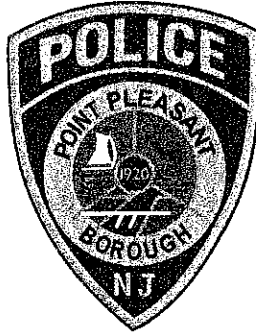

NARRATIVE FOR OFFICER GENE J CAPOANO

Responded to [REDACTED] for a report of a possible overdose male not breathing. Upon arrival, I Officer Capoano along with Officer Maloney and Sgt. Leonhardt arrived simultaneously. As we approached the residence I was met on the front porch by a female (later Identified as [REDACTED]) [REDACTED] directed us through the kitchen to the rear deck. On the deck there was a male sitting in a chair. [REDACTED] advised his name was [REDACTED] [REDACTED] was sitting in a chair with his head down on the table inside his arms that were crossed on top of a black sweatshirt. I along with Sgt. Leonhardt checked and could not find a pulse. [REDACTED] was cold to the touch his face was yellowing and there were signs of lividity. [REDACTED] stated she last spoke to him at approximately 3 am. Based on our findings and [REDACTED] statements it was apparent [REDACTED] was deceased and no life saving measures were performed. First aid responded and placed a sheet over [REDACTED]. Officer Maloney and I slid the chair approximately 12 inches back with [REDACTED] in it so he was under the cantilever of the house and stayed dry from the continuous rain. Nothing found on scene on initial observation to confirm a drug overdose.

Sgt. Leonhardt advised headquarters who contacted the Medical Examiner (M.E.), Prosecutors office, Chief, Detective Hynes and Sheriffs Departments CSI unit. Once these notifications were made I began to speak to [REDACTED] about [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] stated [REDACTED] was an acquaintance of hers through a mutual friend [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] stated [REDACTED] was left at her residence last evening by [REDACTED] after they all were drinking together. [REDACTED] stated [REDACTED] asked for her to take him home but she told him she did not want to drive after drinking. [REDACTED] stated her friend [REDACTED] was picked up by a friend leaving [REDACTED] at the residence. [REDACTED] stated he had no money and no Uber account so she agreed to let him stay on the couch. [REDACTED] stated she finished a cigarette with him and went upstairs to bed leaving him on the back deck smoking.

After hearing the rain this am [REDACTED] stated she began to close the windows of the residence and didn't see [REDACTED] on the couch where he was supposed to be sleeping. [REDACTED] stated she went to the deck to see if [REDACTED] was outside smoking. [REDACTED] stated [REDACTED] was sitting in a chair with his head down on the table inside his arms that were crossed on top of a black sweatshirt. [REDACTED] stated she attempted to wake him and lifted his head off of the table. After lifting his head she stated his face was a yellowish color and was not breathing. [REDACTED] stated she called 911 and we responded shortly thereafter.

Medic Unit 205 responded with medics # 4032 Jones and 0564 Harvey. They assessed [REDACTED] and called their report into Dr. Chineme Md# 46 at Newark Beth Israel. Dr. Chineme recorded the time of death at 0850.

While waiting for the Detectives and the M.E. to respond I spoke more to [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] was not that close to [REDACTED] and did not know any of his relatives or family. She did state that he was from Brick. Detective Hynes and Det Lavdicina from the Sheriff's department arrived simultaneously and were briefed on the facts thus far. Ocean County Prosecutors Detective Ludwick also responded and was briefed. Medical examiner Dr. Giliberti then arrived on scene. Detective Ludwick found 6 empty light blue wax folds with the word "revised" and what looked like a playing card in red ink with the letters A and B on it in [REDACTED] right sock. There was also a 1 dollar bill in his sock. At the Medical Examiner's direction [REDACTED] was transported to Community Medical Center Toms River, New Jersey by Colonial Funeral home. Detective Hynes made contact through Brick Police with [REDACTED] father for notification. Death report completed and faxed to Medical Examiner. See Detective Hynes report for further information.
