The Ocean City Police Department received your Open Public Records Act (OPRA) request on July 14, 2025. The official Records Custodian, Melissa Rasner, received your OPRA request on July 14, 2025. As such, the seven (7) business day deadline to respond to your request is July 23, 2025. This response to your request is being provided to you on the 2nd business day after the custodian's receipt of said request.

The following records are being provided with some redactions and are responsive to your request. The redactions are based on the following:

N.J.S.A. 47:1A-1

Privacy Interest- "a public agency has a responsibility and an obligation to safeguard from public access a citizens personal information with which it has been entrusted when disclosure thereof would violate the citizens reasonable expectation of privacy."

HIPPA data – data classified under the "Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act of 1996," Pub.L.104-191.

If your request for access to a government record has been denied or unfilled within the seven (7) business days required by law, you have a right to challenge the decision by the [insert name of agency] to deny access. At your option, you may either institute a proceeding in the Superior Court of New Jersey or file a complaint with the Government Records Council (GRC) by completing the Denial of Access Complaint Form. You may contact the GRC by toll-free telephone at 866-850-0511, by mail at P.O. Box 819, Trenton, NJ, 08625, by e-mail at grc@dca.state.nj.us, or at their web site at www.state.nj.us/grc. The GRC can also answer other questions about the law. All questions regarding complaints filed in Superior Court should be directed to the Court Clerk in your County.
