Upon arrival I observed the victim on the front patio non responsive and with anginal breathing. Toms River EMS was also on scene prior to my arrival. As I was approaching the victim TREMS advised they gave the victim one (1) dose of narcan. Shortly after the dose was administered _____ began to regain consciousness. I asked _____ was he had taken and he explained he took Heroin. I then observed what appeared to be wax folds hanging out of _____ front left pocket. I then collected said evidence and secured it in my patrol vehicle. _____ was then helped to his feet and taken to the ambulance to be transported to CMC for treatment.

I then spoke with witness 1 _____ According to _____ gave him a ride home to _____ Adams Ave. after his shift at the Crystal Diner. He explained _____ left to go to the bathroom at one point and did not return for an extended period of time. _____ then went to check on _____ to find his unresponsive on the toilet. _____ explained on the floor around _____ were approximately 4 empty wax folds and one needle. _____ explained he flushed the empty wax folds and took the needle away so no one got poked or injured from it. _____ explained he then dragged _____ down stairs and outside to await EMS arrival. _____ was also at the residence and explained the same sequence of events as _____ did however explained he did not touch _____ during the incident.

I then took custody of the hypodermic needle and placed it in a sharps container and secured it in my patrol vehicle. All evidence was collected and secured. 8 wax folds containing suspect Heroin, stamped "Selfie", with a camera on the stamp was packaged and secured in evidence locker 9 and marked To Be Destroyed. The needle was placed in the TRPD sharps container also to be destroyed. The OD Map pertaining to this case was completed and submitted through the OD Map web site. Nothing further at this time.

On 07-03-19, multiple Toms River Police Units responded to the Urgent Care located at 970 Hooper Avenue, in reference to an overdose. Prior to police arrival, Toms River Police Communications advised responding units that an unresponsive male was suffering from an apparent overdose. Upon my arrival, I observed a 2000 sedan, in color, bearing NJ Registration parked in the fire lane near the entrance to the building. In the front passenger seat was a male, later identified as who was unresponsive with agonal breathing.

I was advised by the witness, that became unresponsive while they arrived at Shop Rite on Fischer Boulevard. stated that because he could not wake Decker, he immediately drove him to the Urgent Care. further advised that suffers from a magnitude of health problems, including diabetes and chronic pain. claims that is prescribed opioids for his chronic pain, however did not know the name of the prescription.

Based on the circumstances, I administered 2mg of NARCAN (NDC 76329-3369-1, Stock #3369, Lot #RL093H8). Approximately three to five minutes later, became somewhat responsive, enough to move him onto a stretcher and transported to Community Medical Center for further treatment.

A NARCAN Replenishment Form was completed and placed in Sgt. Maire's mailbox. The incident was documented in the OD MAP as well. No paraphernalia was located on Decker's person or inside of the vehicle.

On 7/6/19 at approximately 0138 hours; Sgt. Martucci, Ptl. Buhowski and I responded to 26 James Street building apartment for a suspected overdose.

Upon arrival, units were met by the reporting party, Mr. who stated his friend had entered the bathroom and began running the water. After not hearing him make noise for approximately 5 minutes, he decided to check on him at which time he was found unresponsive and inadequately breathing.

Med 11 and officers found the patient, later identified as to be laying supine and unresponsive on the bathroom floor. In the vicinity of were two syringes and an empty wax fold. Due to the presence of CDS and current medical status he was administered (2) doses of NARCAN, a total of 4 MG, by Med 11. After approximately 5 minutes, regained consciousness and was escorted to the ambulance where treatment was continued by BLS and ALS on scene. was eventually transported to Community Medical Center for further treatment and observation; he remained conscious and alert throughout.

In addition to the (2) syringes and used wax fold previously mentioned, an intact bundle containing (14) small baggies with wax folds inside was located on the bathroom counter. The additional small baggies and wax folds are suspected of containing heroin. All items were transported to District 1 where the syringes were deposited into the sharps container and the (14) remaining wax folds were entered into evidence for destruction.

