For background, the New Jersey Attorney General's Office Vehicular Pursuit Policy states:

"Every law enforcement agency shall conduct an investigation when one of its vehicles collides with another vehicle or any other object during the course of a pursuit. The investigation shall determine whether the collision could have been prevented. A copy of the report shall be made available to the county prosecutor. In every case where the collision could have been prevented, the report shall set forth the actions taken by the agency to address the cause or causes of the collision (e.g. remedial training, revision of department policy, disciplinary action, etc.)"

We ask that you release records as each becomes available for public disclosure. Please do not temporarily withhold one record that has been approved for public disclosure because you require additional time to review others.

We ask that these records be provided electronically and sent by e-mail (aford3@gannettnj.com) or through a cloud-based file storage system such as DropBox. An upload link can be provided.

We respectfully request that any fees be waived since the records will be used for newsgathering purposes and ultimately released to the public in some form to shed light on the operations of government. If the agency expects to require payment for copies, record location or other elements of the request, please provide a fee estimate before proceeding so that I may weigh the cost and consider my options.

If you claim any portion of the above public records are exempt from disclosure under the law, please provide a Vaughn index identifying which records exist, which portion or portions you claim are exempt and the legal provisions you contend apply, and release the remainder of such records, redacting only the portion or portions you claim are exempt.

At each Strike Force Checkpoint, the senior ranking officer shall supervise the operation.

At all checkpoint locations, warning signs and signal lights, (e.g., flares) shall be set up by officers at a safe stopping distance from the checkpoint. Checkpoints on curves, crest of hills, or narrow roadways are to be avoided. Where possible, checkpoints shall be established near off road areas (e.g., parking lots).

The Stopping of vehicles shall be in accordance with the guidelines set forth in Delaware v. Prouse, (e.g., every vehicle, every fifth vehicle). The pattern of such stopping will be determined by the supervising officer before the operation begins and will depend upon traffic conditions. Should the traffic flow increase or decrease significantly, the supervisor officer shall modify the pattern for stopping vehicles. Any such modifications shall be noted in a DWI Strike Force report and the time of such change shall be recorded. The pre-determined, stopping pattern for a particular operation shall be adhered to strictly.

As each vehicle is stopped, the driver shall be advised in a courteous manner of the reason for the stop. Each driver shall receive a hand-out explaining the purpose of the checkpoint.
