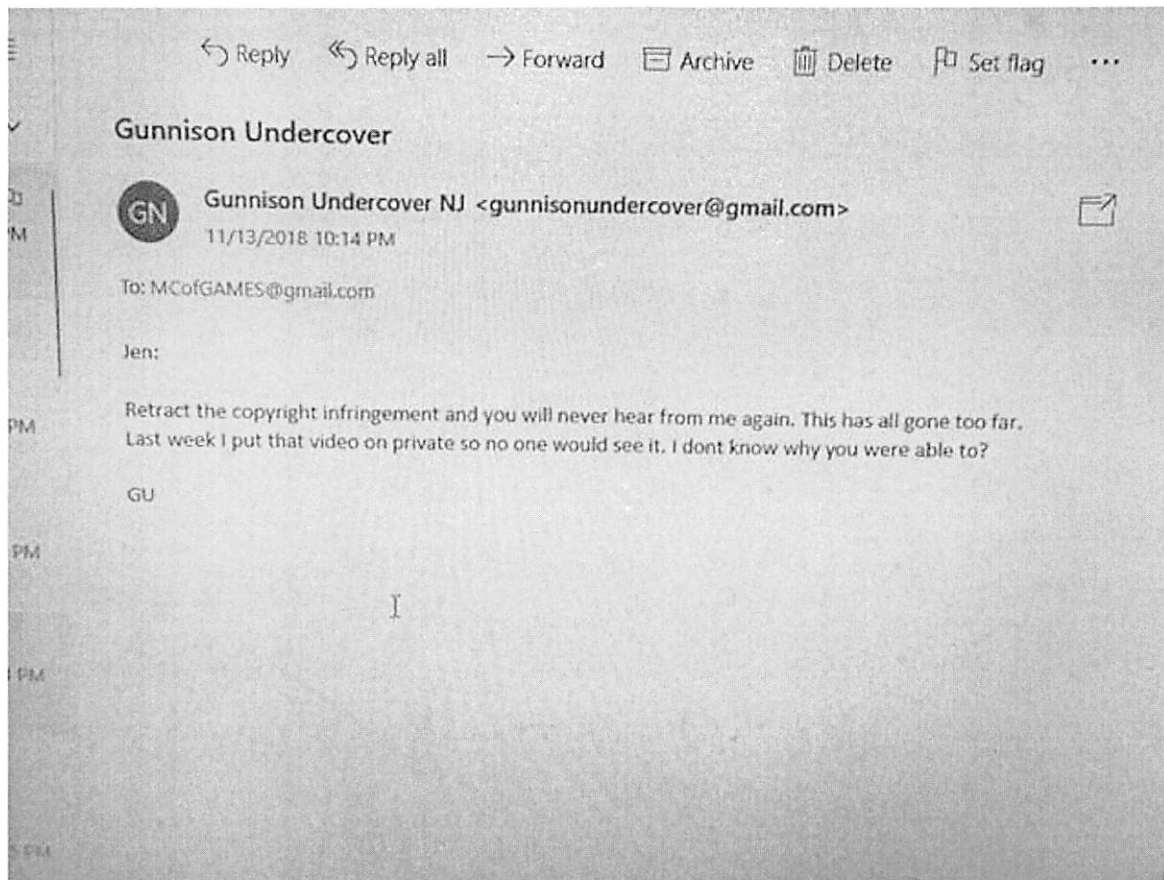

I'm not certain whether or not the issues you raise are prosecutable under the criminal statutes, but you may have a civil cause of action. Have you consulted with a private attorney?

