Incident: *Unconscious Person / Overdose*

On June 27, 2025, Ptl. Dupont and I responded to the above location for an unconscious person. Upon

our arrival, the patient [REDACTED] way laying in her office chair located in the front lobby unconscious and not breathing. The fire department was also on scene at this time and began performing life saving efforts. At this time the Fire Department administered Narcan. The Narcan appeared to have positive effects resulting in [REDACTED] regaining consciousness and restored breathing. During this time Lt. Clark and Sgt. Hall arrived shortly after to assess the situation.

While the Fire Department was speaking with [REDACTED] I began to speak with the caller and manager [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] stated his employee [REDACTED] noticed [REDACTED] "sleeping" in her chair at approximately 11:11am. [REDACTED] notified [REDACTED], who then went to check on [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] stated he initially thought [REDACTED] was tired and did not think anything of it. [REDACTED] explained after approximately 10 minutes of checking on [REDACTED] she was not breathing and was not responding to verbal or physical commands. [REDACTED] stated this is when he called to notify police. [REDACTED] also mentioned this is not the first time [REDACTED] has fallen asleep while at work.

While speaking with [REDACTED] she denied taking any illicit drugs that would cause an overdose. [REDACTED] did mention she took Klonopin and Methadone earlier this morning. [REDACTED] stated she has been taking this medication for "10 years" and never had an adverse effect. [REDACTED] did not wish to seek further medical attention and signed a refusal statement with the Fire Department. Due to [REDACTED] refusing and being in a stable condition the Fire Department did not transport [REDACTED] to the hospital. The Fire Department did leave [REDACTED] a drug resource packet and Narcan. [REDACTED] was then handed over to [REDACTED] for further work related guidance.

An ODMAP entry was completed.

No further action was taken at this time.
