Narrative:

On 10/04/2018 at 0913 hours, I, Officer Morizio #280 was dispatched to 5 Tudor Court for a report of first aid call with a male having respiratory issues and vomiting blood.

Upon arrival, I met with James Guadagno and Danielle Havens. Danielle stated in effect that her boyfriend, Nicholas Guadagno, smoked crack the night prior at approximately 2000 hours. Danielle continued to explain that Nicholas smoked weed after he smoked crack and this morning she was having trouble waking him up.

Quality first aid and fire department personnel treated Nicholas in his bed where he was found laying on his side. Nicholas was sleeping and was not responsive to questions asked. Nicholas also had some dried blood on his lips and mouth which is believed to be from vomiting earlier in the day.

James explained to me that Nicholas usually becomes disoriented and sleepy after he smokes crack and is prone to getting pneumonia.

Quality first aid transported Nicholas to Monmouth Medical Center South Campus for treatment.

I searched the bedroom that Nicholas was found to be sleeping in, but did not recover any drugs or paraphernalia. I asked Danielle as well as James and they stated that they did not know if there was anything else in the house. I also asked Danielle where Nicholas would have obtained the crack and she replied "I am not too sure, he gets it from all over the place".

Nicholas was transported to the hospital without incident and there was nothing of evidentiary value recovered at the scene.

Narrative:

On 9/19/18 Officers Morizio #280, Chesney #195, Reiff #278 and myself Pante #292 responded to 5 Tudor Court on a report of a 22 year old male who had over dosed. The victim was later identified as Anderson Colon. Upon this Officers arrival on scene one dose of Narcan was reported to have been administered by Fire personnel. Mr. Colon was breathing however appeared to be unconscious. This Officer readied a second dose of Narcan which was deployed approximately 3 minutes after the first dose. The second dose that was deployed was from Lot # RL06317. Mr. Colon started slowly waking up after the second dose was deployed.

While on scene Officers were able to speak with James Guadagno, and the caller Linda Guadagno who is also the home owner of 5 Tudor Court. Mr. Colon was transported to Monmouth Medical Southern Campus by First aid. This Officer also responded to Monmouth Medical Southern Campus.

Mr. Guadagno spoke with Officer Morizio further regarding the incident. Mr. Guadagno reported himself and Mr. Anderson had smoked marijuana earlier in the day. Mr. Anderson left and told Mr. Guadagno he was going to buy some adderall and marijuana. Mr. Guadagno explained Mr. Andersons' Grandfather had given him money and transported him to an unknown location before dropping him off at 5 Tudor Court. Mr. Guadagno explained his Grandfather does not speak very good English and he is unsure of his name. Mr. Guadagno believes Mr. Anderson picked up marijuana, adderall and possibly heroin from this unknown location.

Mr. Guadagno observed Mr. Anderson fall over in the garage after he was dropped off at 5 Tudor Court. Mr. Guadagno reported he observed Mr. Anderson take a pill before he fell over and found him laying next to a needle. Mr. Guadagno threw the needle in the trash before Officers arrived on scene. The needle was recovered, photographed and lodged into Jackson Township Police evidence for destruction. A bag containing 11 orange capsules believed to be amphetamine/adderall and 1 small baggie of green vegetation suspected to be marijuana was also recovered from the scene. The bag containing the suspected drugs was photographed and lodged into Jackson Township Police evidence for destruction. The pills and marijuana were not separated since it contained heroin residue also. A copy of the photograph has been electronically attached to this report.

Mr. Guadagno explained to Officer Morizio that Mr. Anderson grows marijuana at an unknown location and trades the marijuana for other drugs.

A Naloxone Administration Reporting Form was completed for this incident. A copy of the form has been faxed to the New Jersey State Police as well as the Ocean County Prosecutors Office.

No further police action is necessary at this time.
