Description of the Incident: First Aid/Overdose Prescription Medication

On the above date and time I was dispatched to 17 Park Ave. for a 57 year old female named [REDACTED] who overdosed on her medication. Monmouth County Police Radio further advised me that the caller was a 3rd party caller who was not on location. Monmouth County Police Radio advised me that the caller was a Mental Health Screener. Upon arriving on location, I noticed the Englishtown Manalapan First Aid Squad was on location. Upon approaching the front door, I noticed it was locked. We then went to the back sliding door and found it to be unlocked. EMS and I entered and found the victim, identified as [REDACTED], laying in her bed with an altered mental status. EMS further took over scene and gave several verbal commands to [REDACTED] however she would respond and was incoherent. Not knowing her normal mental state, EMS asked her if she wanted to go to the hospital, however she could not give a legible verbal response. EMS then decided to take her to the hospital and escorted her out of the residence on a stair chair, where she was then transferred over to the stretcher outside. When we went outside, I noticed Mon-oc paramedics arrived however EMS canceled them. At this time the complainant, [REDACTED] arrived at the scene and spoke with EMS and myself. [REDACTED] advised us that he works for Declarations and is [REDACTED] Mental Health Screener. He further advised us that [REDACTED] called him earlier and told him that she overdosed on 3 of her medications because she was depressed from not seeing her kids. [REDACTED] advised us that she normally is talkative and her current mental status was not right. EMS then transported [REDACTED] to Centra State Medical Center for further treatment. No further action taken by this agency.

Description of the Incident: EMS Call/Heroin Overdose

On the above date and time, I was dispatched to the area of 2 Center St. in reference to a 911 hang up. County then advised that it was an overdose call. As I approached, I observed a white male (██████████) running towards my car from the side of the street. I slowed down to speak with him, and he shouted "the car is down there" as he pointed at Center St. I quickly pulled up behind the black 1995 Nissan sedan (bearing PA registration J2M7140) and observed a female (██████████) attempting to give CPR to the patient (██████████) in a grass area on the passenger side of the vehicle. (██████████) shouted out that (██████████) was having a heroin overdose. I quickly grabbed my narcan and my medical bag from my trunk and cleared the scene asking (██████████) and (██████████) to stand to the side. Off. Kwiecinski arrived at the same time and assisted with her oxygen tank. I observed the area to be clear of dangers and sharp objects. (██████████) was unconscious laying on her left arm. I pulled her arm out and observed a white tank top wrapped around her elbow area with blood on it. (██████████) had a faint pulse, was not alert, and not breathing. I administered 1 narcan dose into her left nostril and immediately started using a bag valve mask with the assistance of Off. Kwiecinski. I observed (██████████) started to blow bubbles out of her mouth but was still not alert and breathing. I administered a second dose of narcan (this time in her right nostril) and continued with the bag valve mask. (██████████) started to open her eyes and move her left arm attempting to remove the mask. EMS arrived on scene and assisted with the mask, then put her on the stretcher. I checked her pockets yielding negative results of contraband. (██████████) was later transported to Centre State.

(██████████) stated that he went to the Quick Crack but realized that they were closed. He made a right onto Main St. traveling South and realized that (██████████) was in the back seat slumped over not responding. He immediately pulled over and attempted CPR on her. He then ran up to the nearest houses and banged on their doors. (██████████) answered and assisted by calling 911. (██████████) later stated that he does not do heroin anymore, but use to do that and crack. (██████████) stated that she just got out of rehab for heroin. Off. Kwiecinski gathered (██████████) and (██████████) pertinent information, and conducted a vehicle search for any drugs/paraphernalia. She found 1 needle within (██████████) purse, and 1 small white/yellow round pill indicative of Hydrochloride Extended Release XL 300MG. A total of 33 opened wax folds were found within the car and (██████████) purse (9 unstamped wax folds, 15 were stamped "Top Secret" in blue, 8 were stamped "Tesla" in red, and 1 was stamped "Gucci" in red). Some of the wax folds contained trace amounts of a white powdery substance indicative of heroin. A plastic container containing multiple razor blades with 1 loose razor blade was also found in the front seat area. All evidence was collected for destruction, then (██████████) and (██████████) left the scene. I transported the evidence to headquarters and locked it up in temporary locker #16, then went to Centre State hospital to replenish the narcan (see incident #18ET06725). No further actions.
