Note

On Wednesday November 24th, 2021 at approximately 2323 hrs. officers were dispatched to the area of [REDACTED] Hillcrest Oaks Apts. (105 Blackwood Clementon Rd.) for a male in the stairwell possibly overdosing.

Upon my arrival, I made my way into the stairwell of [REDACTED] and located the victim, [REDACTED], laying on the landing between the 2nd and 3rd floor. I began an assessment of [REDACTED] and found that he had a weak pulse and was agonally breathing. His skin was also cold and clammy. Upon checking his pupils, I observed them to be pinpoint in nature leading me to believe that he was suffering from an opiate overdose. I removed one 4mg dose of Nasal Narcan from its packaging and administered it into his left nostril. I continued to monitor his condition which did not improve after a few minutes. I removed a second 4mg dose of Nasal Narcan from its packaging and administered it into his right nostril. I, again, continued to monitor his condition, at which time I determined his carotid pulse becoming stronger. As time went on he continued to agonally breath but was not waking up. Jefferson EMS arrived and provided me with a bag valve mask and I began to provide respirations with such. [REDACTED] condition continued to improve until he eventually woke up.

EMS and Medics on scene attempted to determine what David had taken, however he was unable to provide any information. He stated that he remembered leaving home to go for a walk and nothing after that. He did not have any CDS or paraphernalia on his person.

EMS and Medics transported [REDACTED] to Jefferson Stratford for further evaluation.

It should be noted that I completed the required form in ODMAP as prescribed.

11/24/2021 23:15	On Wednesday 11/24/21 at approximately 2108 hours, I was dispatched to [REDACTED] in reference to a 42 year old male, who was unconscious, but breathing. Upon arrival, I spoke with the victim's cousin, (Edwin Drummond), who advised that the victim, ([REDACTED]), was in the kitchen and was not acting like himself, as he was just standing and not moving. Edwin stated that he helped [REDACTED] to the living room couch, where he went unconscious, and had agonal breathing. I asked Edwin if he thinks that Tory had taken any drugs and he replied, that he believed that [REDACTED] possibly snorted something, and that he just got out of the hospital today for taking a pill. (There was no evidence found on [REDACTED] or in the area where he was located). I administered one dose, (4mg), of Narcan in [REDACTED] left nostril at 2116 hours and within 2 minutes he became alert and conscious. Jefferson BLS members, (Fryszacki and Gill), arrived within said time frame of when the dose of Narcan was administered. Note

On October 27, 2021 at approximately 1821 hours, LPD units were dispatched to Berlin Rd. near the Animal Adoption Center for a report of a male that was lying unconscious on the side of the road. The male, later identified as [REDACTED], was located on the 600 block of Berlin Rd. on the ground between the sidewalk and street across from Glen Oaks Autobody. He was surrounded by a group of people that were trying to assist him.

[REDACTED] was sweating profusely and made several snoring/grunting noises while I was trying to awaken him. Based on my training and experience, I determined that he was overdosing on heroin. As a result, I administered one dose of nasal Narcan into his right nostril. Shortly thereafter, Lindenwold EMS arrived on location and began administering first aid to him.

Approximately 5 minutes later, [REDACTED] "came to" while EMS and LPD officers were attempting to lift him onto a stretcher. He refused any further medical treatment and/or transportation to a local hospital. He was advised by EMS that the Narcan he was administered could wear off and he could overdose again, but he still refused. Prior to him leaving, he told us that he needed to get to Metro PCS to purchase a new phone.

Note

On 10/16/2021 at 1826 hours, LPD was dispatched to the area of Laurel Road and [REDACTED] for a possible pedestrian versus motor vehicle accident. Upon my arrival, I located an unconscious male lying on the grass on [REDACTED]. The male did not appear to have been injured externally, and there was no damage to his clothing. While evaluating the unconscious male, I noticed that he was breathing, and had a pulse. The male was exhibiting signs of a possible overdose.

I administered 4mg of nasal Narcan into the male's right nostril. Within approximately two minutes, the male regained consciousness and began speaking with officers. The male, known as [REDACTED], admitting to snorting approximately five bags of heroin. [REDACTED] did not state where he retrieved the heroin from and agreed to be transported to Jefferson Stratford by Lindenwold EMS. While checking [REDACTED] backpack for any possible weapons, two bundles of pre-packaged wax folds, commonly used to package narcotics.

