On October 4, 2018 at 1805 hours, Ptl. Prendeville #223, Ptl. Lardieri #251 and I responded to , Aldi's parking lot, for an unconscious male behind his driver wheel. Upon arrival, who was the caller advised me he was leaving the store and walking back to his vehicle when he observed a male unconscious male behind his wheel. then walked around to the driver side of the vehicle and banged on the window in an attempt to wake up the male. With negative results, called the police.

As I arrived, I observed a male later identified as slumped over the steering wheel in a gray Hyundai Elantra bearing NJ temporary tag R534669. I attempted to bang on the window to wake up With negative results, I opened the driver side door and observed vomit on shirt. skin color was grey and his lips were blue. As I proceeded to give him a sternum rub, was gurgling but breathing. As I looked down, I observed a single wax fold of suspect heroin on the driver side floor board. I pulled out of his vehicle and administered 4mg of Narcan into his right nostril. When I administered the Narcan, again began to gurgle and throw up and was still unresponsive. Brick EMS 538 arrived on scene and began life saving procedures. Brick EMS administered 4mg of Narcan into his nostril. While EMS was treating I was able to detect an odor of raw marijuana emanating from his vehicle. MONOC 215 arrived to assist.

While EMS and paramedics were treating , was walking by and asked Ptl. Prendeville and I if that was in the ambulance. We asked how he knew and stated he was friends with and knew it was his vehicle because of the broken passenger side mirror. explained the following:

got out of Ocean County Jail approximately 3 days ago. stated that he had not seen since he went to jail. He stated that he believes is homeless and his family lives in Florida and somewhere south of Barnaget. stated has a history of narcotic use and tries to stay away from him now.

At that time, started to throw up more and began to have a seizure. MONOC then sedated inside the ambulance. At that time, health became critical and a crime scene log was opened. (See Ptl. Prendeville's case supp.) DEU SGT. Petrola #201 and Det. Mauro #207 was advised and responded to the location with Det. Lash #159 who processed the scene and took the evidence. was then transported by Brick EMS to Ocean Medical Hospital.

At the hospital, was treated by the staff at Ocean Medical Hospital. At the hospital, was being treated by the nursing staff who found approximately 33 wax folds of suspected heroin stamped "Jordan" in black ink, rubber banded around his penis. I secured the suspect heroin and waited for Det. Lash #159 to respond to the hospital. Det. Lash retrieved the evidence. The nursing staff advised me that was not breathing on his own but had a pulse and regular heart beat. I then responded to Brick Headquarters to attempt to locate a next of Kin. I located an aunt in Wall Township. I contacted the Wall Township Police Department and advised them of the incident. I requested them to attempt to make contact with , Wall Township had negative results making contact with

After having negative contact with I advised the hospital that we had negative results and provided them the next of kin information we located.

A Naloxone Administration Reporting Form and a Replenishment Receipt was completed and submitted.

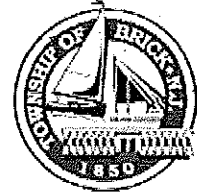

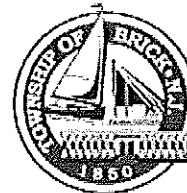

Stephenson #291 were dispatched to [redacted] in reference to an overdose. Prior to our arrival, dispatch advised EMS was on scene performing CPR, and that they administered Narcan

Upon my arrival, Ptl. Foley was outside in the driveway with the two children. I entered the residence and identified the victim as [redacted]. I spoke with the victim's boyfriend identified as [redacted] stated [redacted] was a recovering heroin addict. [redacted] stated he was in his bedroom sleeping when her son came and woke him up. [redacted] stated he was unaware of any drugs being in the house. [redacted] last observed [redacted] at approximately 1700 hours.

When [redacted] gained consciousness, she stated she snorted a bag of heroin. [redacted] advised she found one bag of heroin in the kitchen drawer and she snorted it using a dollar bill. [redacted] stated she flushed the bag down the toilet prior to going unconscious. [redacted] stated there were no more drugs in the house. [redacted] advised Ptl. Person she placed the dollar bill used to snort the heroin inside her wallet. [redacted] went in her wallet and showed Ptl. Person the dollar. Ptl. Person asked if he could look in the wallet for any additional heroin and she handed him the wallet. Ptl. Person located a clear bag which contained six pills. Ptl. Person asked [redacted] if she had a prescription for them. [redacted] stated she did not, and received them from a female named [redacted] who lives on [redacted], and was holding them for her. Three of the pills were round, orange, and marked with "OP 40". Three of the pills were oval, yellow and marked with "S 901".

[redacted] was transported to Ocean County Medical center by Brick EMS. Ptl. Person and I followed [redacted] over to the hospital and ensured she was admitted.

