ON THE ABOVE DATE AND TIME OFFICERS WERE DISPATCHED TO 235 MERMAID AVE FOR AN OVERDOSE. PTL. BATULLO, PTL. BRUNO, SGT. MUSSARI, AND I RESPONDED TO THE SCENE. UPON ARRIVAL WE WERE MET BY THE CALLER, [REDACTED] WHO DIRECTED US INSIDE TO AN UNCONSCIOUS FEMALE LAYING ON THE KITCHEN FLOOR INSIDE THE APARTMENT. HE STATED HE FOUND HER LIKE THIS WITH A NEEDLE IN HER ARM. PTL. BRUNO AND I BEGAN ASSESSING THE VICTIM, WHO WAS LATER IDENTIFIED AS [REDACTED] [REDACTED] WAS NOT BREATHING BUT DID HAVE A PULSE. I BEGAN RESCUE BREATHING FOR THE VICTIM WHILE PTL. BRUNO PREPARED NARCAN. PTL. BATULLO AND SGT. MUSSARI FOUND SEVERAL SEALED WAX FOLDS WITH THE WORD "PRINCE" STAMPED ON THEM IN BLUE INK, NEAR [REDACTED] THEY ALSO WERE ABLE TO FIND THE VICTIMS IDENTIFICATION. PTL. BRUNO THEN ADMINISTERED 1 DOSE OF NARCAN AND I CONTINUED RESCUE BREATHING. BEACHWOOD FIRST AID SQUAD ARRIVED ON SCENE SHORTLY AFTER THIS. THEY ALSO BEGAN ASSESSING [REDACTED] AND ADVISED TO ADMINISTER A SECOND DOSE OF NARCAN. PTL. BRUNO THEN ADMINISTERED A SECOND DOSE OF NARCAN AND THEN I RESUMED RESCUE BREATHING.

OFFICERS THEN ASSISTED FIRST AID IN CARRYING [REDACTED] OUTSIDE ONTO THE STRETCHER. SHORTLY AFTER GETTING [REDACTED] ONTO THE STRETCHER SHE BEGAN BREATHING ON HER OWN. WHILE LOADING [REDACTED] INTO THE AMBULANCE SHE MOVED INTO A SEMI-CONSCIOUS STATE. BEACHWOOD FIRST AID THEN TRANSPORTED [REDACTED] TO COMMUNITY MEDICAL CENTER.

I THEN RECOVERED 4 WAX FOLDS SEALED WITH TAPE CONTAINING SUSPECT HEROIN FROM THE KITCHEN AREA OF THE APARTMENT. I ALSO RECOVERED 1 ADDITIONAL WAX FOLD FROM NEAR THE FRONT DOOR OF THE APARTMENT. ALL 5 WAX FOLDS HAD THE WORD "PRINCE" STAMPED ON THEM IN BLUE INK. THE WAX FOLDS WERE PLACED INTO AN EVIDENCE BAG AND THE BAG WAS SEALED SHUT. I TRANSPORTED THE BAG TO HEADQUARTERS AFTER CLEARING THE SCENE AND THEN I PLACED THE EVIDENCE BAG INTO SHORT TERM STORAGE LOCKER #1.

PRIOR TO CLEARING THE SCENE I SPOKE WITH THE CALLER. [REDACTED] STATED THAT HE STAYED THE NIGHT AT [REDACTED] APARTMENT. HE SAID SHE WAS ACTING WEIRD THIS MORNING AND CAME AND WENT FROM THE APARTMENT SEVERAL TIMES. HE ALSO SAID HE WAS AWARE THAT SHE HAD A DRUG PROBLEM. [REDACTED] ADVISED ME THAT [REDACTED] COLLAPSED IN FROM OF HIM AND HE CALLED 911 AFTER SEEING THIS. HE ALSO REMOVED THE NEEDLE FROM HER ARM. AFTER SPEAKING WITH THE DISPATCHER HE DID CPR UNTIL POLICE ARRIVED. [REDACTED] STATED HE DID NOT HAVE ANY ADDITIONAL HEROIN ON HIM AND THAT HE WAS UNSURE WHERE [REDACTED] GOT IT FROM. I THEN LOCKED AND SECURED [REDACTED] APARTMENT DOOR SHUT AND CLEARED THE SCENE.

AFTER PLACING THE WAX FOLDS INTO EVIDENCE, I WENT TO COMMUNITY MEDICAL CENTER FOR 2 NARCAN REPLENISHMENTS. I COMPLETED THE NECESSARY REPLENISHMENT FORMS AND ATTACHED THEM TO THIS REPORT. THE NARCAN DEPLOYMENT FORM WAS ALSO COMPLETED AND FAXED TO THE PROPER AGENCY. THE FORM IS ALSO ATTACHED TO THIS REPORT.
