she passed away. King stated that he didn't believe Kane to be capable of sexually assaulting Famiano but could not say for sure. I spoke with King a while longer and later concluded the statement. (This is not a full transcription of King's statement. See DVD-R labeled "Statement of Philip King" for a full transcription of his statement).

Shortly after completing King's statement, I was contact by Ofc. Tolan Jr. #262. Ofc Tolan Jr. #262 advised me that Famiano was becoming uncooperative with the Forensic Nurse for taking too long and wanted to leave the hospital. I advised Ofc. Tolan Jr. #262 to bring Famiano back to the police department at the completion of the examination so I could conduct a formal interview.

Ofc. Tolan Jr. #262 returned with Famiano and escorted her into the lobby. I later met with Famiano and asked if she wanted to provide a formal statement regarding the incident. Famiano advised me that she was very tired and just wanted to see her daughter. I advised Famiano that it was necessary to get a statement from her in order to move forward with this investigation. Famiano advised me that she would contact me the following day to set up a time to meet at the police department.

On July 18th, 2017 I was contacted by Kane who advised me that Famiano had text/called him on numerous occasions throughout the night and morning. I later met with Kane to review text messages Famiano sent him. In one of the text messages Famiano sent Kane, Famiano writes "I'm sorry I didn't realize what had happened I am truly sorry if there was anything I could do u would". A second message sent immediately after by Famiano, writes "I won't talk to them and I'll tell them u were helping me OK". Kane was able to screen shot pictures of their conversation and send them to me, which will be attached to this case file.

Several days passed without hearing from Famiano. It was learned that Famiano was involved in an two separate incidents in Wildwood, which resulted in her being arrested and later transported to Cape May County Correctional Facility as a result of her charges. On July 27th, 2017 I contacted Det. Kourtney Perry of the Cape May County Sheriff's Department - Corrections and requested to speak with Famiano regarding this investigation. At approximately 1400 hours, I responded to the Cape May County Correctional Facility to speak with Famiano.

During my brief conversation with Famiano, stated that she did not wish to pursue this investigation any further as she had multiple charges to take care of now due to her drug use. Famiano continued to state that she was originally unsure if she was really sexually assaulted by Kane because she was so messed up on several different drugs that she didn't feel herself to begin with. When I asked Famiano who the black male was on the night of the incident, she stated it was her dealer. I asked Famiano if she had a "date" that night, which she stated she did but that was earlier in the night and everything afterwards was a blur. I explained the Waiver of Prosecution paperwork to Famiano, which she later signed. I advised Famiano if she had any further questions related to this incident to contact me. This concluded my conversation with Famiano.

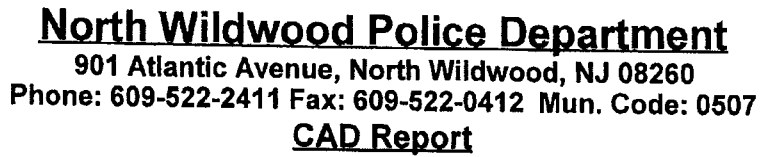

On the above date and time, I responded to 138 West 6th Avenue Rear 1st Floor for a report of a female banging on a door. When I arrived I spoke with the caller, Christopher Kane, who stated that "Gina Famiano" just woke him up banging on the door. I then searched the area for Gina and located her in a neighbors fenced in yard at 601 New York Avenue. I asked Famiano what she was doing and she stated that she was gathering her belongings up from the yard. I asked Famiano where she was staying and she stated, "No where, not here". Famiano stated she was charging her phone and then said, "Actually, I will get the fuck out". Famiano was using an exterior outlet to charge her phone at 601 New York Avenue. As Famiano was picking up her bags and getting her cell phone she began yelling obscenities and I had to advise her to keep her voice down as it was around 0300hrs. Famiano then went to 138 West 6th Avenue to retrieve her bicycle, as she continued to yell. I had to advise her again to keep her voice down. Famiano then got on her bicycle and left the area.

