ON THE ABOVE DATE AND TIME, THIS OFFICER, ALONG WITH PTL ALTMAN RESPONDED TO [REDACTED] HALLIARD AVE FOR AN UNCONSCIOUS MALE. UPON ARRIVAL WE WERE DIRECTED TO THE PATIENT, IDENTIFIED AS [REDACTED], BY HIS GIRLFRIEND, IDENTIFIED AS [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] WAS IN THE BEDROOM LAYING ON HIS BACK ON THE FLOOR. HE WAS BREATHING AND HAD A PULSE. [REDACTED] SAID [REDACTED] MAY HAVE TAKEN HEROIN. PTL. ALTMAN AND I GRABBED [REDACTED] AND CARRIED HIM OUT TO THE LIVING ROOM WHERE WE COULD HAVE ROOM TO WORK ON HIM. AT 0804 HRS. I DELIVERED THE FIRST DOSAGE OF NALOXONE FROM UNIT RL087F8. WE THEN BEGAN ADMINISTERING RESCUE BREATHING USING OUR OXYGEN AND A BAG-VALVE MASK. BEACHWOOD FIRST-AID SQUAD ARRIVED AND TOOK OVER MEDICAL OPERATIONS. AT 0809 HOURS [REDACTED] BECAME ALERT AND CONSCIOUS. HE SAT UP AND WAS COOPERATIVE WITH THE SQUAD TO TAKE VITAL INFORMATION. [REDACTED] WAS LOADED INTO UNIT 158 AND WAS TRANSPORTED TO THE HOSPITAL. AFTER CLEARING FROM THE SCENE I WENT TO COMMUNITY MEDICAL CENTER TO REPLENISH MY NALOXONE. I CLEARED FROM COMMUNITY MEDICAL CENTER WITHOUT INCIDENT.

UPON ARRIVAL BACK TO TOWN I COMPLETED THE NALOXONE DELIVERY SHEET AND FAXED IT TO THE COUNTY PROSECUTORS OFFICE. I ALSO FILLED OUT THE NALOXONE REPLENISHMENT FORM.