The bundles were collected and submitted into evidence. [REDACTED] was transported to Jefferson Stratford for further medical evaluation. After counting and separating the evidence, there were 30 small red plastic baggies, consisting of white wax folds stamped with "RX 360 OUT OF STOCK". There were also 16 small clear plastic baggies containing small blue wax folds stamped with "BLUE LABEL". All wax folds consisted of a white powdery substance, commonly packaged in the wax folds and small plastic baggies it was in.

All evidence was labeled and placed into the evidence locker. [REDACTED] was not charged for possession at this time.

I, Detective Gaceres, was assigned to assist Patrolman Keating in a Sudden Death investigation. Ptlm. Keating responded to 1990 Laurel Road, [REDACTED] Lindenwold, New Jersey, 08021 on December 12, 2021. On this day, Ptlm. Keating met with Maria [REDACTED] and Michael Dostillio. Mrs. [REDACTED] is the separated wife of the deceased, [REDACTED] was found deceased inside his apartment by Mrs. Enos and Mr. Dostillia when they went to check for his wellbeing. For further details regarding the preliminary investigation, refer to Ptlm. Keating's investigation report.

On December 14, 2021; I contacted Detective Robert Jordan from Camden County's Prosecutor Office. Det. Jordan is the lead detective in the sudden death investigation from the prosecutor's office. We spoke briefly about the case and Det. Jordan told me that his agency is not interested in pursuing a strict liability case. Det. Jordan also provided me with details of the toxicology report. [REDACTED] toxicology report alerted to the presence of cocaine, fentanyl, and oxycodone in his body. The cause of death was listed as adverse effect of drugs and the manner of death was determined to be accidental. As a result, I contacted Mrs. [REDACTED] and advised her of my findings. I informed Mrs. [REDACTED] that there would be no follow up investigation from our agency nor the prosecutor's office and that any property collected at the scene belonging to [REDACTED] could be returned. Mrs. [REDACTED] agreed and the case was closed.

12/12/2021 19:33

On Sunday, December 12, 2021 at 1541 hours, I was dispatched to [REDACTED] of Village at Laurel Creek (1990 Laurel Road) for an unconscious and possibly deceased male. Upon my arrival, I met with the caller/brother-in-law, Michael Dostillio, and the deceased's wife, Maria [REDACTED]. The deceased male was later identified as [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] has been separated from Maria for several years and he lives alone.

Prior to my arrival, Lindenwold EMS (BLS 63) were already assessing [REDACTED] and they advised he was deceased. The paramedics were recalled [REDACTED] was cold to the touch. [REDACTED] body had signs of rigor mortis and livor mortis. [REDACTED] was lying face down on the living room couch and there was vomit under his face. His head was facing towards the bedroom and his feet was facing the front door. There appeared to be no signs of trauma or foul play.

Approximately five (5) feet from [REDACTED] were two (2) blue wax folds containing a white powdery substance believed to be heroin on the kitchen island counter. The packages were stamped with red lettering, "Rolling Stones." On the bedroom dresser there were two (2) more blue wax folds, but they were empty. They had the same stamp as the other wax folds. The following was also on the dresser: an unknown white powdery substance, a plastic card with white powder residue on it and an orange straw. [REDACTED] Motorola phone was located on the living room table, but at this time the passcode is unknown. The above mentioned items were photographed and entered into evidence.

[REDACTED] had an extensive medically history including the following: [REDACTED] at age 35, [REDACTED], [REDACTED] [REDACTED] and has approximately [REDACTED] because of [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] smokes cigarettes and is prescribed a vast amount of medication including [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] primary doctor is unknown, but two of his doctors are Dr. Ashok Bapat (705 White Horse Road, Voorhees, 856-435-1777) and Dr. Kenneth H. Rodgers.

Marie last heard from [REDACTED] on Saturday, December 11th at 1459 hours via text message. Marie was concerned because [REDACTED] stopped replying, so her and Michael went to his apartment to check on him and they found him deceased. Maria has a key to the apartment. Maria and Michael were unaware if [REDACTED] abused drugs specifically heroin.

Detective Jordan of the Camden County Prosecutor's Officer arrived and processed the scene. Det. Jordan packaged the above evidence and turned it over to me. Camden County Major Crimes was notified, but did not respond.

Medical examiner Kirk Popiolek arrived on scene and the body was released to him. At this time, it is unknown if the death was a result of a drug overdose. End of report.
