On 09/15/18 at approximately 0434 hours, Ptl. Steffen and I were dispatched to 6 for a unconscious male. Prior to arriving on scene, dispatch advised Ptl. Steffen and I that the caller, later identified as 7, stated she observed a needle in the vicinity of the male, later identified as 8.

Upon arriving on scene with Ptl. Steffen and Quality Medical Transport (QMT), we were met by 9 who I observed to be alert and conscious. Moments later, 10 entered the residence because she stated she was outside looking for the ambulance. 10 stated that he was fine and that he did not overdose. While speaking to 10, I observed him to be very lethargic. 10 admitted to using approximately one (1) and a half bags of heroin, injecting the heroin with a hypodermic needle (I observed fresh track marks in 10's left arm). According to 10, he placed the needle and the empty bags in the dumpster located in the parking lot. At that time, QMT began assessing 10 on scene while I spoke with 10 in her bedroom.

According to 10, 10 entered her bedroom for a phone charger which woke her up. Once 10 exited her bedroom, she heard him moving about the apartment for a little while until she thought he fell asleep on the living room couch. At that time, she heard a noise coming from the living room and when she exited her bedroom to see what it was, she observed 10 on the floor next to the couch unconscious with agonal breathing. 10 stated she called 911 and advised dispatch that she observed a hypodermic needle laying next to 10. 10 stated that 10 is her ex-husband and has been staying with her since his daughter in North Carolina kicked him out due to his drug use. 10 further stated that she observed a change in 10's behavior over the last week and during that time period, 10 advised 10 that he's been extremely depressed. 10 advised me that 10 has not made any specific suicidal/homicidal statements nor did she think this incident was a suicide attempt but was still concerned about 10's well being.

Ptl. Steffen and I were unable to locate any contraband inside the residence or in the exterior dumpster. 10 stated he utilized 10's vehicle earlier in the night to pick up the narcotics, but we were unable to locate any contraband inside 10's vehicle. 10 could not provide any information about who he purchased the narcotics from, or what type of stamp was located on the wax paper folds. 10 was transported to Community Medical Center (CMC) for further evaluation. Due to 10's statements regarding 10, 10 was advised to contact the police if she located any contraband inside her residence.

At headquarters, I notified Sgt. Mazza via email of the incident. No further action taken at this time.

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Upon arriving on scene with Ptl. Steffen and Quality Medical Transport (QMT), we were met by [REDACTED] who I observed to be alert and conscious. Moments later, [REDACTED] entered the residence because she stated she was outside looking for the ambulance. [REDACTED] stated that he was fine and that he did not overdose. While speaking to [REDACTED], I observed him to be very lethargic. [REDACTED] admitted to using approximately one (1) and a half bags of heroin, injecting the heroin with a hypodermic needle (I observed fresh track marks in [REDACTED] left arm). According to [REDACTED], he placed the needle and the empty bags in the dumpster located in the parking lot. At that time, QMT began assessing [REDACTED] on scene while I spoke with [REDACTED] in her bedroom.

According to [REDACTED], [REDACTED] entered her bedroom for a phone charger which woke her up. Once [REDACTED] exited her bedroom, she heard him moving about the apartment for a little while until she thought he fell asleep on the living room couch. At that time, she heard a noise coming from the living room and when she exited her bedroom to see what it was, she observed [REDACTED] on the floor next to the couch unconscious with agonal breathing. [REDACTED] stated she called 911 and advised dispatch that she observed a hypodermic needle laying next to [REDACTED].

[REDACTED] stated that [REDACTED] is her ex-husband and has been staying with her since his daughter in North Carolina kicked him out due to his drug use. [REDACTED] further stated that she observed a change in [REDACTED] behavior over the last week and during that time period, [REDACTED] advised [REDACTED] that he's been extremely depressed. [REDACTED] advised me that [REDACTED] has not made any specific suicidal/homicidal statements nor did she think this incident was a suicide attempt but was still concerned about [REDACTED] well being.

Ptl. Steffen and I were unable to locate any contraband inside the residence or in the exterior dumpster. [REDACTED] stated he utilized [REDACTED] vehicle earlier in the night to pick up the narcotics, but we were unable to locate any contraband inside [REDACTED] vehicle. [REDACTED] could not provide any information about who he purchased the narcotics from, or what type of stamp was located on the wax paper folds. [REDACTED] was transported to Community Medical Center (CMC) for further evaluation. Due to [REDACTED] statements regarding [REDACTED], [REDACTED] was advised to contact the police if she located any contraband inside her residence.

At headquarters, I notified Sgt. Mazza via email of the incident. No further action taken at this time.

It should be noted that I observed two wax paper folds containing a white powdered residue in the bathroom toilet. The stamp contained red lettering but was unreadable. I also observed one clear hypodermic needle and one glass smoking pipe containing burnt residue on the bathroom sink. The contraband was later seized and placed into evidence for destruction.

While [redacted] was unresponsive on the hallway floor, I administered two 2 milliliter doses of Naloxone and placed him in the recovery position. Monor Paramedics and Manchester First Aid arrived on scene and began treating [redacted]. Shortly after the second dose of Naloxone was administered, [redacted] became semi-conscious. While in this state, [redacted] was unable to sit up by himself, crawl, or stand on his own. Sgt. Morgan and I placed [redacted] on the stretcher so that he could be transported to the hospital. It was at this time that [redacted] became combative. More specifically, [redacted] began violently flailing his arms and legs in an attempt to get off of the stretcher. I placed an oxygen mask on [redacted] and he immediately bit me on my left hand (pinkie and ring finger). During the incident, Sgt. Morgan and I utilized compliance holds on [redacted] wrists to gain control over him and prevent him from getting off of the stretcher. Sgt.
