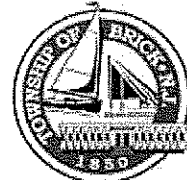

On 07/03/2019 at 0158hrs Ptl. Thergesen #249, Rotondo #252, and I (Ptl. Bailey #293) responded to [REDACTED] Greenwood Loop Road in reference to an overdose. Dispatch advised the caller was actively performing CPR on the victim.

Upon my arrival the caller [REDACTED] was performing CPR on her cousin/victim [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] was unresponsive and not breathing. I administered the only dose of NARCAN to [REDACTED]. Not too long after that Ptl. Thergesen, Ptl. Rotondo and Brick EMS M536 arrived on scene to assist. After a few minutes [REDACTED] became alert and conscious.

[REDACTED] was confused at first as to what was going on. But once he calmed down he stated the following: he was staying at [REDACTED] house for the night. He just wanted one last high before he went to rehab tomorrow morning. He stated he had no more drugs he had already used them all prior to our arrival.

While speaking with [REDACTED] she advised [REDACTED] needed to stay over for one night before he entered rehab in the morning. So she allowed [REDACTED] to stay on her couch for the night. During the course of the night she became thirsty and went down stairs to get a drink of water. When she got down stairs she observe [REDACTED] not breathing on the couch. She called 911 and began CPR.

Brick EMS transported [REDACTED] to the hospital without further incident.

I found a syringe and properly disposed of it at the hospital. There were no drugs located inside the residence. The Naloxone Administration Reporting Form and NARCAN replenishment forms were completed.

DEU Det.Puccio #259 was notified of the incident.

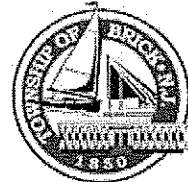

On July 20, 2019 at approximately 1148 hours, Ptl. Storch #206 and I responded to [REDACTED] Creek Road in reference to an overdose. EMS on scene prior to my arrival.

On arrival EMS was providing medical care to the overdose suspect later identified as [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] was located on the bedroom floor next to the bed lying the opposite way on his right side. [REDACTED] was unresponsive but had agonal breathing. At this time EMS administered one dose of Narcan. While providing further medical care [REDACTED]'s condition remained the same. EMS administered a second dose of Narcan and continued to provide care. Ptl. Storch and I searched the area for evidence of substance abuse. Ptl. Storch was able to locate a wax paper fold commonly used to conceal heroin in a garbage can next to the bed. [REDACTED] began clenching his jaw making it difficult for EMS to utilize suction to remove fluid from [REDACTED] mouth. Due to his decline in status [REDACTED] was transported to Ocean Medical Center by EMS. Ptl. Storch followed.

I spoke to the caller [REDACTED] ([REDACTED]'s girlfriend) who stated she found him in his current state prior to calling and did not move him. [REDACTED] stated she did not observe any drugs or drug paraphernalia around [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] advised she last observed him awake at 0030 hours this morning. [REDACTED] stated [REDACTED] has used drugs in the past including marijuana, heroin, crack cocaine and pills. At first [REDACTED] stated she was unaware if he had taken anything but later on stated that he definitely used heroin. [REDACTED] advised [REDACTED] uses heroin by snorting.

I then spoke to other residents in the house including [REDACTED], [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] who had no further information to provide.

I contacted Ocean County Prosecutors office and notified them of the incident and they advised they will not be responding. I contacted [REDACTED]'s father [REDACTED] who advised he would be responding to the hospital.

DVD containing photos of the scene, the wax fold paper and [REDACTED] cell phone were logged into property.

Ptl. Storch notified Sgt. Olsen #185 of the incident.

OfficerID: cpagnotta, Narrative

On 7/20/2019 at approximately 1250 hours Ptl. Newlund #285 and I (Ptl. Pagnotta #301) responded to [REDACTED] Creek Rd. where Ptl. Giambona #290 had secured the scene of an overdose.

At 1258 hours I began a crime scene log due to the unknown and unstable condition of the patient. At the time the log was started Ptl. Newlund #285, Ptl. Giambona #290, [REDACTED], [REDACTED], [REDACTED], [REDACTED], and [REDACTED] were all on scene.

At 1401 hours all the same individuals were still on scene and the crime scene log was closed.

