Dear Ms. Murphy,

This office received your records request dated November 27, 2019 on November 27, 2019 and it was received by the records custodian on the same date. Based on our conversations you have agreed to extend the time to respond. You requested the following:

The complete Monmouth County Prosecutor's File, including but not limited to a copy of the police reports, investigation records, witness statements, videos, photographs, pleadings, transcripts, medical records, and files and/or records from Hazlet Township Police Department or Sayreville Police Department, and any other records related to the assault and battery against Theodore H. Reick that occurred on or about December 30, 2016 at the Knights Inn located at 7089 NJ-35, South Amboy, NJ 08879; and the complete Monmouth County Prosecutor's file including but not limited to a copy of the police reports, investigation records, witness statements, videos, photographs, pleadings, transcripts, medical records, and files and/or records from Hazlet Township Police Department or Sayreville Police Department, and any other records related to the assault and battery against Theodore H. Reick that occurred on or about December 30, 2016 at 6 Ann Court, Hazlet, NJ 07730.

First, OPRA does not authorize a party to make a blanket request for "any and all documents" related to a file. Bent v. Township of Stafford Police Dept., Custodian of Records, 381 N.J. Super. 30, 37, 39 (App. Div. 2005). The requestor's obligation is to specifically describe the document sought; the request may not be a broad, generic description of documents because the custodian is not required to speculate about what the requestor seeks, nor survey agency employees regarding the request. Bart v. Passaic Cnty. Pub. Hous. Agency, 406 N.J. Super. 445, 451-52 (App. Div. 2009). Therefore, your general request cannot be fulfilled as it neither identifies nor describes with any specificity or particularity the records sought. MAG Entertainment, LLC v. Division of Alcoholic Beverage Control, 375 N.J. Super. 534 (App. Div. 2005), New Jersey Builders Association v. New Jersey Council on Affordable Housing, 390 N.J.

Super. 166 (App. Div. 2007), certif. denied, 190 N.J. 394 (2007), and Schuler v. Borough of Bloomsbury, GRC Complaint No. 2007-151 (February 2009).

In addition, your request for prosecution files that contains police reports, witness statements, videos, photographs, medical records is a request for criminal investigatory records. N.J.S.A. 47:1A-1.1 defines a criminal investigatory record: A record which is not required by law to be made, maintained or kept on file that is held by a law enforcement agency, which pertains to any criminal investigation. "Criminal investigatory files include records involving all manner of crimes, resolved or unresolved, and include information that is part and parcel of an investigation, confirmed or unconfirmed." Janeczko v. New Jersey Department of Law and Public Safety, GRC Complaint Nos. 2002-79 and 2002-80, Analysis and Conclusion; Nance v. Scotch Plains Township Police Department Custodian of Record, GRC Complaint No. 2003-125. Police reports are not part of public record. R. 1:38-3(f)(3). Criminal investigatory records are exempt from disclosure in response to an OPRA request. N.J.S.A. 47:1A-1.1(1). North Jersey Media Group, Inc. v. Township of Lyndhurst, 229 N.J. 541 (July 11, 2017).

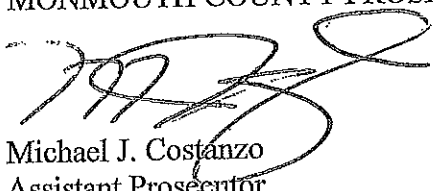

Lastly, OPRA is a public disclosure statute and is not intended to replace or supplement the discovery of private litigants. Constantine v. Township of Bass River, 406 N.J. Super. 305, 324-25 (App. Div. 2009), certif. denied, 200 N.J. 208 (2009); MAG Entertainment, LLC v. Division of Alcoholic Beverage Control, 375 N.J. Super. 534, 545-46 (App. Div. 2005). **If you are involved in civil litigation related to this matter, please send a written request for civil discovery to the Director of the Trial Division Assistant Prosecutor Sean Brennan. Please do not reference OPRA.**

In the event of a clarification or appeal, this office reserves the right to raise any other ground for denial not raised in this response. The failure of this office to assert an exception or privilege at this time does not act as a waiver of any grounds for denial.

