On March 2nd, 2023, Ptl. Corbisiero, Ptl. Korpon, and I (Ptl. Mlotkiewicz) responded to [REDACTED] Scarlet Oak Ave; North Point Hollow for the report of an overdose. [REDACTED] called to report that her [REDACTED] had overdosed. TRPD Communications advised the responding units that [REDACTED] had administered Naloxone (Narcan) while we were in route.

Upon Police arrival, [REDACTED] was alert and conscious but appeared to be very tired. He was not given any additional Narcan from Police or EMS. While on scene, [REDACTED] was looking through [REDACTED] room for any narcotics. In the desk drawer in [REDACTED] room, she found 2 bundles of 19 total wax folds that were suspected to contain heroin. Each wax fold was stamped "take off" in red ink. [REDACTED] stated that he did not wish to be transported to the hospital. The Overdose Response Team (ORT) was contacted by TRPD Communications and a message was left with them. I completed a record in OD Maps as well for this incident. The wax folds were brought to District One and entered into evidence locker #9 to be destroyed. There is no further information at this time.

On 3/3/23 at approximately 1310, I, Ptl. K. O'Leary #455, responded to 231 Warner St; Shore Meadows for a male not breathing. Upon arrival, staff advised this officer that [REDACTED] had gone unconscious and stopped breathing. Staff was actively assisting [REDACTED] breathe, however [REDACTED] did have a pulse. At this time, it was determined that [REDACTED] may be suffering from an overdose. After staff had administered two doses of Narcan, [REDACTED] began vomiting and woke up.

[REDACTED] did not admit to taking any narcotics upon waking up. After initially refusing medical treatment, [REDACTED] was persuaded to be transported to the hospital for medical treatment. [REDACTED] was transported by TR CSO's to the nearest hospital, MMCSC. Upon inspection of [REDACTED] medical bed and surrounding area, no evidence of CDS was found.

ORT was notified of this incident and the OD map was completed.

On 03/05/2023, at approximately 22:47 hours, I, Ptl. Pinto #443 arrived at Tomera Pl. for a reported overdose. Upon my arrival, contact was made with [REDACTED] advised that he returned home at around 2100 hours and observed his [REDACTED] to be acting unusual. [REDACTED] related that he just believed [REDACTED] to be tired. However, [REDACTED] advised that [REDACTED] then began to try to trace objects with her finger, that were not there. [REDACTED] believed that [REDACTED] possibly took too much of her sleeping medication. [REDACTED] related that he did not observe any medication located near [REDACTED] when he returned and that the medicine was where it is typically kept. [REDACTED] added that [REDACTED] has experienced issues with the dosage of her medication, as she often takes too much. [REDACTED] advised that [REDACTED] was recently released from Shoreline due to this behavior.

In speaking with [REDACTED] she experienced difficulty staying awake and was not speaking coherently. [REDACTED] did advise that she took too much of an unknown medication. Once EMS arrived on scene and examined her, she was then transported to Community Medical Center for further evaluation. While inspecting her medications, it was unable to be determined which medication she may have ingested as the prescription bottles did not appear to be unusually low for the dosage and the date prescribed. OD Map and OD Form were completed and submitted for this incident.

On 03/05/2023, at approximately 23:09, multiple forms of emergency personnel and I, Ptl. Pinto #443, responded to [REDACTED] Arthur St. for a possible overdose. Initial information provided to TRPD Communications described a female utilizing a paper towel roll as a cell phone and not making sense. Further information was provided advising that the female possibly consumed rubbing alcohol in addition to unknown narcotics. Upon our arrival, contact was made with a neighbor and the reporting party, [REDACTED] who related the following information.

[REDACTED] advised that she lives next door to [REDACTED] and earlier today she observed [REDACTED] to be intoxicated at 11 AM. [REDACTED] advised that [REDACTED] told her she had taken a [REDACTED] at that time as well. [REDACTED] advised that she came to check on [REDACTED] tonight and observed her attempting to use a paper towel roll as a cell phone. Due to this, she contacted this agency to request a well-being check.

