Narrative

On the above date and time I was dispatched to [REDACTED] in reference to a female subject suspected of overdosing on heroin. Upon arriving on scene I was directed by the caller to bedroom of the residence where I observed the victim later identified as [REDACTED] to be laying on the floor. The victim was unconscious, viewed to be blue in color, and taking short shallow breaths. It was related to me by persons in the home that the victim was viewed to have ingested one wax fold of suspected heroin. When asked, the caller advised that the victim discarded the empty fold by flushing it down the toilet prior to her losing consciousness. The victim was administered two doses of Naloxone (lot#'s: 171102/171770 exp: 09/2019 and 09/2018) via the victim's nasal cavity approximately 5 minutes apart. At this time MONOC paramedics responded to the scene and began assisting the victim in breathing using a non re-breather mask. After 3-5 minutes passed since the administration of Naloxone the victim regained consciousness, but denied ingesting any opiates. The victim refused to provide any information as to the amount of heroin ingested, markings on the folds, or where she procured the narcotics from. She was then prepared for transport to Southern Ocean Medical Center for treatment.

Operations Commander Lt. Carroll (355) and Det. Long of OCPO SOG were notified of the incident as well as the crime reduction unit of this department. Additionally, the Naloxone reporting form was emailed to the NJROIC and OCPO per departmental policies

There was an empty bottle of Vistaril on the nightstand. I found a receipt that indicated the prescription was purchased on 9/21 with a count of 30 pills. The victim was transported to Southern Ocean Medical Center by Barnegat First Aid. I followed the ambulance to the hospital. Upon me arrival i provided PESS with all the information.

On Saturday, September 22nd 2018, at 3:38 PM:

I responded to [REDACTED] located at [REDACTED] for a report of an overdose.

Upon arrival I met with [REDACTED] who was outside the [REDACTED] [REDACTED] stated she woke up from a nap and found her daughter, [REDACTED] on the ground in between her bed and the wall, unconscious and unresponsive. When asked, [REDACTED] indicated her daughter told her she uses heroin on occasion. [REDACTED] stated she believes [REDACTED] snorts the heroin she uses and does not use needles.

Barnegat EMS arrived on scene at the same time as patrol. Barnegat EMS administered 1 dose of narcan (Lot #172023) to [REDACTED]. A short time later [REDACTED] was conscious. [REDACTED] was escorted onto the stretcher and transported to SOMC for treatment.

[REDACTED] gave officers on scene permission to search the [REDACTED] which yielded negative results for any contraband.

A family friend [REDACTED] spoke with [REDACTED] at the hospital. [REDACTED] relayed to officers that [REDACTED] told him, she was buying the heroin from [REDACTED] at [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] was unable to provide any further details or names on the subjects in [REDACTED].

Sgt. Lindstrom notified the administration. CREW and Ocean County Prosecutor's Officer SOG unit were also notified of the incident.

On this date. While working as the School Resource Officer at [REDACTED] I was advised by the [REDACTED] that [REDACTED] 11th Grade is in the nurses office and may want to harm herself.

I then spoke with [REDACTED]. She related she suffers from depression and wants to kill herself. She related she consumed 28 Zoloft and 20 Abilify prescription medications that she was prescribed.

She related she consumed some at home and consumed some at 0900 hours on this date in school. Prescriptions were Prescribed by APN [REDACTED] filled on 05/23/17 at Walgreens.

[REDACTED] was transported to Southern Ocean Medical Center VIA Quality Medical. Guidance Counselor [REDACTED] assisted [REDACTED]. Ptl Ohearn OIC was notified. Sgt Smith was notified. Ptl Nogowski escorted Quality to SOMC and advised the medical staff of officer findings and advised them [REDACTED] is in need of a PESS Eval. [REDACTED] Mother, [REDACTED] was advised and responded to SOMC.

On the above date and time, I responded to the above location in reference to a possible overdose. The victim, [REDACTED] had ingested an unknown amount of Temazepam, Advil, and Benadryl. Upon arrival to the residence, the victim was alert and conscious. I spoke with the victim's daughter [REDACTED] who stated she arrived home at approximately 2200 HRS and observed her mother's speech to be slurred and having difficulty breathing. I spoke with the victim who stated she ingested the pills because she is "deeply depressed and wanted to end her life". The victim is prescribed Temazepam 15 MG. The victim stated she starting ingesting the medications at approximately 1600HRS on this date. The Barnegat First Aid and MONOC Medics transported the victim to Southern Ocean County Hospital and left in the care of [REDACTED] [REDACTED] advised when the victim was medically cleared she would be receiving a mandatory PESS evaluation.
