UPON ARRIVAL OFFICERS WERE MET BY THE COMPLAINANT [REDACTED] [REDACTED] STATED HER BOYFRIEND, [REDACTED] WAS ON HER BACKYARD DECK NOT BREATHING AND WAS UNRESPONSIVE. A NJ ATTORNEY GENERAL SUSPECTED DRUG OVERDOSE AND NALOXONE ADMINISTRATION REPORTING FORM WAS THEN COMPLETED BY THIS OFFICER AND FAXED TO THE APPROPRIATE NUMBER.

ON JULY 3, 2019 1847 HOURS I RESPONDED TO [REDACTED] MIZZEN AVENUE IN REFERENCE TO A SUSPECTED OVERDOSE. UPON ARRIVAL PTL. SCHENA AND MYSELF WERE MET BY THE ABOVE LISTED COMPLAINANT [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] ADVISED ME THE ABOVE VICTIM, [REDACTED] WAS LOCATED IN THEIR BEDROOM BATHROOM AND POSSIBLY OVERDOSED. [REDACTED] LED PTL. SCHENA AND MYSELF INTO HER BEDROOM BATHROOM WHERE THE VICTIM [REDACTED] WAS LOCATED. UPON ENTRY INTO THE BATHROOM I OBSERVED [REDACTED] SITTING ON THE TOILET CONSCIOUS AND RESPONSIVE. WHEN I BEGAN SPEAKING TO [REDACTED] I OBSERVED HIS ACTIONS WERE LETHARGIC, PUPILS PINPOINT, AND APPEARED TO BE UNDER THE INFLUENCE OF A SUSPECTED NARCOTIC. [REDACTED] ADVISED ME HE RECENTLY INJECTED ONE BAG OF HEROIN. SHORTLY AFTER BEACHWOOD FIRST AID ARRIVED ON SCENE AND TOOK OVER CARE.

[REDACTED] ADVISED [REDACTED] WENT TO USE THEIR BATHROOM AND WAS IN THE BATHROOM FOR APPROXIMATELY THIRTY MINUTES. [REDACTED] ADVISED SHE WENT TO CHECK ON [REDACTED] AND HE DID NOT RESPOND. [REDACTED] ADVISED ME SHE HEARD [REDACTED] CHOKING AND THEN MADE ENTRY INTO THE BATHROOM. [REDACTED] ADVISED WHEN SHE MADE ENTRY INTO THE BATHROOM SHE OBSERVED [REDACTED] UNRESPONSIVE AND SLUMPED OVER INTO THE SHOWER. [REDACTED] ADVISED SHE OBSERVED [REDACTED] SKIN WAS PALE AND HE HAD A NEEDLE INJECTED INTO HIS ARM.

BEACHWOOD FIRST AID TRANSPORTED [REDACTED] TO COMMUNITY MEDICAL CENTER FOR FURTHER MEDICAL ATTENTION. A HYPODERMIC NEEDLE WAS LOCATED ON THE FLOOR OF THE BATHROOM NEXT TO [REDACTED]. THE NEEDLE WAS MADE SAFE IN A SHARPS CONTAINER AND BEACHWOOD FIRST AID PROPERLY DISPOSED OF THE NEEDLE AT COMMUNITY MEDICAL CENTER. NO FURTHER PARAPHERNALIA OR NARCOTICS WERE LOCATED ON SCENE. PROPER PAPERWORK WAS FILLED OUT FOR THIS INCIDENT AND FAXED.