On 7/20/19 at approximately 1557 hours, Ptl. Firreno #283 and I were dispatched to [REDACTED] Church Road in reference to an overdose call.

Prior to our arrival, dispatch informed us that the suspect left in a black Mercury vehicle (NJ Reg R67HHA) headed towards Drum Point Road.

After a search of the area ended with negative results, I spoke to the caller [REDACTED]. He stated that he was woken up to the sound of his roommate [REDACTED] screaming. [REDACTED] stated she told him to call 911 because she could not wake her boyfriend [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] told [REDACTED] that [REDACTED] had taken heroin and she thought he was overdosing. [REDACTED] stated that [REDACTED] was in the bathroom and was unresponsive. [REDACTED] stated [REDACTED] was able to get him awake and the two left the house.

Ptl. Firreno #283 was able to stop the vehicle with [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] at Hooper Avenue and Drum Point Road. I spoke to [REDACTED] on the scene she stated that she was shaken up and admitted that [REDACTED] had done Heroin and she believed he was overdosing. She stated that she told [REDACTED] to call 911, but then [REDACTED] woke up. [REDACTED] stated that he was fine but needed something to drink. [REDACTED] decided to drive him to get a red bull and convinced him to go to the hospital. She was driving him to the hospital when the vehicle was stopped.

[REDACTED] was evaluated on scene by Brick EMS unit 537 and taken to Brick Hospital for further evaluation. A search of the vehicle for heroin ended with negative results. D.E.U was notified of the situation.

On 7-21-19 at 1933hrs, Sgt. Matthews #210, Ptl. Pacnya #287 and I responded to the Tip Top Cabins, 2210 Rt. 88 room [REDACTED], in reference to a male subject suffering from a heroin overdose.

Upon arrival I was met at the door by [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] who both stated that they're friend was inside passed out. Upon entry into the room I observed the male overdose victim, later identified as [REDACTED], semi conscious, laying face up on the floor in a puddle of water. I also observed his shorts and unclothed upper body to be soaked. When I called out to him, he was responsive to verbal stimuli and once he realized that I was a police officer, he became more coherent. I asked how much heroin he injected and he replied, "one bag." Moments later Ptl. Pacnya, Sgt Matthews and Brick EMS arrived to treat him further.

I spoke further with [REDACTED] and she stated that while driving with [REDACTED] they had been on the phone with [REDACTED]. During the phone conversation, [REDACTED] advised them that he had relapsed and wasn't feeling good, seconds later they heard a loud bang and couldn't get him bad on the phone. [REDACTED] estimated that it took her and [REDACTED] 4 minutes to get to [REDACTED] room and upon arrival she stated that she had to use her driver's license to gain entry into the room as the door was locked. Upon entry, they observed [REDACTED] laying face up on the floor, unconscious and gasping for air. At this time she called 911 and performed 2 rounds of CPR until [REDACTED] was breathing on his own. She recalled seeing 3 torn wax folds and 3 full was folds on the dresser stamped "Coke" in red ink and three hypodermic needles. She had little information to provide about [REDACTED] as she only knew him thru [REDACTED]. She also claimed [REDACTED] was her uncle.

Upon speaking with [REDACTED] he stated that he had been speaking with [REDACTED] on the phone and was en route to his room. He further stated that upon arriving at [REDACTED] room, [REDACTED] opened the door for them and stated that he just injected some heroin. [REDACTED] apparently then went into the bathroom and flushed the empty bags of heroin down the toilet. After leaving the bathroom, [REDACTED] fell on the floor and began grasping for air. Moments later 911 was called and CPR was performed by [REDACTED]. When I advised [REDACTED] that [REDACTED] had given a different story, he claims that she was lying. He advised that he has been friends with [REDACTED] for awhile and works with him at NJ Best Lawns. [REDACTED] was subsequently transported to Brick Hospital for further treatment by Brick Police EMS # 537.

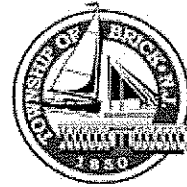
No wax folds were located at the scene and only 2 of the 3 reported hypodermic needles were recovered from the room, one in the trash and one on the dresser. The needles were later disposed of at Brick Hospital.

