Incident: Non-Fatal Overdose

Location: 1st Street Beach Patrol Headquarters / Public Restroom

Report:

On July 19, 2024, at approximately 2:01 PM, Ptl. Crowley and I were dispatched to the above listed location for a report of an unconscious person. Upon our arrival we were met by the Ocean City Beach Patrol that reported to us that they had administered one dose of Narcan. Beach Patrol found [REDACTED] laying on the floor of the family bathroom, and her husband [REDACTED] attempting to render aid. [REDACTED]

The Fire Department arrived shortly after and administered a second dose of Narcan. [REDACTED] regained consciousness a few minutes afterwards and responded to questions. [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] both denied that narcotics were used or present in the bathroom. She was transported to Shore Medical Center in Somers Point.

In the bathroom, Detective Jenkins located multiple empty wax folds, multiple wax folds that contained suspected heroin, one hypodermic needle, and a cap for another hypodermic needle in a bag that belonged to [REDACTED]

The Controlled Dangerous Substance and its paraphernalia were seized and submitted for destruction then placed in the top right evidence locker. The OD Mapping Form was completed. An L-3 case has been created for all associated video evidence for this case, and email notifications have been sent to police records and IT.

No further action taken by this officer.
