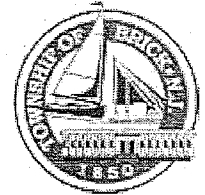

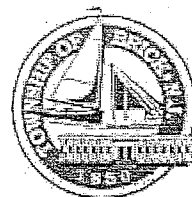

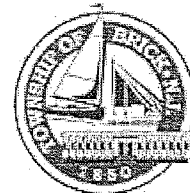
We found _____ still in his bed and breathing agonally. We were unable to wake _____ as well and we assisted him with breathing. _____ had a strong pulse as we waited for EMS to arrive. Once EMS responded, they administered one Narcan dose which woke _____ Soon after the medics arrived, _____ was transported to the Ocean Medical Center.

Found on _____ night stand next to his bed were approximately nine wax folds (Two with the word "Google" and others with a horse) and a syringe which were placed into evidence for destruction. A further check of _____ room was negative for any more drugs or paraphernalia in plain view. _____ stated he would be doing a more comprehensive search and advised he would call police if he finds anything. He was advised of the Blue Hart program and supplied a magnet.

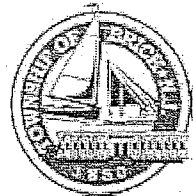

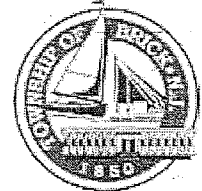

Brick Police EMS arrived on scene and I administered Narcan. _____ on _____ Seconds later, _____ regained consciousness and admitted that he snorted heroin approximately 1 hour prior to our arrival.

_____ reported that _____ children, _____ responded to their residence and advised them that _____ had passed out. _____ went to the residence and discovered _____ on the floor before they called 911. Subsequently, _____ was transported to Brick Hospital and turned over to the staff for further medical attention. The children's Mother, _____, responded to the scene and was advised of the incident. At the hospital, _____ stated he was at a bar in Belmar and he paid a subject, unknown to him, \$20.00 for three wax folds of heroin with a red stamp on them. When he was driven home, he snorted the three bags and threw the empties out of the car window. _____ was unable to provide more detail regarding the drug transaction.

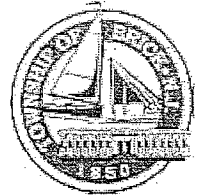

On 09/09/18 at 1339 hrs I was dispatched to [redacted] in the shower.

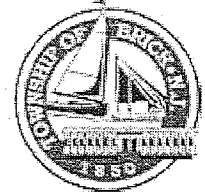
[redacted] in reference to an unconscious/unresponsive subj

Upon my arrival I was met by the [redacted] advised me she was in the kitchen when her boyfriend, [redacted] went to take a shower. Several minutes passed by and she went into the bathroom where she located [redacted] lying on the shower floor, with the water still running. She advised she called out his name, but there was no response. She stated she tried to wake him up but he did not respond, so she called 911. She advised he has done heroin in the past, but thought he quit after rehab. I went into the bathroom and located [redacted] in the same position. I attempted a sternum rub; however it was unsuccessful in awakening him. With [redacted] assistance, we were able to remove [redacted] from the shower and drag him into the bedroom, where there was more room. [redacted] was still unconscious/unresponsive with labored breathing. I did not have narcan in my first aid kit, so I administered oxygen until first aid arrived.

First Aid unit #M533 arrived on scene and we administered one dose of narcan. There was no immediate effect and first aid provided [redacted] with rescue breaths until Medic Unit #205 arrived and took over the scene. They too administered narcan and other medication. After about 10 minutes from [redacted] first narcan dosage, he woke up. We inquired as to what he used and [redacted] advised he snorted 3 bags of heroin; however there was no evidence because he flushed the bags in the toilet. [redacted] was loaded onto a stretcher and transported to Ocean Medical Center without incident.

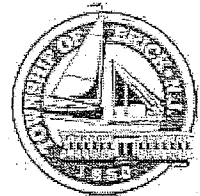

On 9/04/18 at approximately 1521 hours, Sgt. Kenny #224, Ptl. Carter #280, Ptl. Hentges #288, and I were dispatched to in reference to an overdose.

Upon our arrival we were lead up the stairs by , to a back bedroom. (mother) was lying on the bed with shallow breathing and was unresponsive. believed had taken an entire bottle (approx. 30 pills) of Olanzapine 5mg, which was prescribed to her, as an attempt at suicide. At approximately 1522 hours Brick Township EMS #535 arrived on scene to administer medical assistance and Narcan was used on . At approximately 1539 hours MONOC #214 (Sonher 3743, Monagham 1595) arrived on scene. A empty bottle of Clonazepam .5mg (30 tablet container) was also found at the scene. was transported to Brick Hospital at approximately 1630 hours, still unresponsive.

explained that her mother was just in the process of moving in with them because . could not be on her own. informed me that had a history of anxiety and depression and was seeing a psychiatrist at Meridian Health Center, but had never been suicidal before.

aformed me on the morning of 9/04/18, her and had gotten into a verbal argument because attempted control was upset with and "snapped" at her. At approximately 1300 hours was on her way to Middletown to shop for a backpack for her son. told to take her son with her, which found to be strange comment but never the less took her son with her.

