RE: OPRA request for records regarding "Code Blue Program"

Dear OEM Coordinator Mastronardy and Ocean County Records Custodian:

On behalf of the American Civil Liberties Union of New Jersey, I write to inquire about Ocean County's response to its obligations under N.J.S.A. A:9-43.18, et seq. (hereinafter, "the Act"), requiring that the County establish a "Code Blue Program" for at-risk individuals experiencing homelessness, and to request information pursuant to the Open Public Records Act, N.J.S.A. 47:1A-1, et seq., and the common law right of citizens of the state to obtain access to public documents. South Jersey Publishing Co. v. New Jersey Expressway Auth., 124 N.J. 478, 487-89 (1991).

As you are no doubt aware, the Act requires the County Office of Emergency Management – or its appropriate equivalent – to "coordinate with municipal emergency management coordinators in municipalities with a documented homeless population of at least 10, as noted in the most recent Annual Point In Time Count, in developing consistent Code Blue alert plans . . . that provide for emergency warming centers during implementation of a Code Blue alert plan." N.J.S.A. A:9-43.19. The OEM Coordinator must issue a Code Blue Alert "within 24 to 48 hours" in advance of: (1) "temperatures [that] will reach 25 degrees Fahrenheit or lower without precipitation or 32 degrees Fahrenheit or lower with precipitation;" or (2) a "windchill temperature [of] zero degrees Fahrenheit or less for a period of two hours or more." N.J.S.A. A:9-43.20.

Given the strong likelihood that temperatures will drop below relevant thresholds in the coming weeks if not days, and 2017 data reflecting 224 persons currently experiencing homelessness in Ocean County,¹ we request the following information:

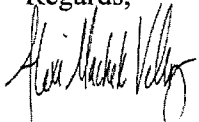
1. All records pertaining to the Code Blue Alert Plan currently in effect in Ocean County;
2. A list of all municipalities within Ocean County that are subject to the Act pursuant to such municipality's documented homeless population of ten (10) or more individuals, including, where possible, (a) the specific documented homeless population within such municipality; and (2) the name of such municipality's "municipal emergency management coordinator." N.J.S.A. A:9-43.19
3. Records reflecting the names of any organizations, groups, individuals, and/or entities with whom the County has arranged to provide emergency warming centers or shelter in the event of a future Code Blue Alert;
4. All records pertaining to agreements between the County and any "volunteer organizations," groups, individuals, and/or entities with whom the County has designated to implement the County's current Code Blue Alert Plan. N.J.S.A. A:9-43.19;
5. Any materials published, produced, or presented by the County and/or its representatives that describe or are used in implementing the County's *current* Code Blue Alert Plan; and
6. All records pertaining to the County's *current* Code Blue Alert Plan detailing the planned provision of transportation to deliver at-risk individuals to local shelters and/or emergency warming centers in the event of a Code Blue Alert.

If you determine that any portion of the above-requested records are exempt from release, we request that you redact the portion that you believe exempt and provide us with copies of the remaining, non-exempt portions. If any or part of this request is denied, please send letter describing the material and listing the specific exemption(s) on which you rely.

If the cost of copies for this request does not exceed \$10, proceed without further approval and send me an invoice with the records. Otherwise, please advise me of the costs before filling the request so that we can discuss arrangements.