While I was outside of 138 West 6th Avenue, speaking with Officer Kopetsky #260, Famiano showed back up in the fenced in yard of 601 New York Avenue. Famiano was attempting to charge her phone again by using the exterior outlet from 601 New York Avenue. Famiano started screaming and stated, "I am fucking out, you guys got me, I am fucking out". Famiano then ripped her phone out of the charger and exited the yard. Famiano was now standing on the sidewalk and continued to scream. Famiano then reentered the fenced in yard and started to charge her phone again. I told Famiano that she has to leave and can not stay in the back yard. Famiano said that she was allowed in the yard as it is her aunt's mothers house. I asked Famiano who owned the house as I was going to confirm with my dispatcher. Famiano did not answer me and continued to charge her phone. I advised Famiano that she can not steal the electric from the residence. Famiano then took her phone out of the outlet and exited the yard as she continued to scream. Famiano appeared to be under the influence of drugs as she was acting very erratic. Famiano would go from being calm and talking normal and then all of a sudden start screaming and not following simple directions.

I then walked around the property to make sure Famiano left the residence. As I was standing in front of 601 New York Avenue, Famiano had already reentered the yard. I asked Famiano where she was going and she stated she was going to Chris's (138 W 6th Avenue) to get a trash bag (It should be noted Christopher Kane was the person who called the police on Famiano). Famiano then started to walk toward me while continuing to scream. I advised Famiano again that she had to keep her voice down. Famiano ignored my order and continued to scream, as she was now within 5 feet of me and continued to approach me. I then told Famiano that she was under arrest, as I grabbed her wrist, as she was walking past me.

Famiano then suddenly turned around and was now facing me and attempted to swing her left arm out of my grasp and stated, "How, I didn't do nothing". I then performed a leg sweep and placed Famiano on the grass and handcuffed her. Famiano continued to scream very loudly the entire time until finally being placed in a police vehicle. Famiano was then transported to the police department by Officer Guglielmo #1713.

Officer Kopetsky and I then began to gather her belongings to bring them back to the police department. I noticed a pill bottle with no label on it in her purse, later identified as 10 1/2 Seroquel pills. Once back at the police department, Famiano also had 9 bags containing suspected heroin stored in a laptop cover and 4 needles in her purse. Famiano also had multiple wallets, driver's licenses and other items in her bags, as they were stored at the police department until their owner's have been contacted.

Judge Belasco authorized a warrant and Famiano was later transported to the Cape May County Correctional Center.

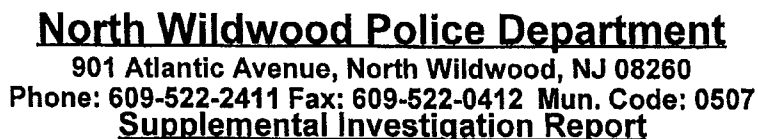

On July 21, 2017 at approximately 1006 hours I met with the accused, Gina Famiano in regards to this incident. During this time she was read her miranda rights which she signed and stated she agreed to speak with me without an attorney present. During our interview she did admit to possessing bags of heroin which she stated were to her belief empty. She also admitted to possessing the needle. During our conversation we further spoke about the wallets she was in possession of. At first she stated they were friends of hers that allowed her to have them. After some further discussion she admitted to engaging in prostitution and stated that two of the wallets came from recent clients of hers who knew she had them. She described the one client as "Dimitri" her former boss who works at Slice restaurant in North Wildwood. Famiano further said that she was last with him last night and he paid her \$80.00 for her time but insisted that did not have any sexual contact. Famiano said that she was in Dimitri's truck and took his wallet as well as a second one belonging to one of his workers.

I asked her about any past experiences with Dimitri, and she stated that he recently paid for oral sex during the weekend of July 7th, 2017. Famiano said that he paid her \$60.00 and they were in his vehicle in the area of 6th and the bay. She further stated that she had numerous other clients, all of whom she meets via backpage.com. Famiano said on this website she goes by the name "Heaven."

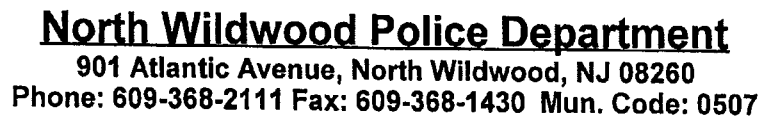
