Narrative:

On July 6, 2019 at approximately 2155 hours, PO Ernest Thomason #290 and I responded to 34 Castle Avenue for a heroin overdose.

Upon arrival, I met the patient's brother, later identified as Matthew Meyer. Matthew directed me to his brother later identified as David Meyer, who he located unconscious in the bathroom of their residence. When I reached David, his head was hunched forward but I was able to observe that he was breathing and he was speaking to me. I requested David to sit on the couch in the living room which he did. Shortly thereafter, Jackson Township First Aid arrived and began treating David.

On the bathroom sink counter, I found three wax folds stamped Chick-Fil-A, a spoon with heroin residue, and a hypodermic syringe. All of these items were collected and logged into evidence for destruction.