On July 6th, 2019 at approximately 2232 hours, Sgt. Martucci #347, Ptl. Deveckka #421, and I responded to W End Avenue for a report of an overdose. While responding to the residence, I was notified by TRPD Communications that the male party had awoken from his unresponsive state and was walking around. Upon my arrival, I was met by ----- who advised me that his ----- was found in his bedroom, unconscious, however was now awake in the residence.

----- then exited the residence and stated that he had taken a Xanax for his anxiety and his mom, -----, believes he had taken some other form of narcotic. ----- eyes were pinpoint, he was sweating and appeared to be confused as to what occurred prior to my arrival. While Ptl. Deveckka stood by with -----, I spoke with ----- who advised she located several items of paraphernalia in his bedroom. ----- escorted me to his bedroom and showed me a dresser drawer filled with a large amount of empty wax folds. There were also 4 hypodermic syringes located in his bedroom, 3 in the drawer and 1 on the floor. Also while in the bedroom, 1 full wax fold, stamped "Pink Panther" in red ink was located on the floor next to the bed.

----- was evaluated by TR CSOs and ultimately transported to Community Medical Center for further treatment. Ptl. Deveckka assisted me in gathering all evidence in the residence which I then transported to District One where it was logged and submitted into Evidence Locker #17, to be destroyed. The 4 hypodermic syringes were placed in the sharps container in the evidence room as well.

Upon arrival I was met with the reporting individual, who advised these officers that she located her son in his bedroom "nodding out." I then observed him walking down the stairs from his bedroom and sit on the couch in the living room. He appeared to have slow movements and restricted pupils.

She stated that she was notified of his condition by his son. She stated that she observed him seated at the end of the bed "nodding off" at which time she notified to call 911. He advised me that he has been using heroin for years and that he refuses to go to rehabilitation programs.

At this time MONOC Paramedics and Silverton First Aid arrived to assess him. MONOC advised that Kristopher was medically cleared at which time after several attempts to get him to go to the hospital he refused. It should be noted that Narcan was never administered to him. His condition did not warrant the need for it.

She advised me that prior to our arrival she checked the room for any further heroin to which she was unable to locate any. I did a quick check of the room and was unable to locate any evidence. She then advised me she located 2 cut straws in which she uses to "snort" heroin. I took possession of the straws and placed them into Evidence Locker #9 for destruction.

She further advised me that she is currently 5 months pregnant with his child. I contacted DCPD and spoke with Officer #1576, who stated that the incident would be documented but a visitation would not be conducted at this time.

On 7/29/2019 at approximately 0122 hours, this writer along with police officers McDermott #404 and Sgt. Reilly #228 responded to Walgreens (1311 Route 37 W) for a report of a suspected overdose. Toms River Communications advised that the female was located in the bathroom, and at the time of dispatch, was still breathing.

Upon arrival, I walked to the back of the Walgreens pharmacy and entered the female restroom, where I observed [redacted] standing in a bathroom stall, screaming and crying. I alerted other responding officers, as well as dispatch, to downgrade their call response due to [redacted] being alert and conscious. While speaking with [redacted], I observed her pupils to be pinpoint, and her behavior was very erratic. [redacted] was yelling that her "anxiety is through the roof," and she appeared to be sweating profusely. [redacted] was also having a very difficult time walking on her own without stumbling.

I spoke with [redacted] on scene, a witness and friend of [redacted] who stated that when he entered to restroom to check on her, he noticed her inner forearm was bleeding, indicative of possible heroin use. [redacted] denied using heroin, and stated that she has a prescription for Suboxone, which is the drug she claimed she had been using prior to police arrival.

[redacted] assisted [redacted] out of the store, and [redacted] was patted down for potential needles (officer safety) due to the testimony of the witness. [redacted] did not appear to have any CDS or paraphernalia on her person. While further speaking with [redacted] she continued to slur her words and behave erratically, appeared unstable on her feet, and under the influence of some sort of substance. Due to the totality of the circumstances, [redacted] was transported (involuntarily) to Community Medical Center. This officer accompanied [redacted] in the ambulance on the way to the hospital to ensure her compliance. She was turned over to the hospital staff and admitted into the ER for further treatment.