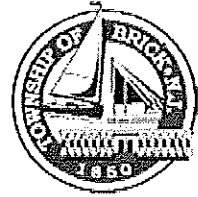

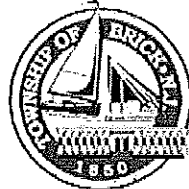

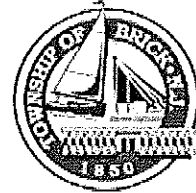

in reference to a suspected drug overdose.

On scene the victim, [redacted], was located in her bedroom. [redacted] had regained consciousness prior to police arrival and was standing up from the floor in which she was found. [redacted] had stated she had shot four bags of heroin. Brick Police EMS #534 arrived on scene and ultimately transported [redacted] to Ocean Medical Center without incident. In a trash can that was located next to where [redacted] was found the following items were recovered:

- An uncapped needle, commonly used to inject heroin
- 2 Water bottle caps with a piece of Q-Tip in it, commonly used to prepare heroin to be injected
- 4 empty wax folds, commonly used to pack heroin (one wax fold contained a red stamp with "The Godfather" logo stamped on it)

I spoke with [redacted] mother, [redacted] who stated the following: at 2204 hrs [redacted] grandmother, [redacted] had called her after she was unable to wake [redacted] who she believed was sleeping in her bed. When [redacted] arrived she checked on [redacted] and found her to be unresponsive. At this time she called 911. While searching the room she located a white shopping bag that contained the following times:

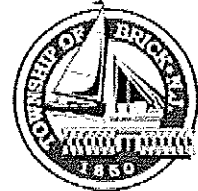
- 5 capped unused needles
- 1 bundle of wax folds, containing suspect heroin (some of the folds were stamped with the above Godfather stamp, and some were stamped with a green "Audi" logo)

I then spoke with [redacted] who stated the following: At approximately 2145 hrs [redacted] had been on the couch watching TV while [redacted] was in her room, [redacted] could hear what sounded like [redacted] was both snoring and crying at the same time. [redacted] went in to check on [redacted], but was unable to get completely in the room due to her limited mobility with a walker. She grabbed [redacted] foot, and yelled to her, but she was unresponsive. At this time [redacted] called [redacted] in order to have her respond and wake [redacted] up. When [redacted] responded and they could not wake [redacted] she dialed 911.

I responded to Ocean Medical Center in order to speak with [redacted] but due to her intoxication I could not get any information about today's events. I contacted DEU Det. Mauro #207 in reference to the overdose and he advised he would not be responding out tonight. All of the recovered drugs and drug paraphernalia was brought back to headquarters and logged into property via AEGIS.

Ptl. Rossi was the first unit on scene and moved [redacted] from the side of the bed to the middle of the bedroom floor and advised that the subject was unconscious and breathing. Upon my arrival, Ptl. Rossi was performing sternum rubs to [redacted] to which he was responding with agnail breathing. Ptl. Rossi advised that the subject may have been overdosing from various pain medications according to his son, [redacted]. At such time, Monoc Medics and Police EMS arrived, and Medics #1894, #3490 deployed one dose of Narcan in each nostril. [redacted] then began snoring in response to the Narcan. There was also what appeared to be a track mark from a syringe on [redacted] left forearm.

While on location, I gathered information from [redacted] and [redacted] step-father, [redacted], son informed me that he was in the room with his father before he fell off the bed and stated he might have taken too much of his prescribed pain medications. [redacted] stated that his father mentioned he had trouble sleeping the past few nights and took more than what he was prescribed to help him fall asleep. [redacted] stated that just before [redacted] fell, he said he took five (5) Sona 350mg pills, several Klonopin 2mg, and several Morphine Sulfate 15mg. When [redacted] fell off the bed, [redacted] ran to [redacted] who called 9-1-1. [redacted] added that [redacted] was not feeling depressed, and did not want to harm himself, he only mentioned that he had trouble sleeping. [redacted] also stated that his father does not drink and is not known to use heroin, or other illegal drugs. When I asked him if he knew about the track mark on [redacted] left arm he stated he received a flu shot earlier in the day.

I returned to the bedroom and [redacted] was still snoring and semi-conscious. Ptl. LaPoint checked the bedroom for syringes and signs of heroin use, which was negative. [redacted] was subsequently transported to Ocean Medical Center by Brick Police EMS #533. All units cleared the scene, and the residents were advised to contact the Police if they locate any heroin or paraphernalia.

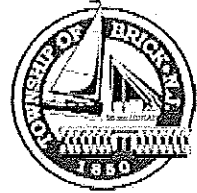
_____ was loaded in the ambulance and then admitted he flushed the needle as well. _____ was then transported to Ocean Medical Center for further treatment and evaluation.