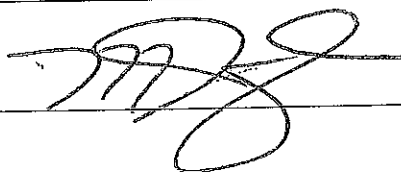

and either mailed or taken directly to the Prosecutor's Office. This office also accepts requests by fax when clearly addressed to the attention of the "OPRA Custodian of Records." This office accepts requests by email **ONLY** at the following address: opra@mcponj.org. See Paff v. City of East Orange, 407 N.J. Super. 221, 227-28 (App. Div.), certif. denied, 200 N.J. 476 (2009). When a request is received by email, a confirmation of receipt will be sent in reply; until and unless a reply confirmation is received, requestors should not assume their email request was received by the records custodian. Ibid. Requests sent to other email addresses and/or not addressed to the OPRA Custodian of Records may not be received by the Custodian.

A Right to Discovery is Separate and Distinct from a Right to Access Public Records.

OPRA is a public disclosure statute and is **not** intended to replace or supplement the discovery of private litigants. Constantine v. Township of Bass River, 406 N.J. Super. 305, 324-25 (App. Div. 2009), certif. denied, 200 N.J. 208 (2009); MAG Entertainment, LLC v. Division of Alcoholic Beverage Control, 375 N.J. Super. 534, 545-46 (App. Div. 2005). Requests for discovery of materials that are not public government records should be made in accordance with the applicable Court Rules.

Procedure for Filing an Appeal.

A person who is denied access to a government record by the custodian of the record, at the option of the requestor, may:

Institute a proceeding to challenge the custodian's decision by filing an action in Monmouth County Superior Court which shall be heard by a Superior Court Judge who has been designated to hear such cases because of that judge's knowledge and expertise in matters relating to access to government records;

Or in lieu of filing an action in Superior Court, file a complaint with the Government Records Council established in subsection 8 of P.L.2001, c.404 (C.47:1A-7).

The right to institute any proceeding under this section shall be solely that of the requestor. Any such proceeding shall proceed in a summary or expedited manner. The public agency shall have the burden of proving that the denial of access is authorized by law. If it is determined that access has been improperly denied, the court or agency head shall order that access be allowed. A requestor who prevails in any proceeding shall be entitled to a reasonable attorney's fee.

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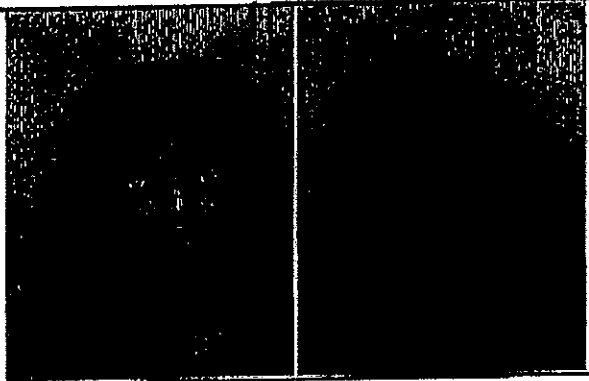

The suspects then entered the victim's residence where they assaulted both occupants in the burglary before leaving with one of the resident's vehicle, a 2016 Nissan Altima. Tucker further admitted that during this time she was in another vehicle just outside the residence where she was in possession of a handgun.

Tucker was subsequently charged on compliant W2017-000031-1339 on transported to the Middlesex County Correctional Facility by the Sayreville Police.

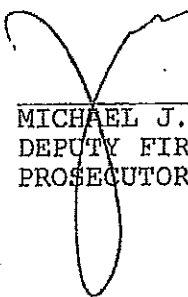

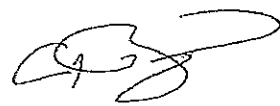

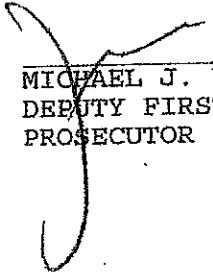