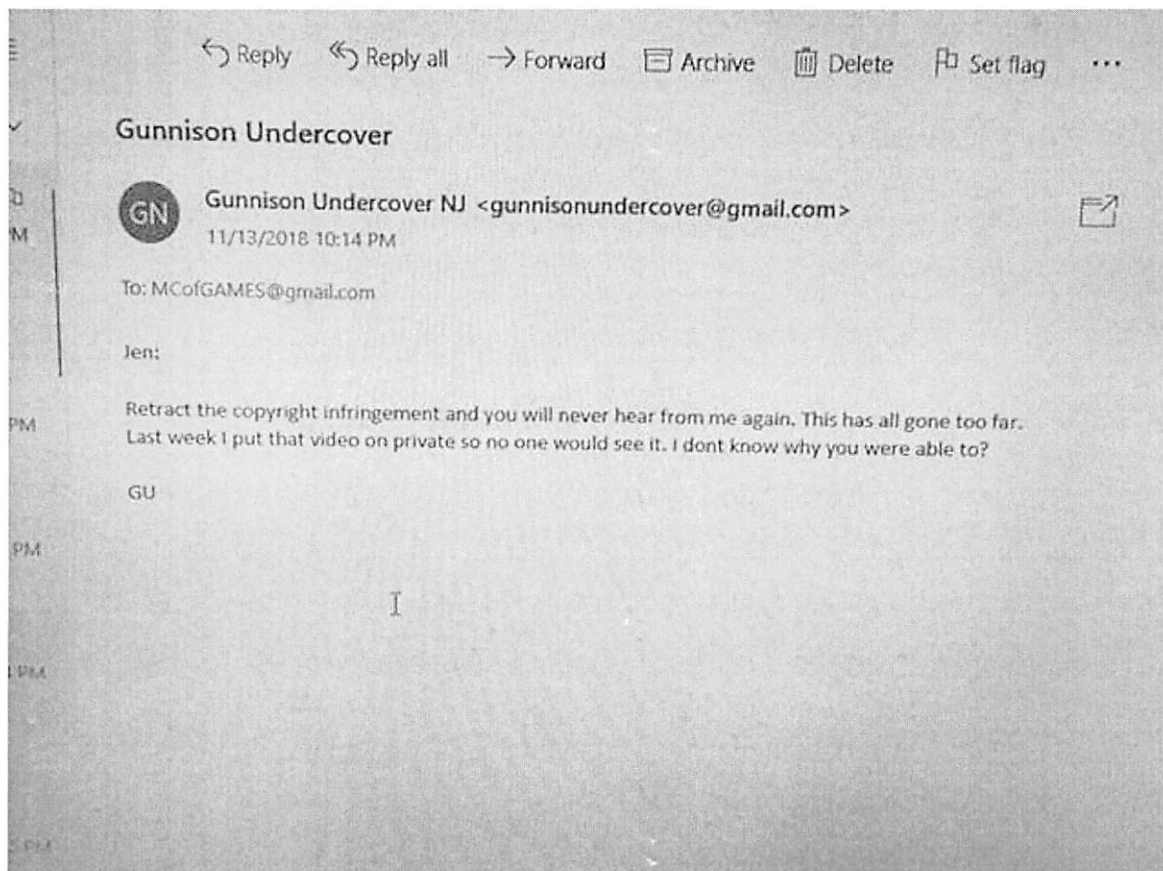

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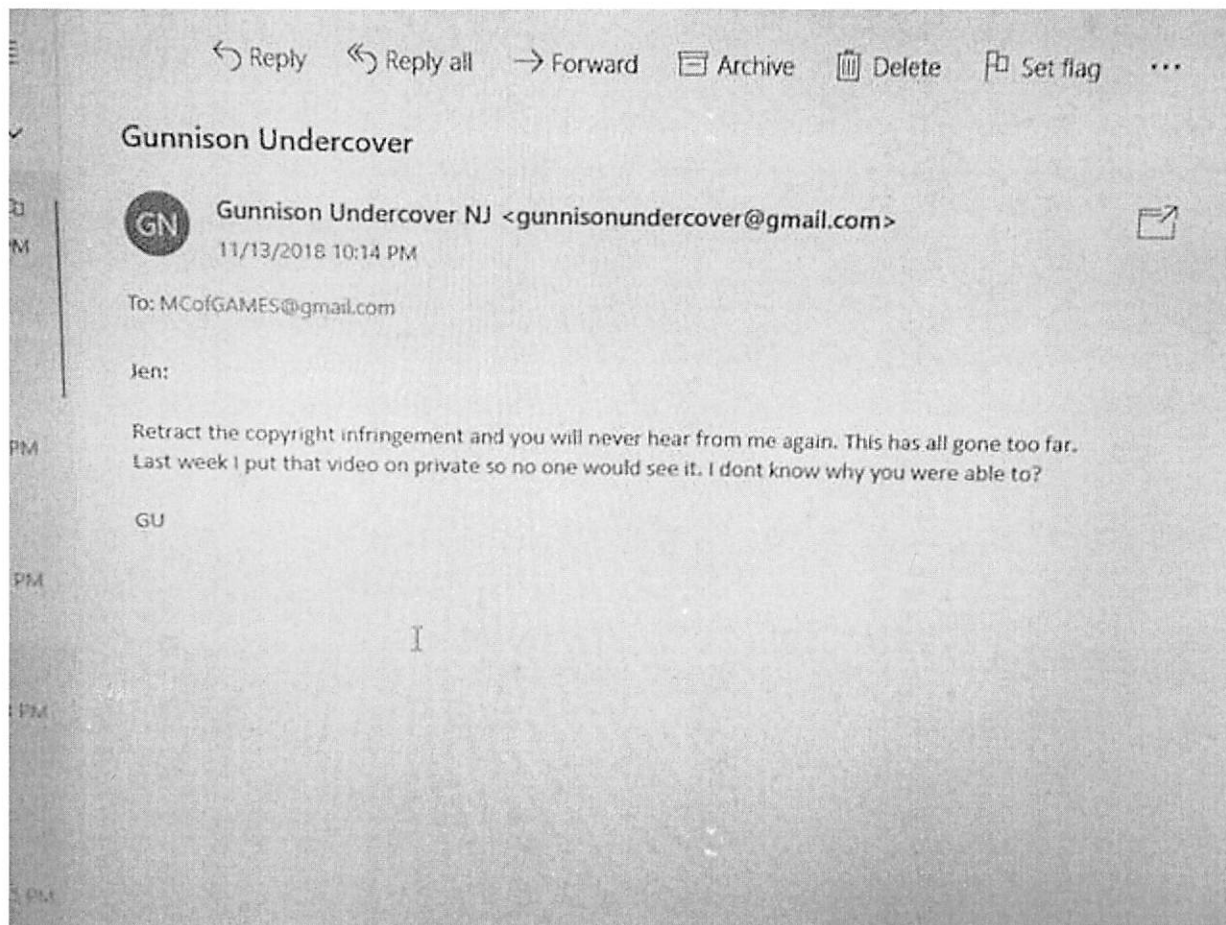
