On the above date and time, Cpl. Mosca and this officer responded to a 9-1-1 call at the intersection of Forman Avenue and Gowdy Avenue for a report of a female who had overdosed on heroine. Upon arrival to the scene, these officers found the female (identified as [REDACTED]) in the rear seat of a vehicle (NJ registration [REDACTED]). These officers assessed the females vitals, and discovered her unconscious with a weak pulse and agonal breathing. The caller (identified as [REDACTED]) stated her drug of choice was

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heroin.

Officer Mosca initiated a sternum rub on [REDACTED] which proved negative in awakening her. This officer administered one 4mg dose of Naloxone at 20:45 which was not immediately effective. EMS and paramedics arrived on scene at 20:47. Once [REDACTED] was placed onto the stretcher she slowly regained consciousness, and her breathing stabilized soon thereafter. [REDACTED] stated that [REDACTED] had just got out of a narcotics anonymous meeting, and he found her unconscious in the rear of his vehicle which prompted him to call 9-1-1. [REDACTED] informed the medics that [REDACTED] was the one who assisted her in intravenously injecting the heroine.

Cpl. Mosca and this officer asked [REDACTED] what he did with the syringe and heroine packets to which he then led these officers to a bush where he discarded the extra heroine. This officer recovered 92 wax folds of suspected heroine. Each fold was stamped with a purple cannonball that said TNT . [REDACTED] also led these officers across the street where he had discarded 2 syringes near a tree. One of the syringes contained a residual amount of liquid. This officer secured the syringes in a sharps evidence container. At this time, [REDACTED] was transported to Ocean Medical Center and [REDACTED] was released from the scene. No charges have been filed and all contraband was secured and placed into evidence.
