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Incident Report



On 02/16/2021 at 09:44 hours I was dispatched to Flipper Avenue for a report of an overdose. Caller advised dispatch that 2 doses of Narcan were administered. Upon my arrival I was met by the caller who informed me that the victim was not responsive but breathing. I then observed lying in the front passenger seat of a with a NJ registration in the driveway. was on his left side with his legs and trunk on the floor and his torso on the seat. I noticed that was breathing and I checked his mouth and saw no obstructions so he was not asphyxiating. then informed me her son was with when he started to OD. then informed me he was the one who administered the Narcan approximately 5 minutes before his mother called. I then brought out of the vehicle and to the rear of the vehicle into the driveway. I placed him on his right side to prevent him from choking if he threw up. I then utilized a bag mask to help get the Narcan into nasal system. Medics arrived and transported to SOMC. I then spoke more with who informed me of the following.

arrived at Flipper Avenue at around 24:30 this morning and the two smoked marijuana before leaving to go to Atlantic City. drove to meet some friends at an undisclosed apartment complex. Upon their arrival, allegedly orally consumed 3 Xanax bars that were 2 mg each before then snorting 1/2 of one. The last time ingested anything was around 03:00 before the two drove home. stated that began to "fall out of it" or overdose, around 20 minutes away from house. stated that he arrived home and went inside to get Narcan. He administered one dose before asking to bring another dose outside. Upon the administration of the second dose, called for medical assistance.

DEU was notified and responded to SOMC and Flipper Avenue.

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Incident Report



On February 20, 2021 at approximately 2354 hours, I was dispatched to Outrigger Lane, Manahawkin, New Jersey in reference to a possible drug overdose. Upon arrival, directed Patrolman Bush and I to the patient later identified as located inside a bedroom inside the residence. I observed lying on his back unconscious, not breathing, but had a slight pulse. At this time, advised me used to have a heroin addiction years ago. I checked I pupils, which appeared to be constricted. Based on my training and experience this is indicative of some sort of opiate use. Due to the mentioned circumstances, I administered one dose of naloxone 4mg into I left nostril. still did not regain consciousness after one dose of 4mg naloxone. I then administered a second dose of naloxone 4mg into left nostril. During this time, began to regain consciousness and Stafford Township EMS arrived on scene, taking over medical treatment. eventually began to regain full consciousness and become alert. I was then transported to Southern Ocean Medical Center for further treatment.

Prior to being transported to Southern Ocean Medical Center he advised me he snorted a wax paper fold of heroin approximately two hours ago inside his garage. Officer's checked the garage and residence with negative findings of evidence. A naloxone replenishment receipt form was completed and submitted into records.

On March 2, 2021 at 1838 hours while on patrol, I was dispatched to an overdose call at . Upon arrival, subject was found slumped over unresponsive, but breathing in his wheelchair in the outside smoking veranda of . I then administered one dosage of Narcan into his left nostril. After giving the subject oxygen, we wheeled him to the front of the building. As soon as we arrived in the lobby area, the subject immediately regained consciousness and was then transported to Southern Ocean Medical Center by Stafford Township Emergency Medical Services (EMS) for further evaluation. Stafford Township Drug Enforcement Unit was notified of the incident and an on-point referral had been completed.

At this time, The subject was advised that he was being placed under arrest on the strength of the above listed warrant. The subject was then transported to Southern Ocean Medical Center for further medical evaluation. The subject was released on his own recognizance with a future court appearance scheduled in Asbury Park Municipal Court. He remained at SOMC for observation after being served his paperwork.

On Saturday, March 12, 2021 at approximately 1124 hours, I was dispatched to Vainsail Avenue in reference to a possible overdose. While en route to the residence, dispatch advised the male was unconscious and not breathing.

Patrolman Morrin and DeMarco of this agency arrived at the residence shortly before me and made initial contact with the caller who was identified as [redacted] was located in the rear of the residence with the victim who was identified as [redacted] was lying on his back, unconscious, and breathing slowly. Additionally, I observed an unknown white substance around his nose and mouth suspected to be heroin. At this time, I checked [redacted] for a pulse and performed a sternum rub on his chest.

After observing a possible drug overdose, I administered one dose of Narcan to [redacted]. After approximately three minutes, I administered a second dose of Narcan to [redacted]. Stafford Ems arrived on the scene and provided additional medical attention to [redacted].

After several minutes, [redacted] became alert and conscious and began breathing on his own. Patrolman Flanagan arrived on the scene and located in [redacted] front right pocket a bundle of blue paper wax folds labeled "Dior". Patrolman Flanagan also located a prescription pill bottle with a mixture of white and blue pills inside of it.

I then asked [redacted] what he used prior to our arrival at which time he stated he snorted several bags of heroin. Subsequently, [redacted] was transported to Southern Ocean Medical Center for Medical Treatment. Detective Wade was advised and responded to the scene. There is no further information regarding this incident.

Upon arrival I met with and spoke to the caller, who stated that his girlfriend, just overdosed on heroin. stated that when he went upstairs he found unresponsive but still breathing. At this time administered one dose of Narcan into her nostril. stated that as soon as he administered Narcan, regained consciousness stated that she snorted the heroin, she was able to provide me with a paper wax fold labeled "Bang Theory." was then transported to Southern Ocean Medical Center by Stafford Township Emergency Medical Services (EMS) for further evaluation. Stafford Township Drug Enforcement Unit was notified of the incident and an on-point referral has been completed. The wax paper fold was submitted to evidence and will be sent out for destruction.

Upon arrival I met with and spoke to the caller , who stated that his friend did not overdose he just had a seizure. , stated that he observed fall onto the ground and started to seize. While speaking to he was alert and conscious. He stated that he just had a seizure and was adamant that he did not overdose. While was being evaluated by EMS he admitted to overdosing on heroin. stated that he snorted the heroin, he was able to provide me with a light blue paper wax fold that was not labeled. No narcan was used during this incident. was then transported to Southern Ocean Medical Center by Stafford Township Emergency Medical Services (EMS) for further evaluation. Stafford Township Drug Enforcement Unit was notified of the incident and an on-point referral had been completed. The wax paper fold was submitted to evidence and will be sent out for destruction.
