Narrative:										
Narrative Michael Heck contacted this agency stating he believed someone just stole his vehicle. Mr. Heck gave a description of his vehicle and said it appeared to have traveled West, on Hume Street, towards Main Street. Sgt DiBona and Ptl Williams both responded. The vehicle description and license plate number were broadcast over the County Hotline. Asbury Park PD reported they were behind the vehicle and were attempting to stop it. The unidentified driver continued to drive and refused to pull over. Asbury Park PD continued to follow the vehicle, until it crashed at the intersection of Neptune Blvd. and Bingham Street, in Neptune Township. The unidentified driver then fled on foot. Sgt DiBona headed to the crash scene, while Ptl. Williams responded to 308 Hume Street, to meet with the caller. Deal Police was requested for assistance, to cover incoming calls, as per Sgt. DiBona.

while both Allenhurst units were out with the stolen vehicle. Asbury Park PD requested a tracking dog to look for the driver that had fled on foot. Ptl Smith, from Spring Lake Police Department, and Sheriff Officer Kroeper, from Monmouth County Sheriff's Department, responded. Both K9's did an exterior sniff of the car and tracked the scent to the woods behind the Crystal Inn, at the Asbury Circle. Officers from Asbury Park, Neptune, Spring Lake and Monmouth County Sheriffs Office conducted a search of the suspect with negative results. Sgt. DiBona requested Atlantic Towing be called, to bring the vehicle back to headquarters for processing and had Ptl. Williams stand by with the vehicle until Atlantic Towing arrived on scene. Atlantic Towing brought the vehicle back to Police Hq, where it was parked in the front driveway of headquarters. Inside the vehicle was a black backpack, which the owner said did not belong to him. The backpack was brought inside by Ptl. Williams and was searched, where a social security card, birth certificate, and financial papers, with a name of Daquane Dana Esdaile, with a date of birth of 1/22/1993 on it, along with other miscellaneous items. All items were inventoried, photographed and were placed back in the backpack, and then it was placed in the evidence locker. Investigation to continue.
