INCIDENT: Drug Overdose / Medical Emergency

LOCATION: [REDACTED] Central Avenue

NARCOTICS CONFISCATED:

- Ten (10) Blue Oval-Shaped Pills Stamped "CL43"; Later Identified as Olanzapine
- Three (3) Pink Oval-Shaped Pills Stamped "OLA20 APO"; Later Identified as Olanzapine
- Two (2) Yellow Round-Shaped Pills Stamped "326"; Later Identified as Naltrexone Hydrochloride

REPORT:

On June 8, 2025, at 1638 hours, I responded to [REDACTED] Central Avenue for a possible overdose. Upon arrival, I retrieved Patrol Bag Six (6) from my Patrol Vehicle and entered the property.

I was met by [REDACTED] who claimed that his son was likely having a drug overdose in his bed. [REDACTED] stated that he could not wake his son up, so he immediately called 911. [REDACTED]

As I entered the bedroom, I found [REDACTED] lying in his bed, unconscious and breathing. I

immediately administered Naloxone (Narcan) to [REDACTED] right nostril and informed Central Communications that Narcan had been deployed. At this point, the Ocean City Fire Department arrived on the scene and administered further medical treatment. Lt. Lick and Ptl. Millevoi also arrived and helped secure the scene.

Ptl. Millevoi and I spoke with [REDACTED] in a separate room, where he informed us that [REDACTED] has [REDACTED] and has also battled with cocaine and alcohol addictions for the past two (2) years. [REDACTED] claimed that [REDACTED] possibly took a high dose of his prescribed Lithium along with alcohol and or another narcotic. While on the scene, an Atlaticare Paramedic informed me that nine (9) Lithium pills were unaccounted for in the bottle (the prescription was not followed).

After [REDACTED] was transported to Shore Medical Center, Lt. Lick and I discovered one (1) clear plastic bag containing a variety of unidentified pills. The pills were in plain view on top of a desk in the bedroom. I confiscated the bag and entered it into evidence to be destroyed. A Cape May County Forensic Laboratory Examination was completed for the seized narcotics. It should be noted that the pills were found not to be scheduled narcotics.

An Overdose Data Collection Form and a New Jersey Naloxone Administration Reporting Form were completed for this incident. All audio and video evidence was captured on my body-worn camera (B.W.C.) and attached to this case via AXON.

No further action was taken.