In speaking with [REDACTED] she was conscious and alert, while answering the questions posed by EMS. However, she was observed to be shaking and later exhibited difficulty walking. [REDACTED] related that she may have ingested [REDACTED] but she was not positive and suddenly began to feel unwell. [REDACTED] advised that she was not attempting to harm herself. [REDACTED] family, including her [REDACTED] [REDACTED] advised that this is not normal behavior for her and they were concerned. No narcotics or other paraphernalia were located near [REDACTED]. Additionally, an OD Map/OD Form were completed. [REDACTED] was then transported to Community Medical Center for further evaluation.

On March 15, 2023 at approximately 17:45 hours multiple TRPD units and I responded to [REDACTED] Peaceful way for an overdose. Upon my arrival I observed the victim, [REDACTED], laying on his back on the kitchen floor. Initial responding officers advised they had issued two (2) doses of Narcan (4mg) before turning over medical care to EMS.

[REDACTED] explained [REDACTED] is a recovered heroin addict and she has not known him to use in years. He has another residence in Homestead Run but primarily stays with her. He left this afternoon for a few hours and upon returning passed out. No CDS or paraphernalia was located on scene.

[REDACTED] woke up and stated he only took some pills. He was ultimately transported to Kimball by Lakewood EMS for further treatment. A message was left for ORT by dispatch. OD Map was completed for this incident.

On 03-26-2023 at approximately 1414 hrs, I responded to the Toms River Bus Terminal; 400 Highland Pkwy, for an overdose call. According to dispatch, NJ Transit reported that a customer (later identified as [REDACTED] was unconscious and breathing on the back of bus 18115 (319 Atlantic City Route). Upon my arrival, TRPD EMTs were on scene and provided [REDACTED] with a dose of narkan. They then rendered him first aid while he remained unconscious.

After several minutes, [REDACTED] regained consciousness and we were able to remove him from the bus and into the ambulance. I asked [REDACTED] what he consumed that made in unconscious. He advised that he did not take anything. The medication found in his possession were antibiotics [REDACTED]

After speaking to [REDACTED] I spoke to the bus driver, Guy Koumapley. Mr. Koumapley advised that [REDACTED] entered his bus in Atlantic City. He advised that [REDACTED] behavior seemed strange, so he monitored him during their ride to Toms River. Upon stopping at the TR bus terminal, he observed [REDACTED] unconscious. As a result, he called 911 and awaited our arrival.

Due to his medical episode, [REDACTED] was transported without incident and voluntarily to CMC for further treatment. A voicemail for the ORT was made, advising them of this incident. This incident was also entered into the ODMAP database. No further action taken at this time.

On 03/29/2023 at approximately 1220 hours, I, Ptl. Galati #445, was dispatched to [REDACTED] Peacock Place in reference to a [REDACTED] later identified as [REDACTED] who was experiencing an [REDACTED]

Upon my arrival, Toms River CSOs were in the process of moving [REDACTED] to the ambulance for further evaluation where [REDACTED] was semi-conscious. While EMS on scene was administering aid to [REDACTED] I spoke with with the reporting party, [REDACTED] stated he had recently returned home from work and observed [REDACTED] in this state. He advised he did not believe [REDACTED] was taking medication for anything but [REDACTED] had a history of [REDACTED] At this time, I was advised by RWJ Paramedics on scene that this was an overdose and one (1) dose of Naloxone was administered on scene where [REDACTED] then became alert and conscious.

[REDACTED] allowed me to look inside of his residence for possible CDS/paraphernalia involved in this incident. [REDACTED] at this time walked me to the basement where [REDACTED] resides and opened [REDACTED] box where sixteen (16) wax folds of heroin were located. These wax folds had a red stamp on them stating "Safe House". The CDS on scene was collected and transported to District One where it was placed into evidence for destruction.

At this time, I spoke with [REDACTED] in the ambulance who stated that [REDACTED] was trying to overdose. It was also advised that [REDACTED] stated to paramedics on scene that [REDACTED] moved into [REDACTED] residence so that if [REDACTED] overdoses then [REDACTED] daughter will have a place to live.

Based on [REDACTED] statements on scene, [REDACTED] was transported via Toms River CSOs to Community Medical Center for further medical treatment [REDACTED]
