Conforti, and I responded to [REDACTED] Frank Drive reference a possible drug overdose. Upon arrival, we encountered the male patient (later identified as [REDACTED] in the upstairs bedroom. He was in a seated position on the floor next to the bed, leaning on the wall. He was wearing black cargo style shorts and a white tee t-shirt. There was a white prescription pill on the floor next to him. He was not breathing and did not have a pulse; however, he was warm to the touch. We moved him onto the floor at the foot of the bed to give us more room to perform CPR. We initiated CPR and administered two doses of Narcan. Stafford Township EMS arrived on scene to assist. Located in [REDACTED] front pocket was a prescription pill container with a variety of pills and several wax paper bags of what appeared to be heroin. Also in his side pocket there was a clear plastic bag with several pieces of women's jewelry in it. Life saving efforts were continued as [REDACTED] was transferred into the ambulance to be transported to Southern Ocean Medical Center. Det. Schweigart and Det. Povlosky arrived at [REDACTED] Frank Drive to further the investigation. The pill container and it's contents were given to them to be secured as evidence. SOMC advised that [REDACTED] had been pronounced dead at the hospital so detectives on scene notified the Ocean County Sheriff's Department and...

NARRATIVE On September 24, 2018 I responded to [REDACTED] Breakers Drive for a report of an unconscious male who was breathing. While en route dispatch further advised that it was the [REDACTED] residence which I was familiar with. Upon my arrival I located the male in the upstairs bathroom laying flat on his back. He was unresponsive to my voice and a sternum rub. He had shallow agonal breathing, but had a strong pulse. Residents in the home identified him as [REDACTED] who I remember from a similar incident about a year prior in which he had to be administered a dose of narcotics. [REDACTED] eyes were constricted and I ultimately administered one 4mg dose of nalcron. Approximately 1-3 minutes later he became responsive. The area immediately surrounding [REDACTED] did not show any signs of heroin use and [REDACTED] stated that he snorted two bags of heroin which he discarded in the toilet prior to going unconscious. [REDACTED] mother was the caller at the address who contacted police after she heard her [REDACTED] fall down in the bathroom after going unconscious. [REDACTED] was transported to SOMC for further treatment. No Further Information.

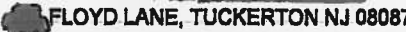
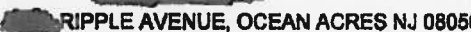

See the sudden death investigation report by Patrolman Lawrence for additional details of this incident prior to my arrival. I responded to [REDACTED] bedroom and located him lying on the bed. A wax paper fold stamped "Powerplay" was located on the bed next to [REDACTED]. Detective Chester #222 of the Ocean County CSI unit arrived on scene, and located additional "Powerplay" wax paper folds and hypodermic needles in the bedroom. The wax paper folds contained a white powdered substance indicative of heroin. It should be noted, Det. Chester photographed the scene and logged the CDS into evidence. Detective Carroll #154 from the Ocean County Prosecutors Office Major Crimes Unit arrived on scene for further investigation. Det. Carroll and I spoke with family members regarding [REDACTED] medical history and drug abuse. A cell phone, frequently used by [REDACTED] was retrieved by Det. Carroll and logged into evidence. Family members stated [REDACTED] was last seen alive during the evening hours on October 4th. Woods funeral home responded to the residence and transported the body to Community Medical Center at 1804 hours pending an autopsy.

On 10/5/16 at 1452 hours I was dispatched to [REDACTED] Ripple Avenue, in reference to a report of a male subject unresponsive and not breathing, due to a possible drug overdose. I immediately responded to the residence along with other patrol units, Sgt. Conforti and Ptl. Woodring. Medics from Monoc unit #216, were additionally pulling up to the scene upon my arrival. As we entered the residence, we were led by mother, Cynthia Parker, to the front right bedroom where the male subject, later identified as [REDACTED], was in his bed, lying on his back. Father of the victim, James F. Parker, was standing in the bedroom, and sister of the victim, Amanda...

Parker, was straddled on top of the victim, attempting to perform chest compressions. When entering the residence I immediately observed that the hallways and bedrooms were filled with several boxes and items, making mobility throughout the house and access into the bedroom extremely limited. Amanda and James were directed out of the bedroom, and Medics entered into the room to begin assessing the victim. Due to obvious signs of rigor mortis, resuscitation efforts were not rendered. Medics contacted Dr. St. Geroge of Newark Beth Israel, who pronounced [REDACTED] deceased at 1502 hours.

When entering into the bedroom I observed the deceased, laying on his back on his bed. I further observed that he appeared to have vomited, and a single wax paper fold was next to him. The wax paper fold was stamped in green with a "Powerplay" symbol. Due to the nature of this incident, the Ocean County Prosecutors Office, Ocean County Medical Examiner, and Stafford Township Detective Bureau were notified.

I then interviewed the family members residing at the residence. Sister, Amanda Parker, advised that last night [REDACTED] came out his room and went into his mom's car for something. He then came into her room and borrowed an umbrella from her, and left the residence in his blue pickup truck. A couple hours later he came back to house, and returned the umbrella to her before going to his bedroom. Amanda could not recall what time [REDACTED] left the house or came back, but could only advise that it was late.

I spoke with [REDACTED] father, James F. Parker, who advised that last night [REDACTED] was at the residence and ate a late spaghetti dinner with him. He talked with him for a little while, and then [REDACTED] went into his bedroom sometime between midnight and 0100 hours.

Mother, Cynthia Parker, stated that [REDACTED] had recently been talking to a female on Facebook and visited her last night on her work break. Cynthia did not know her name, but advised that she is an LPN at Genesis Healthcare in Manahawkin. Cynthia provided me with [REDACTED] medical history, advising that [REDACTED] was currently on [REDACTED], and has been in and out of rehab on four occasions for his heroin addiction. Cynthia further related that upon not hearing from him today, she went to his bedroom to go check on him. The door was stuck, so her husband pushed the door open at which time they found [REDACTED] on the bed unresponsive and contacted Stafford Police.

Shortly after, Detective Chester, #222, of the Ocean County Sheriff's Department, and Detective John Carroll, #154, from the Ocean County Prosecutor's Office, responded to the scene for processing. Detective Povlosky, from the Stafford Township Drug Unit also responded to the scene.

At 1715, Ocean County Medical Examiner Santangeli arrived at the scene and authorized release of the body. Woods funeral home responded shortly after and transported [REDACTED] to Community Medical Center where an autopsy is scheduled. No further information at this time.
