Summary

Upon arrival I made contact with the caller, Evelyn Devereaux who stated that her friend [REDACTED] overdosed on her couch. She said he was just released from prison last night and she was letting him spend then night tonight. Evelyn said she sent him out to the store to pick up orange juice and iced tea and waited for him to get back. Evelyn stated that once [REDACTED] returned back to her house she went into the shower to get ready for work and when she came out he was on her couch unconscious but breathing slowly. She said she began CPR on him and called 911. While speaking with Evelyn I observed [REDACTED] unconscious and he had agonal breathing. I checked his pulse and he had a strong pulse. I administered one 4mg dose of Narcan to [REDACTED] left nostril, and put him on high flow oxygen.

I checked [REDACTED] front pockets and sweat shirt pocket for any other CDS or paraphernalia and was unable to find any. Approximately 3-5 minutes later he sat up and was conscious and alert. KEMS arrived on scene and [REDACTED] refused medical attention. After KEMS assessed him, I asked him if he had any unused CDS and he handed me 3 wax fold baggies with white powdery substance suspected to be heroin with a "Get Out" stamp in red ink. Hazlet hopes was offered to [REDACTED] but he refused and he stated he would seek help on his own. All Narcan paper work completed and e-mailed to appropriate agencies and an email was sent to Lt Brink in regards to the overdose and wax fold baggies with the stamp information.

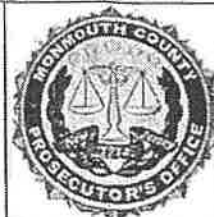

After searching the area patrols, accompanied by the KEMS, located Drust and [REDACTED] and the KEMS began their assessment. [REDACTED] presented with agonal breathing and a weak pulse. Drust stated [REDACTED] "shot up" and then one 4 mg dose of Naloxone Hcl (Narcan) was administered. After a short period [REDACTED] woke up, and her breathing improved. [REDACTED] refused further assessment, treatment or transport to a hospital by the KEMS and signed their refusal form. After advising [REDACTED] should be evaluated at a hospital [REDACTED] continued to refuse, [REDACTED] was told to call for help again if [REDACTED] needed it. [REDACTED] was also offered information about the Hazlet Hopes program and [REDACTED] stated [REDACTED] was not interested. All police and EMS personell cleared without incident. The Narcan forms were filled out and faxed.