At Approximately 1445 hours and her son had returned home. walked up the stairs to check on her mother. had locked the door and did not answer when knocked. knew had to get into the locked room and used household tools to open the door. noticed laying on the bed with an empty Olanzapine bottle on her night stand. was unresponsive to and she called 911 and had go to a friends house.

As EMS left the scene husband arrived on scene. stated had shown no signs that she would attempt suicide. did say that at 1159 hours had called him and was questioning whether or not it was okay for her to stay with them because she did not want to be a burden. assured her that everything was fine and she was better off living with them.

A crime scene log was started by Ptl. Carter #280 at approximately 1605 hours. Det. Schinder #208 arrived on scene at approximately 1619 hours. At 1711 hours the crime scene log was ended and all officers were clear of the scene. OCPO was notified and would not be responding to the scene. The residence checked negative for anything suspicious to indicate foul play.

The empty bottles of Clonazepam and Olanzapine were entered into property as evidence.

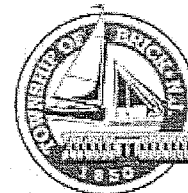

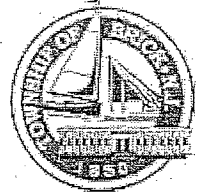

On 09/02/18 at approximately 1854 hours Ptl. Joaquim #271, Ptl. Bennett #279, Ptl. Bailey #293 and I responded to in reference to an unconscious 31 year old male. Brick Police dispatch advised the caller stated he administered Narcan and was currently giving CPR.

Upon arrival I located the subject in question, who was alert and conscious. Brick Police EMS also arrived on scene advised me of the following:

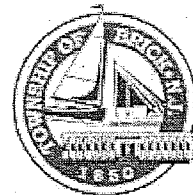
Approximately 1 hour prior to police arrival he had injected two bags of heroin. After using the heroin he discarded the needle and two bags containing the heroin in a trash can but could not remember exactly where. He purchased the heroin in Barnegat but would not provide any further information and could not remember what stamp was on the bags of Heroin. was later transported to Ocean Medical Center for further treatment.

I spoke with a witness on scene, advised he observed inside of his vehicle in the driveway and he was not moving. As he got closer he observed face to be blue and it appeared he was not breathing. He immediately recognized this to be an overdose and removed from his vehicle. He placed on the ground, administered 4MG of Narcan which he retrieved from his residence and began performing CPR. While performing CPR 911 was contacted and shortly after became conscious and began breathing on his own.

While on scene officers attempted to located further CDS and paraphernalia with negative results. Detective Nixon #209 of the Drug Enforcement Unit was contacted and notified of the incident.

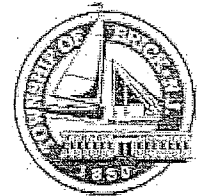

On September 1st, 2018 at 0552hrs Ptl. Gordon #237 and I were dispatched to [redacted] for a suspected overdose. Upon arrival, we were met by [redacted] and I [redacted] who stated their friend was overdosed in the rear right bedroom. They stated she had consumed heroin prior to our arrival. Inside the room I observed a Hispanic female on the floor wearing a gray shirt and dark shorts unresponsive with shallow breathing. The female was identified by her drivers license provided by [redacted]

The three advised that at home (over the counter) Narcan was administered prior to our arrival. I observed [redacted] to be sweating and turning blue due to shallow breathing. I immediately deployed BTPD nasal Narcan at 0603hrs and began a sternum rub. [redacted] was still unresponsive after the second dose of Narcan. At this time BTPD EMS Unit 532 arrived on scene and began further treatment. Shortly after their arrival, Medics arrived on scene to assist.

The three individuals stated that prior to calling, [redacted] went into the bathroom for a period of ten minutes and then came out. A short time later they went in the room to check on her and found her unresponsive. In the toilet in the bathroom I observed a wax foil that was marked "I'm Apache" in green font with an Indian head on it. Also in the toilet bowl was bodily fluid with possible blood borne pathogens that made the evidence unable to be seized. One of the individuals stated she put the needle in a plastic bin. Next to one of the beds was a three drawer clear plastic nightstand. Looking through it I could see a hypodermic needle and silver spoon. I opened the drawer and removed the spoon and needle for evidentiary purposes. Ptl. Gordon located on the floor of the living room a empty wax fold stamped "fast and Furious" with a red car on it.

At approximately 0627hrs [redacted] started to regain consciousness and was sitting up and speaking. She advised EMS and Medics she ingested 2 wax folds of heroin. Brick Twp EMS then prepared [redacted] to walk outside where she was loaded into the ambulance and subsequently transported to Ocean Medical Center for further evaluation. At police headquarters I completed the NJ Attorney General Naloxone Reporting Form as well as BTPD Narcan Replenishment Form. Ptl. Gordon submitted the seized hypodermic needle, wax folds and silver spoon into evidence in accordance with departmental policy.
