UPON ARRIVAL, OFFICERS ENTERED THE RESIDENCE TO FIND THE ABOVE LISTED VICTIM, [REDACTED] TO BE ALERT AND CONSCIOUS. THIS OFFICER WAS LATER GREETED BY THE ABOVE LISTED COMPLAINANT, LATER IDENTIFIED AS [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] ADVISED THIS OFFICER THAT HIS GIRLFRIEND OVERDOSED IN HIS BEDROOM.