Upon speaking with [REDACTED] at Brick Hospital, he stated that he had been in contact with [REDACTED] thru out the day and was agitated because [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] had been telling him that they'd be over in 10 minutes. While waiting he admitted to drinking numerous alcoholic beverages. Once they arrived 3 hours after they said, he was very angry and asked if either had any heroin to calm him down and [REDACTED] provided him with one wax fold of heroin that had an unknown stamp in blue ink. After injecting one bag of heroin into his left forearm, he passed out until he woke up with on police arrival. He admitted to owning the needle that was located on the dresser but denies owning the needle recovered from the trash can and denied flushing any bags down the toilet. [REDACTED] alluded to the fact that both [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] are both heroin users. He confirmed that he is friends with [REDACTED] and works with him. When asked what his relationship is with [REDACTED], she stated that he only kind of knows her thru [REDACTED]. When asked about [REDACTED] and [REDACTED]s relationship, he stated "friends", "why are they saying he's her uncle?" He went on to stated that [REDACTED] is not [REDACTED]s uncle.

At the time of this report [REDACTED] was still in the care of hospital staff and expected to make a full recovery. The BTPD Drug Enforcement Unit was also notified of the incident.

On 07/21/2019 at 2140 hours I was dispatched to [REDACTED] 6th Ave for a report of a semi conscious male. Upon my arrival I observed a white male, later identified as [REDACTED], bent over the foot of the bed, unresponsive.

I placed [REDACTED] on the floor in the supine position to conduct a medical evaluation. [REDACTED] was breathing shallow, grossly diaphoretic and had a strong pulse. [REDACTED] pupils were constricted to pin point. I administered one dose of Naloxone at 2146 hours in [REDACTED] right nostril and advised dispatch. [REDACTED] was placed on 15L/min of oxygen via non-re breather mask and monitored. Approximately five minutes later [REDACTED] was alert and oriented to his environment.

Brick Police EMS, Paramedics and Sgt. Vendrell #228 arrived on scene. Brick Police EMS transported [REDACTED] to Ocean Medical Center Emergency Room after [REDACTED] admitted taking Oxy.

Sgt. Olsen #185 (Brick Police Drug Enforcement Unit) was notified and elected not to respond to the scene.

The Naloxone Administration Reporting Form was faxed to the NJROIC.

On 07/22/2019 at 1529 hours, I responded to [REDACTED] Schindler Drive in reference to an unconscious [REDACTED] y/o female. Upon arrival, Brick EMS and I were met by the caller, [REDACTED], at the front door. [REDACTED] escorted us to the victim [REDACTED] in the kitchen. I observed [REDACTED] leaning on the wall near the trash can unconscious and unresponsive. Brick EMS began treating and evaluating [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] reported upon coming home at the time of the 9-1-1 call, he located [REDACTED] on the kitchen floor in her current state. [REDACTED] stated [REDACTED] is a diabetic and recovering opiate user. Brick EMS deployed one (1) dose of Narcan to [REDACTED]. Several minutes later, [REDACTED] began responsive and talking. [REDACTED] admitted to snorting an unknown substance when she came home. [REDACTED] stated she had the remaining substance in her purse. [REDACTED] located her purse and placed it on the kitchen table. I recovered three (3) wax folds of heroin stamped in red "Rolex" and a cut plastic straw. The items were seized and placed into evidence. [REDACTED] was transported to Ocean Medical Center by Brick EMS.

Det. Sgt. Olsen #185 was notified.

Sgt. Catalina added the information to ODMAP.

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Vanessa Romer called 9-1-1 after her friend [REDACTED] (suspect-overdose) overdosed on the living room couch after shooting up heroin in their bathroom.

Upon arrival, I gave [REDACTED] one (1) 4mg dose of Narcan nasal spray. She was alert and conscious within 3 minutes of the dose. One hypodermic needle was found in the bathroom where she shot up. Another was found in [REDACTED]'s purse at [REDACTED] feet. She admitted to using heroin and cocaine the night before, and one bag this afternoon. The packaging for the heroin was never found.

After being extremely uncooperative and argumentative, [REDACTED] finally was able to be convinced by [REDACTED] to go to the hospital.

It was later discovered that [REDACTED]'s boyfriend, [REDACTED], who also resides at [REDACTED] Creek Road, discarded all the packaging, paraphernalia, and possibly other drugs when he discovered police were on the way.

No further police action.
