INCIDENT: Non-Fatal Drug Overdose

LOCATION: [REDACTED] Wesley Apartment [REDACTED]

REPORT:

On January 28, 2024, at 1754 hours, I was dispatched to [REDACTED] Wesley Avenue, apartment [REDACTED] for a possible overdose. Central Communications informed responding units that [REDACTED], the 911 caller, believed that her son, [REDACTED] was overdosing due to a phone call that she had just received from him.

Upon arrival, Ptl. Rauner and I entered the property and made our way to the apartment. As we got to [REDACTED] room, he came out on his own accord and claimed that he had taken a "dope ticket" and felt sick. [REDACTED] claimed that he called his mother, [REDACTED], and asked her to take him to the hospital due to feeling close to an overdose. [REDACTED] described his ears ringing and then passing out briefly before waking up and walking out of his apartment.

[REDACTED] claimed that [REDACTED] has a history of drug abuse and overdosed approximately one month before this incident. [REDACTED] claimed that [REDACTED] uses heroin and fentanyl, to which [REDACTED] agreed and declared the "Dope Ticket" was fentanyl.

While on the scene, Ptl. Rauner and I witnessed [REDACTED] vomit multiple times. Ptl. Rauner and I did not observe and controlled dangerous substances (CDS) or CDS paraphernalia in plain view, and [REDACTED] claimed that he did not have any more drugs in his possession. We also did not observe anyone else in the apartment with [REDACTED], apart from his mother, [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] eventually refused medical

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treatment and was given a Narcan kit by the Fire Department.

An entry was made in the OD Mapping system for this incident.

No further action was taken.
